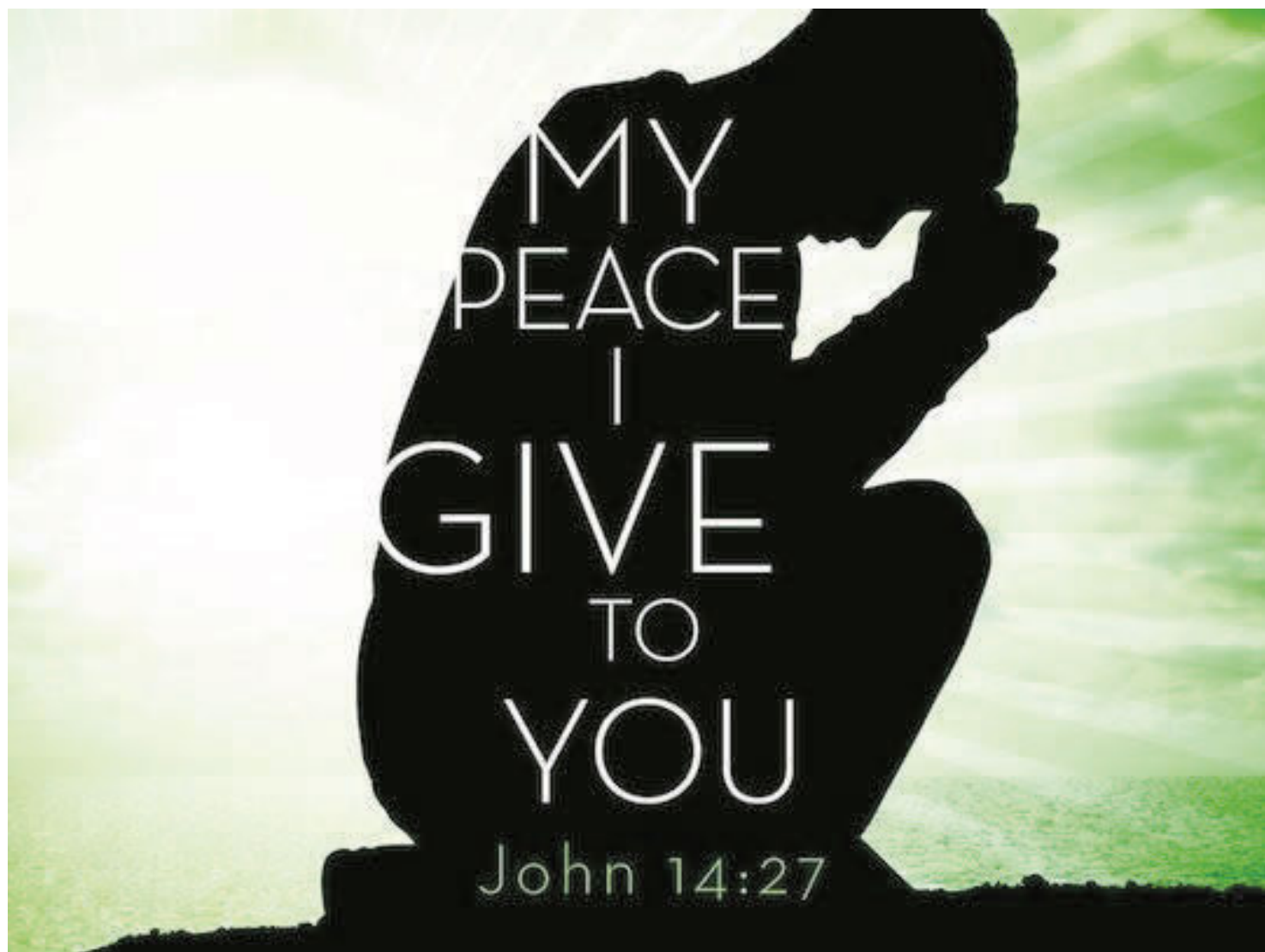

Registration will be in the RECTORY OFFICE—during regular office Hours

### Registration Requirements:

- 1.1. If this is your child's first year, a **copy of his/her Birth, Baptism** will be required at the time of registration **and First Communion Certificates** (for Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.
2. If your child has not been baptized they **MUST** be baptized before the classes start in September .
3. If this is your child's second year, **tuition for their first year must have been paid in full** and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.
4. Classes can fill up and applications are accepted on a first come basis for students that have completed all the requirements.

### Tuition Fees:

1 Child in the family **\$100.00** ~~ 2 Children in the family **\$140.00** ~~ 3 Children or more in the family **\$150.00**

