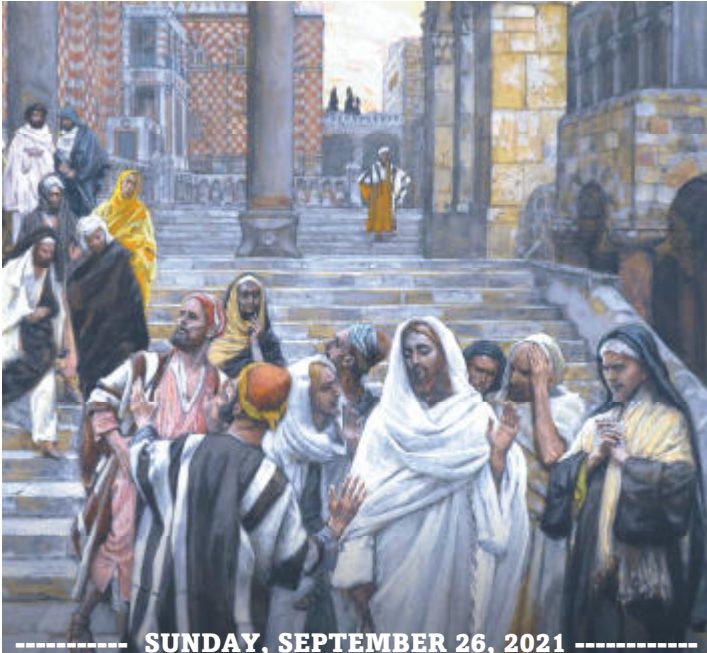

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

A PASTOR'S HEART

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On Tuesday, September 14, the Falcon area experienced a heavy hailstorm which brought several inches of hail followed by rain. Between our three buildings, we experienced fourteen leaks as water backed up on our roofs. A few hours later, five parish groups held meetings using the church, the narthex, the John Paul II room, and three rooms in our Pastoral Center.

As a pastor, my heart is often saddened and troubled that we do not have the space we need to accommodate our activities. But I was truly moved to see the patience and enthusiasm of the various groups walking slalom fashion around buckets and towels on the floor. The Pastoral Council, Women's Group, Troops of St. George, Little Flowers, and Little Women all found their spaces and carried out their activities. Then the dads from the Troops ran the wet-vacuum and got down on their hands and knees with towels to sop up water in the church and in the main office. We are so blessed as a parish family. I am so grateful to everyone.

Brothers and Sisters, not a day goes by that I do not feel the responsibility of our future and the urgent need for us to build. We need to overcome our mortgage which stands at \$369,891.51 and continue to grow our Building Fund which currently stands at \$68,758.73.

I hope you share my dream of building the final church on our property. I am posting a concept of this dream on our bulletin board. If anyone has a few million dollars to spare, now is the time to let me know! Meanwhile, we will entrust ourselves to the Merciful Lord and ask him for continued patience and a robust family spirit.

If we love Our Lord Jesus Christ, His Mother, St. Benedict our patron, and if we immerse ourselves in the beauty of the liturgy, the life of the sacraments, the traditions, the customs of our beloved Catholic Faith, and the exercise of Merciful Love, we will have everything we could ever desire in this world.

I ask for your prayers that I may be a shepherd after the heart of Jesus Christ the Eternal Priest and that I may not hesitate to spend myself for as long as God may keep me among you.
