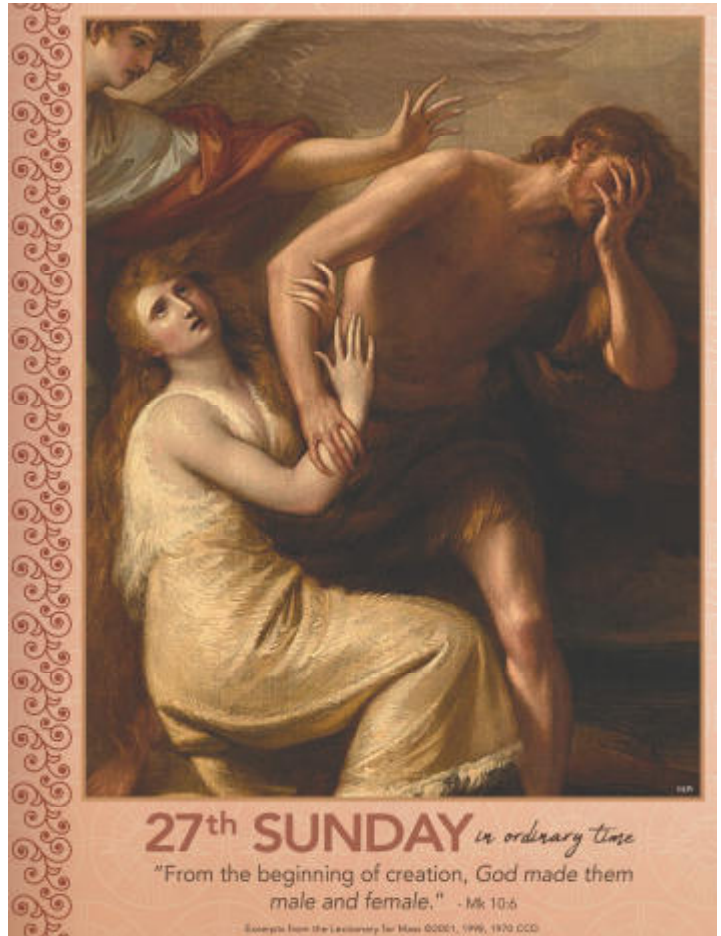

What Marriage is and is not

In today's Gospel, we have Christ's explicit teaching on marriage and divorce, the divine origin of marriage, the sacredness of family life and the indissolubility of marriage. These are difficult messages to preach in a society that embraces co-habitation and ignores both the escalating divorce statistics and the dangerous consequences of divorce. The Gospel teaches that family life is sacred, that husband and wife are partners with equal rights and that the destruction of the family by divorce will result in the destruction of society.

Marriage is the Sacrament, instituted by Jesus Christ, to give the couple the powerful grace that makes it possible for them to live as one. The Sacrament of Reconciliation makes it possible for them to forgive each other, just as the Holy Eucharist directs them with the real presence of Christ. No written contract, or judge's decision can change that.
