Excerpts from the Lectionary for Mass ©2001, 1998, 1970 CCD.

The entire life of Jesus, from his birth to his death on the cross, is according to the overall plan of God for the salvation of the world. That is why, in **today's** Gospel, Jesus is "resolutely determined to journey to Jerusalem." He goes to Jerusalem, not as a tourist or visitor. He is going there solely to accomplish the plan of the Father. It is there that He will undergo sufferings and death and offer His life for the salvation of mankind. No one can change His decision to follow His Father's will, not the hostility of the Samaritans, and not even the objections of Peter and the pleadings of His disciples. The actions of Jesus was a strong lesson for all His followers. Obedience to the will of God is prompt, absolute and non-negotiable. In the Gospel, Jesus challenges His disciples to imitate His example. He invites everyone to follow Him. But following Him is not that simple and easy.

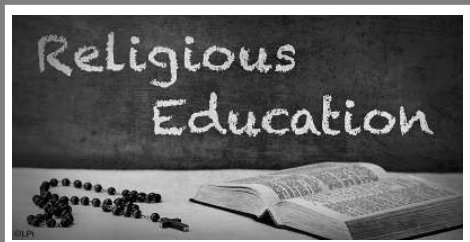
