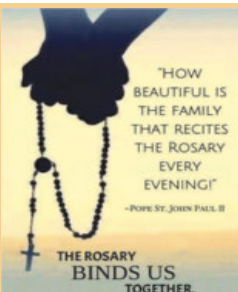

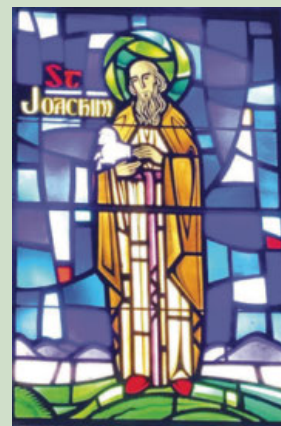

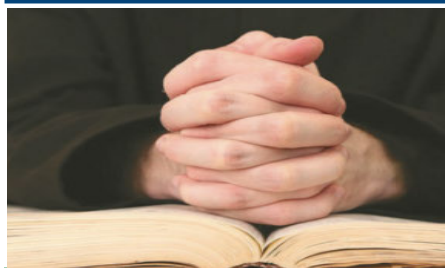

## VATICAN CORNER

Pope Francis was discharged from the Gemelli Hospital on March 23, 2025, after spending nearly 40 days there. In a brief message the day before, he greeted groups of pilgrims from dioceses across Italy currently in Rome for the Jubilee Year. He thanked them for their prayers for his health. He wrote “Recently, I have very much felt the support that comes from your closeness, particularly the prayers which you have been accompanying me with.” “Even though I can’t be with you physically, I want to express my great joy in knowing that you are united in me, and among yourselves, in the Lord Jesus”. “I bless you and pray for you. And please: continue to pray for me too”. Before leaving the Hospital, Francis briefly met with medical staff and hospital leadership to thank them for his treatment. He then appeared on the fifth-floor balcony of the Hospital, making his first public appearance since February 14. waving and giving a “thumbs-up” he quickly blessed approximately 3,000 well-wishers who were gathered outside in the square and thanked them for bringing flowers. He was taken to the Basilica Santa Maria Maggiore,



where he gave Cardinal Rolandas Makrickas a bouquet of flowers to lay before the large, venerated Byzantine image of the Blessed Virgin Mary and Child holding a Gospel Book on a gold background. Afterwards he returned to the Vatican and prepared a written message that was published and he briefly appeared at his window at about noon to greet the faithful and give his blessing. His message read: “During this long period of hospitalization, I have had the opportunity to experience the patience of the Lord, which I also see reflected in the tireless care of doctors and health care workers as well as in the attentiveness and hopes of the patients’ families. “This confident patience, anchored in God’s love that never fails, is truly necessary for our lives, especially to face the most difficult and painful situations.”

Regarding gratitude, on December 30, 2020, Pope Francis gave a talk on the importance of thanking God and letting others see one’s gratitude. He said Catholics can change the world by being “bearers of gratitude.” He said: Above all, let us not forget to thank: if we are bearers of gratitude, the world itself will become better, even if only a little bit, but that is enough to transmit a bit of hope.” “Christians, as all believers, bless God for the gift of life. To live is above all to have received. All of us are born because



someone wanted us to have life. And this is only the first of a long series of debts that we incur by living. Debts of gratitude.” “During our lives, more than one person has gazed on us with pure eyes, gratuitously. Often, these people are educators, catechists, persons who carried out their roles above and beyond what was required of them. And they provoked us to be grateful. Even friendship is a gift for which we should be grateful.” Pope Francis urged Catholics to follow the “path of happiness.” “pray constantly, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. Do not quench the Spirit” (1 Thes 5:17-19).

Hospital officials said Francis will continue convalescing at his apartment in Casa Santa Marta at the Vatican for at least two months and will require ongoing oxygen therapy during that time. Doctors said at a press conference that Pope Francis would undergo a “protected discharge” and would “still have to carry out “treatment “for a long time
