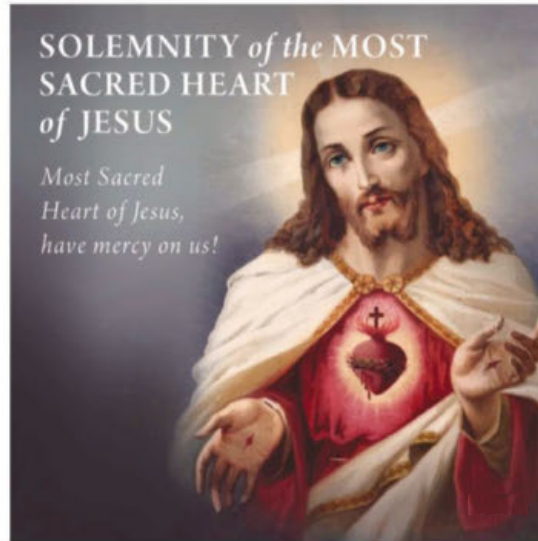

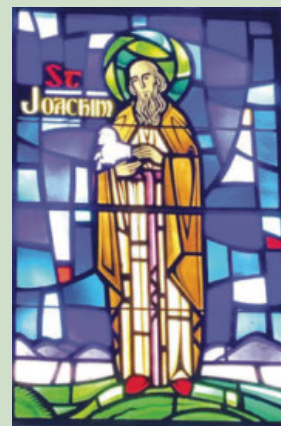

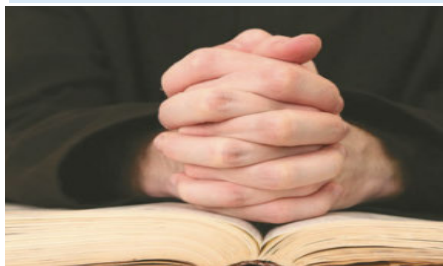

VATICAN CORNER

The origin of the use of coats of arms started in the 12th century as a way for knights to identify themselves on the battlefield. Knights wearing armor had trouble distinguish themselves from each other. They began to use unique symbols, colors and shapes on their shields, banners and the on the tunics they wore over their armor called surcoats to shield them from the sun. Those coats are where the name coat of arms comes from. Eventually the coat of arms evolved to indicate family descent, alliance, property ownership, schools, universities, churches, professions, fraternal societies and even modern corporations, in order to symbolize the meaning of their mottoes or to suggest their histories. The coat of arms of the popes has been a tradition since the middle ages. Originally they would be of his family and not unique to himself alone. But some popes did create their own using symbols to represent their past or their aspirations. In the early modern period, a man who did not have a family coat of arms would adopt one upon becoming a bishop, as men did when knighted or achieving some other title. Some men who already had a coat of arms would alter it upon being elected pope. In the mid fifteenth century, the papal tiara combined with the keys of Peter became common symbols used on the pope's coat of arms. The tiara represented the role of authority of the Pope, while crossed keys of Saint Peter represented the power to loose and bind in Heaven as on earth. Those two symbols remain on the coat of arms of the Vatican and on its city flag. Pope Leo XIV has adopted a modified version of the coat of arms that he used during his time as a cardinal and he kept the same motto. The motto on the coat of arms is "In the one Christ we are one", and it is taken from the writings of Saint Augustine and expresses the idea that Christians are united in Jesus. The coat of arms has a fleur-de-lis on a blue background, symbolizing the Virgin Mary and her purity, fidelity and spiritual beauty, while the right side displays a heart pieced by an arrow, resting on a book against a cream background. The heart represents the passionate love of God and neighbor and the arrow represents the word of God which pierces and illuminates. It is the restless heart of St. Augustine that rests only in Him. This is based on the traditional symbol of the Augustinian order. There is a three-petaled lily design on the shield representing the Holy Trinity, and it may hold personal meaning since it is a feature used historically by the French and Leo's father is of French background. The crossed keys of St. Peter, one golden (heavenly authority) and one silver (earthly authority) are intertwined with a red cord. The symbol comes from the New Testament. In the Gospel of Matthew, Simon Peter is one of the first disciples to recognize Jesus as the Messiah. Jesus responds by declaring "You are Peter and on this rock will I build my church... I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." The papal tiara is replaced by a mitre, as was Pope Francis' and Pope Benedict's coat of arms. The Pope's coat of arms is typically displayed on official documents, principal buildings, and other official publications to serve as a visual representation of the Pope's authority. It is also often placed on some of his clothing such as his white cassock and sash. A floral version of the coat of arms of Pope Leo has been completed in the Vatican Gardens on the slope in front of the Governor's Palace, descending toward St. Peter's Basilica. It replaced the one that was there for Pope Francis.

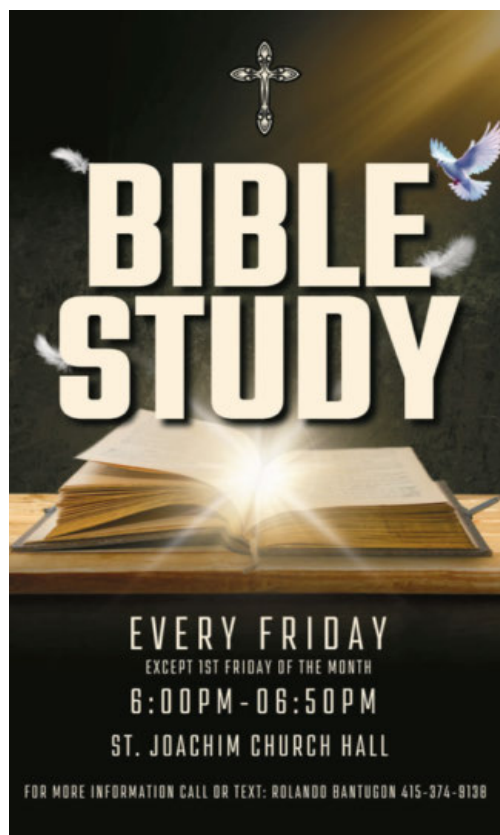

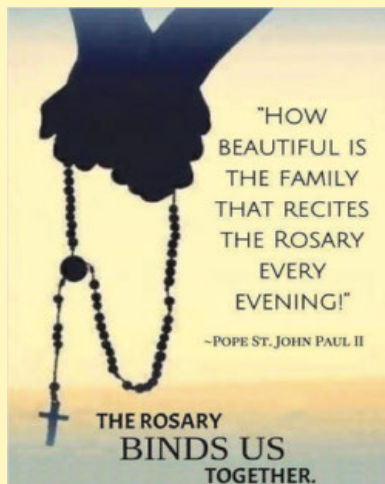
