



Pope Francis Biography

Pope Francis, born Jorge Mario Bergoglio on December 17, 1936, in Buenos Aires, Argentina, was the first pope from the Americas and the first Jesuit to lead the Catholic Church. Before his election as pope on March 13, 2013, he served as Archbishop of Buenos Aires, where he was known for his humility, simple lifestyle, and dedication to the poor.

Raised in a family of Italian immigrants, he studied chemistry before entering the seminary and joining the Jesuits. Ordained a priest in 1969, he later became the Provincial

of the Jesuits in Argentina and played a key role in guiding the Church during a period of economic and social crises in the country. When he was appointed bishop in 1992 and archbishop in 1998, he prioritized evangelization, social justice, and pastoral outreach.

As pope, Francis emphasized mercy, care for the marginalized, and environmental stewardship. His papacy was marked by a call for a "poor Church for the

poor," interfaith dialogue, and reform within the Vatican. His teachings focused on compassion, the dignity of every person, and the need for a missionary Church.

On April 21, 2025, Pope Francis passed away, leaving behind a legacy of love, humility, and service.

Biografía del Papa Francisco

Jorge Mario Bergoglio, el Papa Francisco, nació el 17 de diciembre de 1936 en Buenos Aires, Argentina. Fue el primer Papa del Continente Americano y el primer jesuita en dirigir la Iglesia Católica. Antes de ser electo Sumo Pontífice, el 13 de marzo de 2013, sirvió como arzobispo de Buenos Aires, donde era conocido por su humildad, su estilo de vida sencillo y su dedicación a los pobres.


Creció en el seno de una familia de inmigrantes italianos, estudió química antes de ingresar al seminario y unirse a la Compañía de Jesús. Fue ordenado presbítero en 1969 y, posteriormente, fue

electo provincial de los jesuitas en Argentina, desempeñando un papel clave como guía de la Iglesia durante un período de crisis socioeconómica en su país. Al ser nombrado obispo en 1992 y luego arzobispo en 1998, sus prioridades fueron la evangelización, la justicia social y el trabajo pastoral.

En su calidad de Pontífice, Francisco hizo énfasis en la misericordia, el cuidado de los marginados y la custodia del medio ambiente. Su pontificado estuvo marcado por el llamado a "una Iglesia pobre para los pobres", el diálogo interreligioso y la

reforma de la Curia Vaticana. Sus enseñanzas se concentraron en la compasión, la dignidad de cada persona y la necesidad de una Iglesia misionera.

El 212 de abril de 2025, falleció el Papa Francisco, dejando un legado de amor, humildad y servicio.

VATICAN CORNER

Pope Francis, the 266th pope of the

Catholic Church died early Monday morning after Easter Sunday April 20, 2025. He died of a stroke that put him into a coma that led to irreversible heart failure. His death was confirmed by Dr. Andrea Arcangeli, the head of the Vatican's health department. He was 88 years old, Argentina-born, and survived by his sister Maria Elena Bergoglio, and several nieces and nephews, including his late sister Marta's youngest son, José Ignacio Bergoglio, and



his niece Cristina Bergoglio, who is an artist in Madrid. She is the daughter of his late brother Alberto Horacio. Other relatives are his nephew Jorge Mario Bergoglio, a lawyer and director of an Italian company, and he had more distant relatives living in Northern Italy where his father and mother migrated from to Argentina. Pope Francis had made several appearances in his final week despite his ongoing heath struggles. On Wednesday of Holy Week he presided over a spirited general audience where children spontaneously rushed the stage. He visited a prison in Rome on Holy Thursday and talked with the inmates, made a surprise appearance on Easter Sunday, first from his balcony of St. Peter's Basilica, and later appearing in the open-air popemobile to greet the worshippers. He also met with U.S. Vice President J.D. Vance. He died at his residence at Casa Santa Marta in the Vatican. Catholic tradition was followed and the pope's formal apartment at the Apostolic Palace was sealed and a "sede vacante" or vacant see was declared which is the period between the death of one pope and the election of the next. A red ribbon through the door handles was draped and then liquid wax was poured on the bow and Francis' papal seal was impressed on the wax to hold the knot. The camerlengo, Cardinal Kevin Farrell, who is in charge of the papal household and other church leaders tested the big doors to make sure they were locked tight. Pope Francis simplified the funeral rituals last year to emphasize his role as a mere bishop and allowing for burial outside the Vatican in keeping with his wishes. He wanted to be buried in the St. Mary Major Basilica across town in Rome. After every foreign trip, Francis would go to that Basilica to pray before the Byzantine-style painting that features an image of Mary, draped in a blue robe, holding the baby Jesus who is holding a jeweled golden book.

The first cardinal from Central African Republic, Dieudonné Nzapalainga, praised Pope Francis' risky trip to the war-torn county a decade ago, saying "He carried the message of hope and divine mercy." He was appointed as a cardinal by Pope Francis in 2016 as the youngest cardinal at the time. He will be coming to Rome to elect Francis' successor. Catholic archbishop of Mexico City, Carlos Aguiar Retes, wrote that the pope "leaves behind a great legacy of true love for one's neighbors." The South Sudan Council of Churches said it remembers with gratitude Francis' visit to the country and his "dedicated efforts to promote healing and unity among our leaders." To mourn Pope Francis, the Home Ministry of India will fly the India flag at half-mast on government buildings nationwide. Russian President Vladimir Putin said "the pope has done a lot of good not only for his flock, but also for the entire world." President Donald Trump signed an executive order lowering the U.S. flags to half-staff in recognition of Pope Francis' death. He said "He was a good man, he loved the world and it's an honor to do that." Francis was the Archbishop of Buenos Aires before being elected pope and Argentina postponed the country's professional soccer matches for a day due to the pope's death. Games in Italy have also been postponed. Bishops and cardinals around the United States joined in prayer and mourning following Francis' death, recalling the pope's legacy of service, prayer, and faith. The U.N. Secretary-General Antonio Guterres said Francis leaves behind "a legacy of faith, service and compassion for all – especially those left on the margins of life or trapped by the horrors of conflict."






