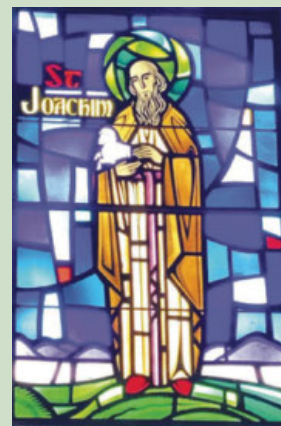

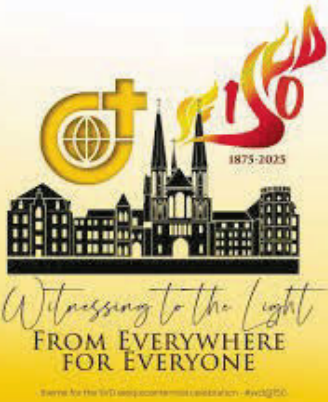

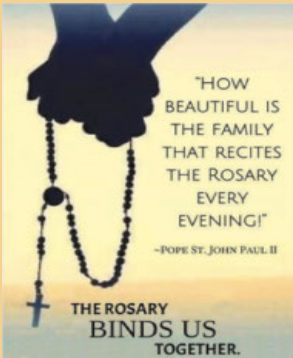

VATICAN CORNER

One of the most beautiful galleries inside the Vatican Museums is the Gallery of Maps and it is one long corridor, 394 feet (longer than a football field) and 20 feet wide leading to the Sistine Chapel. The gallery is decorated on the walls and ceiling with paintings using the fresco technique, where water and dry-power pigment is painted on freshly laid lime plaster. In this way the painting becomes an integral part of the wall. Italian and Flemish artists were the painters under the direction of Ignazio Danti, the multitalented Italian priest, who was a mathematician, astronomer and cosmographer. He had left his post as a professor of mathematics in Bologna to help the pope using Renaissance mathematics and astronomy in the efforts to correct the inaccurate Julian Calendar, which gained a day every 128 years. Danti had previously designed the Sala della Carte Geografiche (Hall of Maps) in Florence. The wall frescos consist of forty enormous maps showing Italian regions, the Italian peninsula, neighboring Italian Islands and the former Papal territory of Avignon now in France. The regional maps also show a detailed view of its major city and some major battles were also shown. At the end of the gallery there are frescos of the main Italian ports of the sixteenth century. Each ceiling painting next to a regional wall painting shows the main religious events that took place in that region, with images of saints, martyrs, apostles, and other important figures in Christianity. Although the maps were created hundreds of years ago, they have been said to be over 80 percent accurate to this day, and it is said what the geography the artists didn't know about, they chose to omit. The map of the Venice region has almost all the street and canals shown exactly as they are today. The Gallery of maps was commissioned by Pope Gregory XIII and built between 1580 and 1585. The maps predated a unified Italy by nearly 300 years. Rather than have the maps painted using the north pointing up as the convention is today, Pope Gregory XIII had the maps turned so that everything was arranged according to what it looked like if he could see from where he was in Rome. Consequently, some maps appear upside down to today's viewer. He had the maps painted so that he could accurately study the Italian peninsula without having to leave his home. Between each windowsill of the corridor a bizarre painting style was used to depict vines, demon-like heads, and strange children. This painting style was called grotesque and was very popular for decoration in the mid-16th century. The term comes from the Italian word grotto meaning "cave". In the 16th century, ancient Roman frescos had been discovered using this grotesque painting style and it was copied by artists like Raphael at the time. By the 18th century this decorative style went out of fashion, but it is the source of today's common word "grotesque". If you look closely at the map showing the detailed region of Rome, you will see that at St. Peter's Basilica does not show St. Peter's Square with its huge colonnade, since it would be another 50 years before it was built. Over the centuries the frescos had deteriorated due to moisture, dust, and poor maintenance. The damage became so significant with stains and erosion, that visitors thought the damages were geographic inaccuracies, or they would ignore the frescos completely and rush to the Sistine Chapel. In 2011, the Vatican decided to restore the gallery, and the Patrons of the Arts in the Vatican Museums funded a full restoration. Six and one half million visitors on average walk through the Gallery of Maps each year, so you may not have a lot of time in this room for viewing, and you may be expected to keep walking during the busy months. But see what you can of this marvelous room to get a glimpse of Pope Gregory XIII's 16th century. *Sources: vaticanmuseumsrome.com, visitvaticancity.org, rockyruggiero.com, theromanguy.com*
