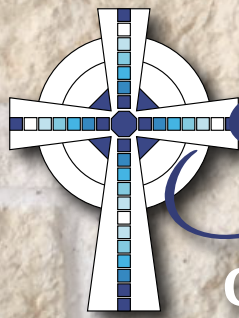

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

I have much more to tell you. (John 16:12)

Had Jesus run out of time? Why didn't he tell his disciples everything he had in mind? Had the Last Supper taken too long?

No, Jesus' timing was always perfect. He knew his hour had come—it hadn't snuck up on him. And he was always ready for whatever he had to do. Rather, Jesus had "much more" to teach his disciples because they weren't ready to hear it. They couldn't understand everything yet. They needed time and experience—and a lot of help from the Holy Spirit.

Like those disciples, we have much more to learn. We don't quite comprehend a lot of what Jesus teaches, and we need the Spirit's help to live out the things that we do understand. Take today's feast of the Holy Trinity as a classic example. Every Sunday we proclaim that we believe in one God in three divine Persons: the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. But the Trinity is a mystery we will never fully comprehend. Jesus certainly has a lot he can teach us—about the Trinity and so much more. He unfolds these mysteries for us over our lifetime, as we seek him and open ourselves to the Spirit.

How blessed we are! Jesus loves to reveal his truths to us, and he offers us everything we need to understand him. He has overcome the sin that clouds our minds and hinders us from seeking and knowing God. Not only that, but he has given us the Spirit, who lives in us and helps us understand the truths of our faith. And he has given us the Church, where we receive the Scriptures, the sacraments, and brothers and sisters who love us. All these things help to reveal more and more to us about the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

There's always more to learn from the Lord. Jesus is ready. Are you?

"Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, teach me your ways."

The Mystery of the Holy Trinity

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and life. God reveals himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The doctrine of the Trinity includes three truths of faith.

First, the Trinity is One. We do not speak of three gods but of one God. Each of the Persons is fully God. They are a unity of Persons in one divine nature.

Second, the Divine Persons are distinct from each other. Father, Son, and Spirit are not three appearances or modes of God, but three identifiable persons, each fully God in a way distinct from the others. Third, the Divine Persons are in relation to each other.

The distinction of each is understood only in reference to the others. The Father cannot be the Father without the Son, nor can the Son be the Son without the Father. The Holy Spirit is related to the Father and the Son who both send him forth.

All Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. The Trinity illumines all the other mysteries of faith.

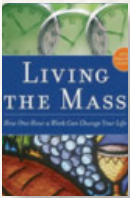
FAMILY LIFE

Letters from a Monastery: *Contemplata aliis tradere*

"God's Loving Call"

We so often hear or see the word "vocation" in the Church today (and I'm afraid you are going to see it a lot in this letter). There has been an increased emphasis on vocation in recent decades, due in large part to the pastoral care of St. John Paul II. We do so much to foster vocations in our parishes today, and thanks be to God. But I fear that, as with all things familiar, we as Catholics have become rather desensitized; "vocation" seems to have lost some of its meaning. And so, I want to take this opportunity to answer one important question: What really is a vocation?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines vocation as "the calling or destiny we have in this life and hereafter." It adds, "God has created the human person to [know,] love, and serve Him; the fulfillment of this vocation is eternal happiness." God made us to know Him and love Him, so as to manifest His glory and have us share in it. God is, therefore, at all times and in all places calling all people to Himself. This is, in part, what the Second Vatican Council described as the "universal call to holiness," and rightly so, for we are all called to holiness. We each are called to a personal relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

God calls us individually because He loves us as His beloved sons and daughters. The love of God is the most fundamental truth of our lived experience. Everything in life – and I mean everything, good and bad – should be understood within the greater context of God's unending love. We must believe that whatever God gives or permits in our lives is meant only to draw us closer to Himself.

One's particular vocation should be understood principally as an intimate expression of God's love. For when God calls us, He is not only calling us to Himself, He is also calling us out of ourselves, out of our cruel prisons of pride and self-love. Our vocations free us from our dark, selfish vision for life by drawing us into the light of God's loving plan of redemption.

Our vocations are so important because through our free cooperation with God's grace, we continue His work of salvation; we continue to build up His Kingdom and bring souls to Heaven. Whatever our vocation, its purpose is to bring glory to God and souls to Heaven. Nothing is more important than that.

But before we can even consider our vocation, we must first accept God's love. One's vocation only truly begins to unfold when one accepts the love of Christ into his or her heart. And to accept Christ's love we must first believe in Christ's love. We must believe in God's love! How could we possibly take God up on His offer if we don't truly believe He loves us? Many people fear that by giving their lives to God and living as faithful Catholics, either in religious life or married life, they are somehow forfeiting their happiness or freedom. If only they knew how wrong they are! If only they knew the joy of the Christian life! God's love – and only God's love – will make us truly happy. Jesus Himself said, "As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you; abide in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love...These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be complete" (John 15:9-11). Take Jesus at His word! Listen to Him when He calls you, and believe in your heart that He only desires your happiness, both in this life and in the next.

How do we hear God's call? Simple. Through a life of prayer. In my next letter, I hope to explain how we can better "hear" God's voice in prayer.
