



VATICAN CORNER

The last time Russian President

Vladimir Putin spoke with the head of the Catholic Church was on Dec. 17, 2021. That is when he wished Pope Francis a happy birthday by phone. On February 24, 2022, Russia invaded Ukraine, and from then on Putin refused to take any calls from Pope Francis. Putin did not attend Francis' funeral. On March 2023 the international Criminal Court (ICC) in Netherlands issued an arrest warrant for President Putin, which makes his travel outside Russia difficult, since Italy and 122 other countries are ICC members. In



1998, the Vatican played a role in the formation of the ICC and it contributed to the drafting of the ICC treaty. The ICC court could have focused on Russian military commanders who bombed schools. hospitals, and residential areas, but they instead focused on the deportation of Ukrainian children to Russia as an on-going war crime for which they alleged that Putin was responsible. Pope Francis sent Cardinal Zuppi to Russia to address humanitarian issues between Russia and Ukraine but was only received by a lower-level advisor to the president. However, Zuppi has been able to arrange the return of some Ukrainian children and the exchange of some prisoners of war. Pope Francis offered the Vatican as a site for talks between the two warring countries. But it has been learned that the Russians did not consider the Vatican as a serious venue for talks. One reason for this was that they thought it inappropriate for a Catholic state to be hosting two warring Eastern Orthodox states discussing their problems. Also the Vatican is surrounded by Italy a NATO members and Italy supports Ukraine and sanctioned Russia. Also Russian official cannot even fly to Italy due to Western restrictions. So on June 4, 2025, it was quite a surprising that Pope Leo and President Putin spoke by phone. It was not clear who initiated the call. Pope Leo confirmed the continued willingness for the Vatican to host talks, but Istanbul is currently holding the first direct talks between Ukraine and Russia after more than 3 years of war. Putin is not taking part. The two men talked about the humanitarian situation, the need to facilitate aid where necessary, and ongoing efforts for the exchange of prisoners. Leo urged Russia to take steps towards ending the conflict in Ukraine. The Vatican reported that "The Pope made an appeal for Russia to make a gesture that favors peace, emphasizing the importance of dialogue for achieving positive contacts between the parties and seeking solutions to the conflict." Putin thanked Leo for offering to help settle the conflict and he said that Ukraine was intent on "escalating" the war and carrying out sabotage against civilian infrastructure sites on Russian territory, describing those acts as terrorism. Putin restated that the conflict's "root causes" must be addressed, referencing the Russian demands that Ukraine adopt a neutral status and that NATO rule out eastward expansion. Pope Leo thanked Russian Orthodox Patriarch Kirill for his greeting when Leo was elected. Pope Francis had been critical of Kirill's support for Putin. Ukrainian authorities have launched criminal proceedings against many of its clergy because of suspected sympathies for Moscow. A separate Kyiv-based Ukrainian Orthodox Church formally recognized in 2019, has grown larger in Ukraine during the war. The Russians asked the Vatican to "take a more active role" in calling for freedom of religion in Ukraine for members of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church that has links to Russia. The war has so far killed 13,000 Ukrainian civilians, and estimates of 60,000 to 100,000 Ukrainian military and 170,000 to 246,000 Russian military. Both sides have launched large-scale attacks recently. Putin says he believes in God and that "God is with us." He is of the Orthodox faith and always attends services during major church holidays. There are reports that in the past he would pray daily in a small chapel next to his presidential office. But from his actions there is no reason to believe in his religious sincerity. He may be playing the religious card in order to reach out to ordinary Russians, just as Joseph Stalin did. If he really is Christian and believes in God, he must have missed the parts about "Thou shall not kill" and "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God."



Registration Requirements:

- 1.1. If this is your child's first year, a <u>copy</u> of his/her Birth, Baptism will be required at the time of registration and First Communion Certificates (for Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.
- 2. If your child has not been baptized they MUST be baptized before the classes start in September .
- 3. If this is your child's second year, <u>tuition for their first year must have been paid in full</u> and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.
- 4. Classes can fill up and applications are accepted on a first come basis for students that have completed all the requirements.




