A widow clutching two almost worthless coin, gives what she could.

But that's not the only difference this nameless widow made. She has touched the entire Christian world, and she continues to touch our minds and souls today.

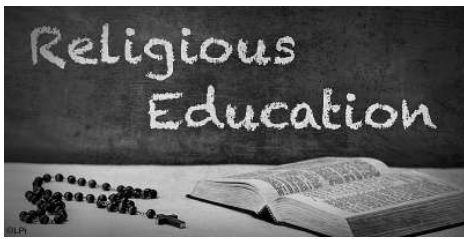
