



VATICAN CORNER

On July 3, 2025 at a private meeting at the

Pontifical Villas in Castel Gandolfo, Pope Leo XIV was presented with a donation of two custom-built compact, eco-friendly electric vehicles to help him during his apostolic trips abroad. The vehicles are designed to be very maneuverable in tight spaces with lots of people, such as squares, shrines or urban centers. The vehicles were developed by the Danish company Garia (part of the Club Car



Group) with Italian distributor Exelentia, and are designed to travel in planes on long-haul flights without the vehicle needing to be taken apart. ITA Airways on which Pope's travel on many of their trips, helped with the technical and dimensional requirements. The Vatican Gendarmerie Corps which provides security teams on international visits were also part of the development team. A press release said the vehicle used a combination of innovative engineering, high-level mechanical and electronic manufacturing, and expert craftsmanship to produce a fully electric vehicle with maximum efficiency, agility and security, that emits no noise or pollutants. A front handle and lateral supports under the armrests offer the Pope secure grips and improved comfort when boarding and exiting the vehicle. Mercedes-Benz gave Pope Francis a new electric popemobile in December 2024, on the occasion of the 2025 Jubilee. It was a one-of-a kind vehicle tailored specifically for Francis' needs. The previous popemobile was a gasoline-powered G-Class Mercedes which he used for his weekly General Audiences, riding up and down the aisles between the people in St. Peter's Square. A team of specialist from different Mercedes locations worked for almost a year with representatives from the Vatican to build a car to fit the Pope's needs. One of the main priorities was zero emissions, as the Vatican plans to convert all its vehicles to emission-free by 2030 – the same goal that Mercedes has. The new electric car has a rotating seat, handcrafted interior furnishings and all-wheel drive, designed for low speed trips through St. Peter's Square. It also has a retractable roof to protect the Pope from the elements. In 2017 Lamborghini gave the Pope a \$950,000 Huracán supercar. He didn't drive it, but blessed and signed it before auctioning it off for charity. A number of charitable causes personally chosen by the Pope were given a portion of the auction's proceeds. Car manufacturers sometimes give vehicles to the Vatican or the Pope for various reasons. They may be trying to promote their technological advancements, and it is an opportunity for companies to showcase their commitment to sustainable mobility and highlight the features of their models. Donating cars for Merceds-Benz is a symbolic gestures and a continuation of a tradition acknowledging their close relationship with the Vatican. Gifting cars to the Vatican is also done to support charitable endeavors. Often cars are given as gifts knowing that they will probably be auctioned off to raise money for charitable purposes. But possibly the biggest reason for giving cars to the Vatican is the tremendous amount of free advertising.
