Excerpts from the Lectionary for Mass ©2001, 1990, 1970 OCD.

The central theme of today's readings is **God's call to a person**, and the positive response to this call which leads the person to discipleship.

Isaiah in the first reading, Paul in the second, and Peter in today's Gospel express their unworthiness to be in the presence of God's great holiness. It was by giving these three men a strong conviction of their unworthiness and of their need for total dependence on His grace that God prepared them for their missions.

Today's readings tell us that God has His own criteria for selecting people to be prophets and ministers. Presenting the special calls, or vocations, of Isaiah, Paul and Peter as life-changing events, the readings challenge us to examine our own personal calls to conversion and discipleship.

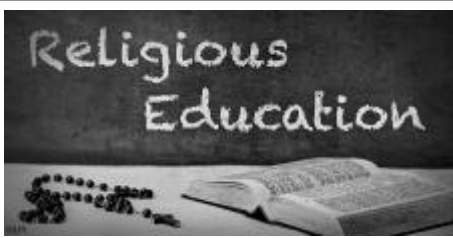
## Script ordering
