VATICAN CORNER In 1969, Pope Paul VI

removed 93 saints

from the universal Catholic calendar and revoked their feast days. That action did not de-saint those saints, it just downgraded them. The Vatican explained the reason for doing so was "to clean up a crowded liturgical calendar" and "those (93) saints had origins shrouded in more mystery than manuscripts." The Vatican said those names had only ever been alive as legends or not enough was known about them to determine their status. Also, the decree was aimed at putting more emphasis on the crucifixion and Christ. Saint Nicholas, a third



century saint whose legend as the patron saint of children grew in some countries into Santa Claus was reclassified at that same time but remains on the church calendar, however, Catholics no longer are obligated to honor him on his feast day on Dec. 6th in Western Christian countries or Dec. 19th in Eastern Christian countries. Vatican authorities stressed that there was no doubt of the authenticity of St. Nicholas, but his commemoration was made an option of local authorities throughout the world to remove the obligation to honor a saint not universally well know. Not a lot is known about Nicholas, who was bishop of Myra, a Greek city in modern-day Turkey. He was exiled and imprisoned under emperor Diocletian, and after being freed he attended the Council of Nicea in 325. He died in Myra on Dec. 6, 343. Many stories and legends gave him a reputation as a just and upright man, charitable gift-giver, a miracle-worker, and one who spent his life in service to the weak, the small and the defenseless. He was much admired for his devotion to God. It was said he gave away his inherited wealth and traveled the countryside helping the poor and sick. One of the best-know stories about him is the time he saved three poor sisters from being sold into slavery or prostitution by their father by providing them with a dowry so that they could be married. In both the east and west Christian churches, for nearly 1700 years St. Nicholas has been one of the most popular saints. There is a very large number of churches, chapels, religious institutions and altars dedicated to him throughout the Christian world. He is the patron saint of Russia, Greece, Germany and many other cities and regions. St. Nicholas is also the patron saint of children, unmarried people, fishermen, sailors, innkeepers, merchants, archers, repentant thieves, pawnbrokers, toymakers, students and the falsely accused. He is also the patron saint of brewers and barrel makers and the reason for this may be because of a grisly legend where three young boys were killed in a butcher's shop and then put in a wooden barrel and brined, to be sold as "ham" during a famine. Nicholas worked a miracle and saved the boys. It is the Rev. Clement Clarke Moore (1779-1863) who is blamed for changing the image of the universally popular saint Nicholas with his poem originally title "A Visit from St. Nicholas," to "Twas the Night Before Christmas." With that poem, St. Nicholas was recast from a bishop of boundless charity and compassion into a spirit who flew about on Christmas Eve leaving gifts for children. In that poem, Moore used the names St. Nicholas and Santa Claus interchangeably. It was said that Dutch settlers called their patron saint Santa Claus. The poem has appealed to children and adults for almost 200 years, but it had unintended consequences. Catholics found it difficult to pray to a saint who was said in the poem to be "a right jolly old elf." Although devotion to St. Nicholas in the West has lost its traditional appeal, both Catholic and Orthodox continue to visit the shrine of St. Nicholas which contains his relics, located in Bari a port city on the Adriatic Sea and the capital of southern Italy's Puglia region. One recent pilgrim to the shrine was Russian president Vladimir Putin. Devotion to St. Nicholas in the West continues among the Austrians, Germans, Swiss, Belgians and Dutch to give candy and maybe a small gift to children on Dec. 6th, St. Nicholas Day, a sweet prelude to Christmas.
