

#### ASK FATHER

Dear Father,

Why do you mix water and wine in the chalice and what are you saying when you that? Thank you.—C

Dear C.

The co-mingling or mixing together of the water and wine in the chalice is very ancient. It is believed that Christ himself used wine tempered with water at the Last Supper since this was common practice among the Jews & in Mediterranean culture in general. St. Justin Martyr makes mention of it in his Apology written around the year 150 A.D. Although the water is not essential for the validity of the sacrament, it is highly symbolic. As Pope Alexander I writes: "In the Lord's chalice neither wine only nor water only ought to be offered, but both mixed because we read that both flowed from His side in the Passion." The words of the Roman Missal to be said by the ordained minister as he mixes the water and wine are also indicative: "By the mystery of this water and wine may we come to share in the divinity of Christ who humbled himself to share in our humanity."

#### FAMILY ROSARY NIGHT

October is month of the rosary with the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary being on October 7. Known for several centuries by the alternate title of "Our Lady of Victory," the feast day takes place in honor of a 16th-century naval victory which secured Europe against Turkish invasion. Pope St. Pius V attributed the victory to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, who was invoked on the day of the battle through a campaign to pray the Rosary throughout Europe. Here at St. Benedict we will celebrate this month of the rosary with Family Rosary Night on October 10 at 6:00pm. Please mark your calendars and stay tuned for details.


