FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

MINIATURES ON THE MASS

Sacred silence also, as part of the celebration, is to be observed at the designated times. Its purpose, however, depends on the time it occurs in each part of the celebration. Thus, within the Act of Penitence and again after the invitation to pray, all recollect themselves; but at the conclusion of a reading or the homily, all meditate briefly on what they have heard; then after Communion, they praise and pray to God in their hearts. Even before the celebration itself, it is commendable that silence be observed in the church, in the sacristy, in the vesting room, and in adjacent areas, so that all may dispose themselves to carry out the sacred action in a devout and fitting manner. (General Instruction on the Roman Missal, 45)

FRONT ENTRANCE

For some time now, a group of parishioners has been working on a more permanent sign for the front entrance. The plans have been finalized, and we are working with a company who in turn, are seeking the necessary permits. The sign—actually, a pair of signs—will flank the front entrance. Some landscaping will be necessary, and we will be able to remove the orange barrels and the old plywood signs.

Additionally, we are beginning to look at a more final plan for our property and the construction of the permanent church and buildings. Let us entrust all of this to the intercession of St. Benedict!

For the last three Thursdays, we have seen parishioners come and spend time with our Eucharistic Lord either privately, as a couple, with friends, or as a family. What a consolation to the heart of Christ. Remember the words he spoke to St. Faustina: **“My heart overflows with great mercy for souls (...). If only they could understand that I am the best of Fathers to them and that it is for them that the Blood and Water flowed from My Heart as from a fountain overflowing with mercy. For them I dwell in the tabernacle as the King of Mercy. I desire to bestow My graces upon souls, but they do not want to accept them (...). Oh, how indifferent are souls to so much goodness, to so many proofs of love! (...). They have time for everything, but they have no time to come to Me for graces.”** (Diary, 367)
