Using the master- thief parable Jesus warns us to be on our guard so that the thief- the devil - may not steal our treasure of divine grace by his temptations.

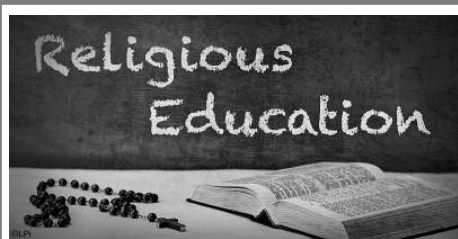
