Registration Requirements:

1.1. If this is your child's first year, a <u>copy</u> of his/her Birth, Baptism will be required at the time of registration and **First Communion Certificates** (for Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.

2. If your child has not been baptized they MUST be baptized before the classes start in September .

3. If this is your child's second year, <u>tuition for their first year must have been paid in full</u> and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.

4. Classes can fill up and applications are accepted on a first come basis for students that have completed all the requirements.



VATICAN CORNER Bishop Benoni "Don Ben"

Ambarus, who was Pope Francis' man in charge of charity and prison pastoral care in Rome, told of an act of mercy Pope Francis made in his final days. Ambarus reported to Italian media that before his death, Francis donated from his personal bank account to a pasta factory that operates in the juvenile prison - Casal del Marmo. It is the Roman prison which houses roughly 50 youth offenders aged 16 to 21, including several foreigners. It offers vocational training, contains both male and female inmates, and where Francis would sometimes visit to celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday in the chapel and wash the resident's feet. Bishop Ambarus said he told Francis "that we have a big mortgage for this pasta factory, and if we



can reduce it we will lower the price of pasta, sell more and hire more boys." He said Pope Francis replied: 'Almost all my money is finished, but I still have something in my account,' and gave him 200,000 euros (or about \$225,000). The Bishop went on to say that Pope Francis invested his last bit of energy on Holy Thursday, four days before his death to visit the prison. "I remember a tired man, whose body was frail, yet who demanded attention to the prisoners... "He (fought for) them until his last breath, that is why the prisoners saw hope in him..." Bishop Ambarus also recalled Pope Francis opening the Holy Door at the Rebibbia New Complex Prison in Rome, making it the first time a pope opened a Holy Door in a prison during a Jubilee year. The act symbolized hope and forgiveness for prisoners and a message of closeness to them. He said that after Francis' death, he received messages from people who said they now feel like orphans. Some prisoners asked him to put a flower on Francis' grave for them. He said Pope Francis called for more to be done to restore dignity to people... but there was no direct result of his appeals, like on the reduction of sentences. "A great sadness enveloped the prisoners when they realized that the institutions had done nothing, not even a small gesture." It is known that a pope's salary can be 30,000 euros a month, but Pope Francis refused to collect it throughout his papacy, and instead deferring it to various organizations, churches and others in need. Some of Pope Francis's final words before he died on Easter Monday morning April 21, 2025 were "thank you" to Massimiliano Strappetti, for bringing Francis on Easter Sunday back to St. Peters Square to make a surprise appearance in the Popemobile, touring among the tens of thousands of worshippers. The Vatican reported that Francis' health deteriorated quickly on Monday morning. He made a gesture of farewell with his hand to Mr. Strappetti and fell into a coma. "According to those who were with him in his final moments, he did not suffer. It all happened quickly. Biographer Austen Ivereigh said that Francis had a phenomenal work ethic, and the people who work with him said he had not taken a holiday since the 1970s. Argentinean priest Esteban Alfon said Francis "always had the most needy in his heart."