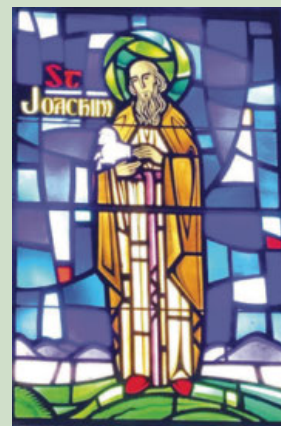

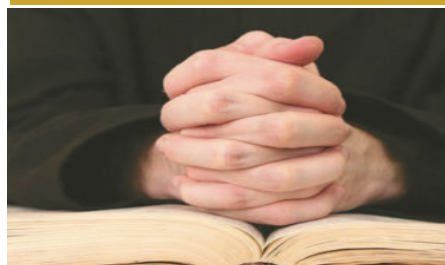

On Sunday May 18, 2025, at the formal inauguration of his pontificate, Pope Leo XIV held Mass in St. Peter's Square with approximately 100,000 people attending. There were pilgrims, presidents, patriarchs, and princes from more than 150 nations. US Vice-President JD Vance, US Secretary State Marco Rubio, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky, Prince Edward, Duke of Edinburgh, the President of Peru, Dina Boluarte, and Olga Liubimova, Russia's Culture Minister, were among the dignitaries. Pope Leo took his first tour through the piazza in the white Popemobile before Mass, smiling and waving and receiving cheers and loud applause from the crowd. During the two-hour long liturgy, at one point Leo appeared to be visibly moved when he received the two symbols of the papacy placed on him – the



the pallium the woolen stole over his shoulders and the Fisherman's ring on his finger. It was as if the responsibility of leading the entire Church had just sunk in. The pallium of lambs wool symbolizes his pastoral care for the Church as a role of shepherd to his flock. Its three pins represent the nails of Christ's crucifixion. The Ring of the Fisherman, or Piscatory Ring is a symbol of his papal authority and bears an image of St. Peter the apostle and first Pope, who was a fisherman by trade. The Ring's name also is derived from the tradition that the apostles were "fishers of men" (Mark 1:17). In the Gospel of Luke 2:32, Jesus tells Peter he must strengthen his brothers in the faith and mission. The Ring of the Fisherman thus symbolizes the duty with which the first Pope was entrusted. The ring has been part of the symbols of the papacy since at least the 13<sup>th</sup> century. It was used as a seal of authentication stamped into lead and affixed to official documents signed by the Pope until 1842 when it was replaced by a stamp. Now the Ring of the Fisherman is only used symbolically, but every Pope still has a ring. Since the Middle Ages it has been the tradition for Catholics meeting the Pope to show their devotion by kissing the Pope's ring. Pope Paul VI abolished that tradition, but it continues. The late Pope Francis discouraged the custom. A new ring is cast for each new Pope and past Popes have had rings reflecting their own tastes. Pius IX had a ring containing more than a hundred diamonds. John XXIII's ring was a simple cameo. John Paul II's ring was hammered gold. Benedict's ring was created by eight artisans working in gold. Pope Francis' ring was previously owned by the secretary to Pope Paul VI and it was silver with gold plating. When the Pope dies, his ring along with his stamp is broken or defaced before the papal conclave by the Cardinal Camerlengo in order to prevent forged documents. Pope Benedict's ring was defaced by applying two deep cuts in the shape of a cross using a chisel. Following his death, the ring and seal of Pope Francis were cut with a chisel by a laywoman in front of the College of Cardinals on May 6, 2025. There is an on-line video posted by Vatican News showing the cutting. Pope Leo XIV's ring has an image of St. Peter on the outside band with the words "Leo XIV" and his coat of arms engraved on the inside. In his homily, Pope Leo said at the inauguration Mass that he wanted to be a servant to the faithful through the two dimensions of the papacy, love and unity, so that the church could be a force for peace in the world. "Let us build a Church founded on God's love, a sign of unity, a missionary church that opens its arms to the world, proclaims the word, allows itself to be made restless by history, and becomes a haven of harmony for humanity"

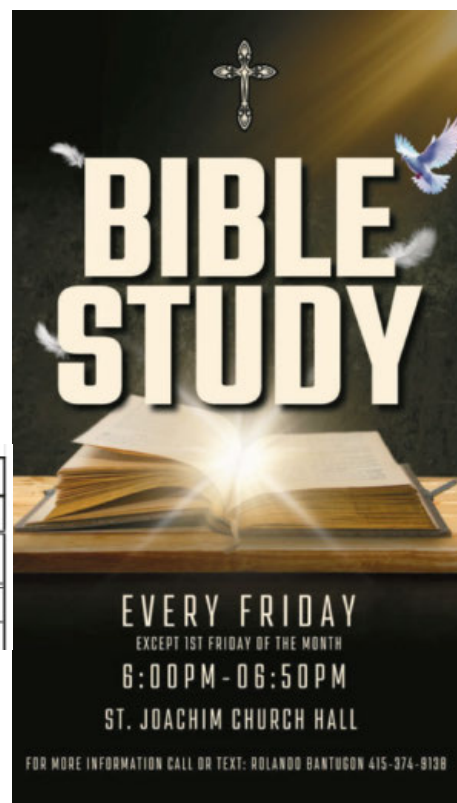

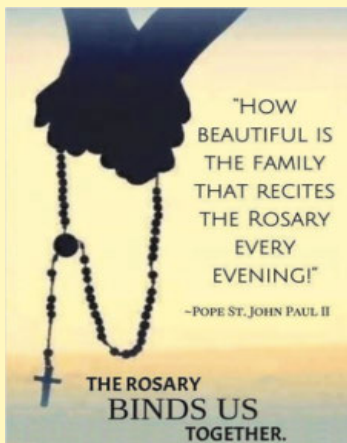
