



Registration will be in the RECTORY OFFICE—during regular office Hours

#### **Registration Requirements:**

- 1.1. If this is your child's first year, a <u>copy</u> of his/her Birth, Baptism will be required at the time of registration and First Communion Certificates (for Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.
- 2. If your child has not been baptized they MUST be baptized before the classes start in September .
- 3. If this is your child's second year, <u>tuition for their first year must have been paid in full</u> and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.
- 4. Classes can fill up and applications are accepted on a first come basis for students that have completed all the requirements.

**VATICAN CORNER** 

Soon after Pope Leo XIV (formerly known as Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost) was

elected on May 8, 2025, genealogists started researching his family tree and found that some of his ancestors on his mother's side were free people of color from the seventh ward of New Orleans, Louisiana. Alex DaPaul Lee, genealogist, said Pope Leo's great-great grandmother Celeste Lemelle was the daughter of two free people of color who married in Louisiana in 1798, and were legally classified as "quadroons", meaning a fourth African ancestry. The Creol of Loe community emerged in Louisiana from a blending of cultures there, French, Native American, Spanish, German and descendants of West African countries all cohabitated in the region during the pre-colonial



era when France and Spain owned the Louisiana territory. Documentation shows that the Lemelle family once owned enslaved people. The family's wealth came from cattle ranching and it became one of the most prominent Creole families of the time before the Civil War. Genealogist DaPaul Lee said it was likely that Pope Leo's family was part of the first wave who migrated north in the early 1900. By moving north, people would have had more job opportunities and better civil liberties. "Considering the fact that many of these families passed for white in Chicago meant they were going to have more success, regardless, because of their appearance." Lee said it's notable that the Pope's racial background reflects the diverse blends of cultures that have historically merged to form the unique identity of Louisiana. The Pope's ancestry represents a more inclusive view of what it means to be a Catholic, and what it means to be an American with Louisiana Creole ties. This is more than just genealogy, it's a legacy." A team led by Harvard historian Henry Louis Gates Jr., (who is the host of PBS' program Finding Your Roots) dug deeper into Pope Leo's ancestry, all the way back to the 16th century. Historian Gates said the findings of his team astounded him, and said Pope Leo's multicultural background is 'One of the most diverse family trees we have ever created." So far he and his team identified Pope Leo's forbears from France (40), Italy (24), Spain (21) the United States (22), Cuba (10), Canada (6), Haiti (1) and Guadeloupe (1). Gates said there were African slaves and slaveowners, two freedom fighters and several distantly related celebrities. Pope Leo is ninth cousins, various times removed, with Pierre and Justin Trudeau, Hillary Clinton, Angelina Jolie, Justin Bieber, Jack Kerouac, and Madonna. While doing the research the team came across interesting origins of the Prevost surname which involved a marital scandal that was published in the local newspapers at the time. The Pope's paternal grandfather, Salvatore Giovanni Gaetano Riggitano (1876-1960), immigrated to the United States from Sicily in 1903 and became a teacher of languages, particularly Italian, French and Spanish. He married Daisy Hughes in Chicago. The marriage may not have been witnessed by a priest. Less than three years later, in March 1917, wife Daisy Hughes Riggitano had her husband arrested on suspicion of adultery, which at the time was not only illegal but civilly punishable. Giovanni's brother-in-law told the newspaper that it was all a misunderstanding. Suzanne Fontaine the young woman was also arrested. She had emigrated from France and eventually moved to Chicago. What happened in the legal case against Giovanni and Suzanne isn't clear, but about four months after the arrests, Suzanne gave birth to a boy in a home for unwed mothers. She gave birth again three years later to a boy named Louis, who would later become Pope Leo's father. Giovanni and Suzanne lived together for the rest of Giovanni's life – about 40 years. Both took the name Prevost – Suzanne's mother's maiden name and gave that name to their two sons. Whatever the origins of their relationship, Giovanni and Suzanne lived as Catholics and raised their two boys as Catholics. The older boy died in 1996 and the younger boy became father of Pope Leo. Msgr. Charles Pope, said about the Pope's ancestry. "It is interesting that his name is Prevost and he carries it as a legacy of an unchaste union. Nevertheless, God can make a way out of no way and write straight with the crooked lines of our lineage." A saying: genealogy is like a magic mirror. 


