

## PASTORS CORNER

### Dear Friends and Family of St. Mark's,

After the ordinations of both Father Tim and Deacon Ed, and the celebrations of their first Masses, let's reflect for a moment on the importance of Holy Mass in general: 1. The Mass is Calvary continued.

2. Every Mass is worth as much as the sacrifice of Our Lord's life, sufferings and death. **St. Padre Pio,** the great stigmatic priest, said the world could exist more easily without the sun than without the Mass.

3. At Mass we kneel amidst a multitude of holy angels, who are present at the adorable

Sacrifice with reverential awe. As revealed by Our Lord to **St. Gertrude the Great**, each time you even look at The Most Blessed Sacrament your place in Heaven is raised forever.

4. Assisting devoutly at Holy Mass you render to the sacred humanity of Our Lord the greatest homage. **St. Pope Paul VI** said that *"The Mass is the most perfect form of prayer!"* And did you know that our prayers are strongest (most effective) at the Consecration in Holy Mass (ie. the raising of Host and Chalice).

5. Being the Holy Sacrifice of Calvary re-presented, the Holy Mass is the most powerful atonement for our sins. 6. God forgives the venial sins we may not have confessed. The power of Satan over us is thus diminished and we are strengthened to resist mortal sins.

7. God supplies for our negligence and many omissions.

8. Besides receiving the Word of God and Jesus' Body and Blood, we receive God's blessing and are surrounded/protected by His grace. *We receive the priest's blessing which Our Lord ratifies in Heaven. Therefore never leave Mass early, skipping out before the final blessing!* 

9. We are blessed in our temporal goods and affairs.

10. We are preserved from dangers and misfortunes which otherwise might have befallen us.

11. We can afford the souls in Purgatory the greatest possible relief. They in their turn, once released by your prayers in the Mass, will pray for us!

12. One Mass heard during life will be of more benefit than many offered after our death. A great doctor of the Church, **St. Anselm,** declares that a single Mass offered for oneself during life may be worth more than a thousand celebrated for the same intention after death.

13. In eternity, we shall fully realize that it was certainly worthwhile to have assisted at Holy Mass (daily if possible).

14. It was revealed by Our Lord to **St. Gertrude the Great** that for each Mass we celebrate with devotion, Our Lord sends a saint to comfort us at the hour of our death.

15. At the hour of death, the Masses we have celebrated will be our greatest consolation.

16. Every Mass we every attended with love and fervor will go with us to judgment and plead for our pardon. At Mass one can diminish more or less the temporal punishment due to our sins, according to our fervor. In other words, we can shorten our time in Purgatory.

17. Every Mass wins for us a higher degree of glory in Heaven.

18. The **Blessed Virgin Mary** once told Her faithful servant Alan: "My Son so loves those who assist at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass that, if it were necessary He would die for them as many times as they've heard Masses." 19. Once, **St. Teresa of Avila,** overwhelmed with a sense of God's Goodness, asked Our Lord, "How can I thank you?" Our Lord replied, "ATTEND ONE MASS."

20. This is why, above all, the devil wants us to miss Mass, even one Sunday, so that in missing more and more Masses, it will quickly become a habit so that we may fall away altogether, becoming easy prey. Separating ourselves from the Mass, in effect we are distancing ourselves from Christ and God's grace and protection.

21. The **Cure d'Ars, St. Jean Vianney,** once stated that if we knew the value of the Mass we would die of joy. The Holy Mass, in summary, is the cause of our Joy. Where Jesus is present, there is true JOY—joy that will last forever in the heavenly banquet, but beginning now in the Holy Mass.

22. So we pray for ourselves, our loved ones (that they continue to be faithful and/or return to Mass) and especially for all priests, that together, we may always offer the Holy Mass with an ever-growing reverence and love.




