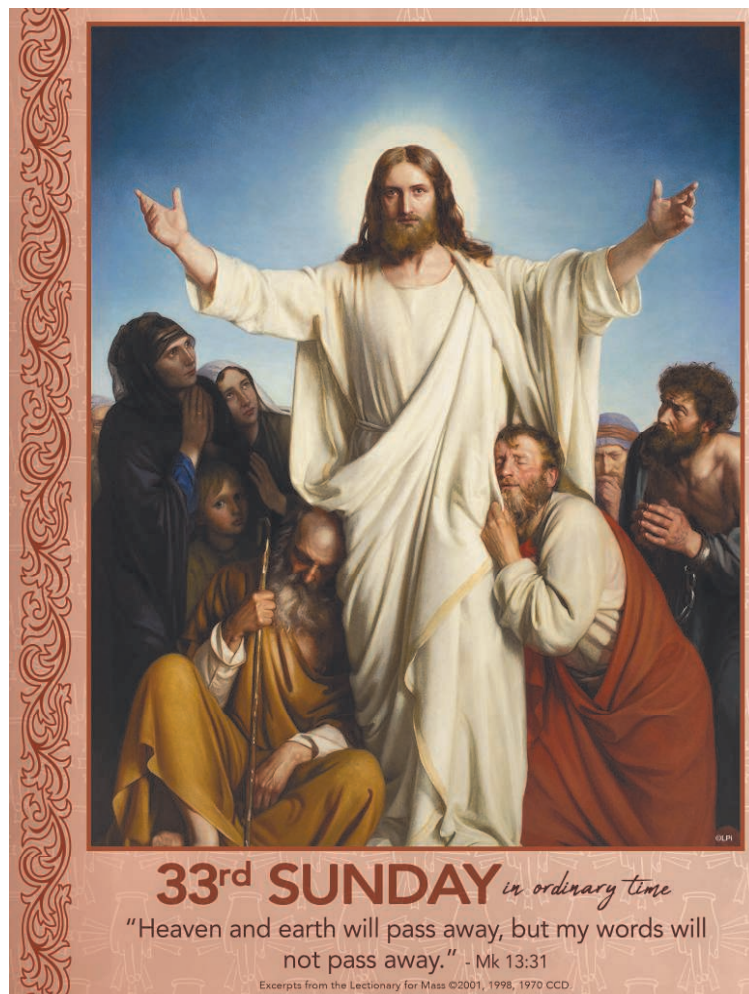

The End Time

In *today's* Gospel reading Jesus foretells the future. He says that there will be a time of tribulation, the sun will darken and the stars will fall from the sky and the powers in the heavens will be shaken.

As people of faith, we should not be consumed with fear – for these signs tell us of his Second Coming. Jesus, the Son of God, became incarnate for our salvation. It is by faith in Christ that we are saved. HE will come and “send out the angel to gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth, to the ends of the sky.”

We are called to be the elect that his angels will come to gather up to God. Can we do this on our own? No, that would be impossible. But with God and by regularly going to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we can be forgiven of our sins every time we fail and fall. With this kind of trust in Jesus – we can stay prepared for his second coming.

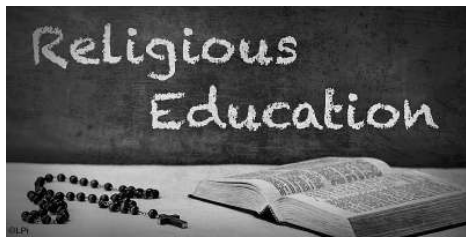

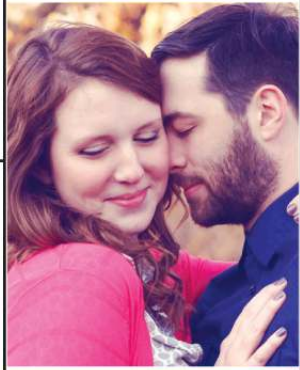
