




### VATICAN CORNER On Dec.

21, 2024, Pope Francis met with the Vatican employees and their families in the Paul Vi Hall for the annual Christmas greetings. He described their service as precious for spreading the Kingdom of God throughout the world. He thanked them for the work they do for the Vatican and the universal Church. He said that all the activities in the streets, courtyards, corridors and offices in the various departments



"feels like being in a large beehive". He also thanked those that continued to work and could not be present at this gathering, but who made it possible. The atmosphere was festive with the presence of so many children. Francis said "Love the family, which is founded and rooted in marriage, is the place where life is generated." "Family is also the first community where "from childhood, one encounters the faith" that is transmitted, the word of God, the Sacraments, and learning to care for one another and grow in love. "I therefore encourage you – parents, children, grandparents and grandchildren, grandparents are of great importance – I encourage you to always remain united, close to each other and around the Lord: in respect, in listening , in caring for each other." Parents spend time with your children, and don't neglect grandparents. "Teach your children to pray – gather together around the crib and give thanks to God for His gifts, - ask Him for help for the future, and to renew your affection for each other before the Child Jesus." Having finished, Pope Francis greeted those present, shook their hands, exchanged a few words and gave the children treats and small gifts.

On January 13, 2025, at the Mass on the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, Pope Francis baptized 21 infants of Vatican employees, in the Sistine Chapel. Francis said when children are baptized, their parents and the Church are giving them the greatest gift ever: the gift of faith. "Let us ask the Lord that they grow in the faith, a true humanity (and) in the joy of family." Francis led the baptismal prayers and poured the water over the heads of the infants and was assisted in anointing the babies by Cardinals Konrad Krajewski, the papal almoner, and Vérgez Alzaga, president of the commission governing Vatican City State. When an infant was accompanied by an older sibling, the Pope helped the older child make the sign of the cross on the infant's forehead after he and the parents made the sign. After the fathers lit their child's candle from the Paschal candle during the Mass, the Pope told the parents to always keep the candle in their homes as a reminder of the day. "And when there is some kind of problem or difficulty, light the candle to ask the Lord for grace for your family." The Pope thanked the parents for bringing their children to be baptized, and as usual he told them to do what they had to do to make sure the babies were comfortable. "If they are hungry, nurse them, so they don't cry. If they are too hot, change their clothes. What is important is that "they feel at ease because today they are in charge and we have to serve them with the sacrament, with prayers." *Sources: vaticannews.va, catholicnewsagency.com, ncronline.org*


