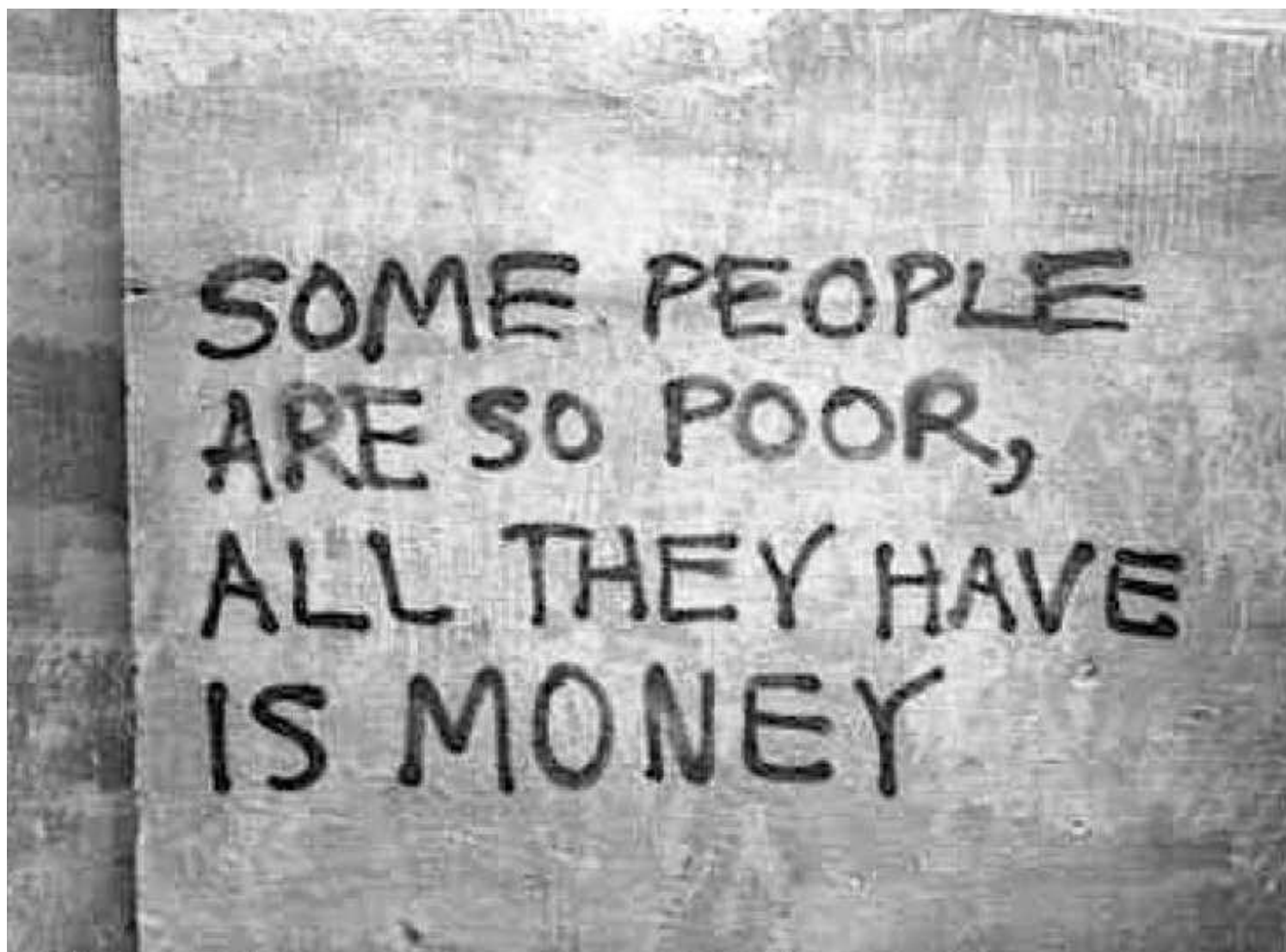

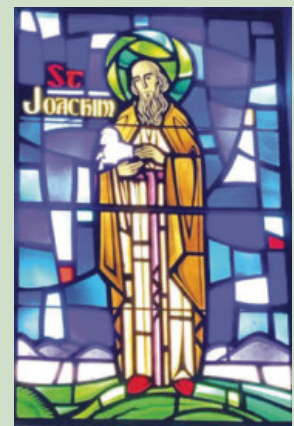

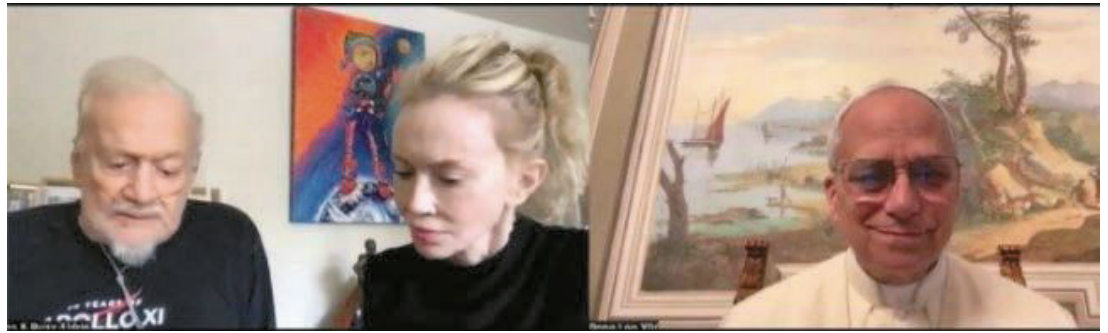

VATICAN CORNER

On July 20, 2025, Pope Leo XIV while on vacation at the summer papal residence, at Castel Gandolfo, visited the Vatican Observatory. He met with the team of



Jesuit astronomers and scientist who work there. Pope Leo showed great interest in how the observatory's double astrograph telescope worked to take plate-glass photographs of the night sky. He visited the observatory's refractor telescope and asked for it to be positioned to point at a particular spot for him to look through it. On that same day, at 8:56 PM PST, 56 year earlier, Commander Neil Armstrong took the first steps on the Moon. It was the Apollo 11 mission, which had astronaut Michael Collins circling the Moon in the command module, while astronauts Neil Armstrong and Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin landed on the moon's surface in the Lunar Module Eagle. Pope Leo celebrated that anniversary by making a video-call to Buzz Aldrin (95), the last surviving member of that astronaut crew. Pope Leo was 13 years old at that time of the moon landing. Aldrin shared with Pope Leo his memory of that historic achievement. They reflected together on Psalm 8 which is a hymn of praise to God that is about the astonishing contract between the vastness and majesty of God's creation and the relative insignificance of humanity, yet God's deliberate choice to elevate humanity and grant them dominion over the earth. St. Pope Paul VI was the Pope at that time of the moon landing, and he dedicated Psalm 8 to the Apollo 11 astronauts. The Psalm was written out and to be left on the moon by the astronauts, along with messages from Heads of State of many UN countries. A few minutes after the lunar touch-down, Pope Paul VI sent a message to the astronauts blessing the successful Moon-landing in the Vatican's tradition of supporting science, astronomy and the