VATICAN CORNER

The doctors who treated Pope Francis at Rome's

Gernelli Hospital have not said how they thought the infection started that brought on the Pope's double pneumonia. He had been sick days before February 14, but he resisted going to the hospital, probably because of his Jubilee commitments. Dr. Sergio Alfieri, the head of the medical team that treated Pope Francis said when Francis began to breathe with ever greater difficulty and realized he couldn't wait anymore, he came to the hospital, arriving in much pain. In an interview with Italian newspaper *Il Corriere della Sera*, Dr. Alfieri said that one of the most critical moments at the hospital was when they had to choose between continuing the therapy or letting the Pope die. He said "We had to choose whether to stop and let him go or push it and try every drug and therapy possible, running the extremely high risk of damaging other organs. After days of moderate optimism in the hospital, Pope Francis experienced a severe coughing fit that suddenly worsened his clinical condition. Although he never lost consciousness and cooperated with the therapeutic maneuvers of the specialist, the alarms went off, and the doctors decided to place him on a noninvasive mechanical ventilation mask to help him breathe. Dr. Alfieri said "For the first time, I saw tears in the eyes of some people who were close to him. People who, I've come to understand during this period of hospitalization, truly love him, like a father. We were all aware that the situation had worsened further and there was a risk that he might not make it." However, despite the risk of causing irreversible kidney and bone marrow damage due to the medical treatment he underwent, they decided to act. We really thought we wouldn't make it." It was a difficult decision, Dr. Alfieri said, and ultimately the Pope himself supported the decision, through his personal health assistant at the Vatican, Massimiliano Strappetti, who knows perfectly the Pontiff's will. The Holy Father had delegated any type of health decision to him. Strappetti gave a clear order: "Try everything, let's not give up". "It's what all of us also thought. And no one gave up" "That night was terrible, like us, he knew it, that perhaps he wouldn't survive the night. For days we ran the risk of damaging the kidneys and the bone marrow, but we kept going, then the body responded to the treatments and the lung infection improved." The second truly critical moment was when he suffered an episode of vomiting and gastric juices entered his lungs. Dr. Alfieri said, "In these cases, if you don't act quickly, there's a risk of sudden death, in addition to complications in the lungs, which were already the most compromised organs." The doctor said "despite the seriousness of the situation, Pope Francis was always aware, "even when his condition worsened, he was completely conscious. I think that his awareness was also the reason that kept him alive", said Dr. Alfieri. He added that "I believe that the fact that the whole world was praying for him also contributed to this." "There is a scientific publication according to which prayers give strength to the sick, in this case, the whole world began to pray. I can say that twice the situation was lost and then something like a miracle occurred." "He was certainly a very cooperative patient. He submitted to all the therapies without ever complaining." Eventually his good mood recovered, and he would often say "I'm still alive", and add "Don't forget to live and stay in a good mood." Dr. Alfieri said the Pope "Has a tired body, but his mind is that of a 50-year-old man. He had spent two stable weeks, and he asked to go around the room in a wheelchair and see the other patients. One night he gave money to one of his collaborators who bought pizza, and offered it to those that helped that day." When he left (the hospital) we talked and he promised not to waste the effort we had made. But he is the Pope, we are not the ones who can dictate his behavior,"

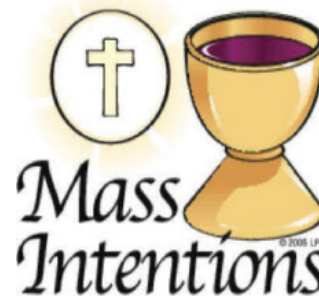
