

VATICAN CORNER

The ancient Romans built an extensive and complex network of aqueducts across their

territories to transport fresh water to highly populated areas using gravity. They used pipes, tunnels, canals, bridges and the natural slope of the land to carry water from a freshwater source, such as a lake or spring to a city. The water flowing into the city was used for drinking, irrigation and to supply public fountains and baths. Rome itself had about 11 aqueduct systems, and water was brought from as far away as 57 miles. Roman rulers such as the emperors Augustus, Caligula and Trajan all ordered aqueduct construction. Despite their age, some of the aqueducts still function today to provide modern-day Rome with water. The aqueduct constructed in 19 B.C.E. during the reign of Augustus still supplies water to Rome's famous Trevi Fountain in the heart of Rome. The ancient Romans would build fountains as a way of celebrating rulers and decorate public places, and that tradition was carried on by the Catholic Church. In 1612 Pope Paul V oversaw the restoration of one of Rome's most important aqueducts, the aqueduct



Trajan, and created a "master fountain" called Acqua Paola at an elevation of 266 feet above sea level on top of the Janiculum hill. That fountain then able to provide water to fountains and public baths at lower elevations, ensuring enough water supply for a new fountain project in Vatican square. In 1612, Pope Paul V hired Baroque architect Carlo Maderno, who was famous for completing some of the designs of the façade of Saint Peter's Basilica, to create a new fountain over a previously existing one on the right side of the obelisk in St. Peter's Square. On an octagonal base, he placed a large irregular basin on top of steps and columns to prevent water from overflowing. An ornamental pedestal with four stone scrolls was placed on top of the old Roman basin and topped with a smaller basin covered with stone scales. The "mushroom-like" structure allows water to descend from the top of the fountain and sparkle through stone scales. Construction was completed in two years. In 1667, about fifty years after the first fountain, Pope Clement X commissioned a second fountain to be built on the left side of the obelisk in the Square. It was to be an exact replica of the first. The second fountain was completed 10 years later by Gian Lorenzo Bernini, the artist who designed the bronze baldachin inside the Basilica. The only way of telling the two fountains apart is by the different coat of arms decorating the bases. The eagle and dragon belong to Pope Paul V, while the stars belong to Pope Clement. Both fountains operate without the use of pumps and only use gravity and a system of pressure valves. They have operated continuously since their construction in the 17th century except for a brief time in 2017 during a severe drought. Together, the twin fountains provide a harmonious sense of symmetry to the most famous square in the world. They inspired architects across Europe including the "Fontaines de la Concorde" in Paris and some of the fountains commissioned by Peter the Great in St: Petersburg, Russia. 