application of human reason. The Apollo 11 mission also had a quiet ceremony just before touchdown on the moon. With the permission of NASA officials, Aldrin, a Presbyterian elder, had asked for a moment of silence and consumed some wine and bread from his personal kit celebrating Communion. During the return flight to Earth, Aldrin read two verses of Psalm 8 from the King James Bible in a radio communication. Pope Leo and Aldrin together on the anniversary video-call "reflected on the mystery of creation, its greatness and its fragility," A picture of the Pope and Aldrin with his wife, Anca Faur was taken during the video-call and released by the Vatican Press Office. Aldrin posted on his X account "Anca and I were grateful and touched to receive the highest blessing today, from His Holiness, Pope Leo XIV on the 56th Anniversary of the Apollo 11 moon landing." Aldrin wrote "What an honor! We prayed for good health, long life, and prosperity for all humankind." The Vatican Museums has on display a Vatican flag that was carried to the moon by that same Apollo 11 mission. It is on display in a showcase along with a few fragments of lunar rocks. A small museum plaque reads: "This flag traveled to the Moon and returned with Apollo 11, and these fragments of the lunar surface were brought back to Earth by the first crew to reach the Moon." The flag was present to Pope Paul VI by US President Richard Nixon during his second visit to the Vatican on September 29, 1970, following a first meeting with the Italian pope on March 2, 1969. President Nixon, a Quaker was concerned by what he saw as overtures of the Vatican toward Communist regimes. Inflated by the worldwide enthusiasm generated by the Moon mission, which enabled the United States to assert its technological and cultural supremacy over the rival Soviet Union, Nixon thus sought to anchor the Papacy with the U.S. and Western bloc countries with his visits (and gifts?). 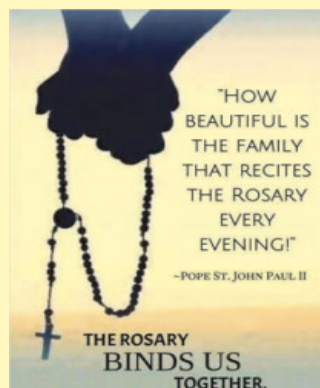
