What more can be said?

Of all of the teachings of Jesus the parable of the Good Samaritan is undoubtedly the most famous, known to Christians and non-Christians alike.

A man, identified only as "a certain man", is attacked, left for dead, naked and bleeding on the side of the road. A Temple priest comes along, moves to the other side of the road, continuing on his journey. Levite who assists in the Temple, does the same as the priest. The Samaritan not only goes over to the injured man but cleans his wounds. The hated enemy is the compassionate neighbor in this parable.

Once, when Jesus was asked what the Greatest Commandment was, he say "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first commandment. The second is like it: " You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

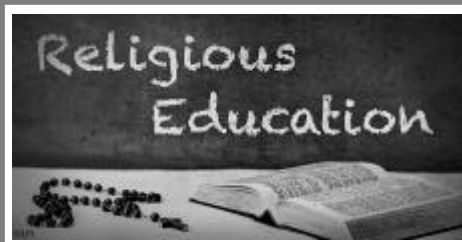

Welcome Fr. Frank!

Fr. Francisco Javier Quezada was born on April 17, 1958 in Corpus Christi, Texas. He is often referred to as Fr. Frank or Fr. Quezada by parishioners, colleagues and friends.

Fr. Quezada first entered the seminary at the age of 15 and graduated from St. Anthony High School Seminary in San Antonio, Texas in 1976. He was ordained a priest on January 9, 1988.

Fr. Quezada established the Diocesan Office of Hispanic Ministry after serving as Pastor at Our Lady of Guadalupe.

In 2007 Bishop Sheridan appointed him as Vicar for Hispanic Ministry and Pastor of St. Mary Cathedral. He has served as President of the National Association of Hispanic Priests and a Consultant on the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' Committee on Clergy a member of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulcher and Knights of Columbus.

Father also served at St Mark in Highlands Ranch before taking some time to return to Texas for a while to be close to his family and came back this year to serve at Corpus Christi. With the departure of Fr. Jaimes Ponce, Fr. Frank now serves St. Benedict and St. Michael parishes as Parochial Administrator.

One of his favorite saints is Teresa of Avila and has a particular devotion to the Mother of Our Lord Mary! He makes it a personal task as priest to invite others to consider the priesthood.
