

20TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing! (Luke 12:49)

Jesus' words about setting the earth on fire can be confusing even frightening. It might remind us of a forest fire that consumes everything in its path. It's true that fire in Scripture often symbolizes the purifying presence and judgment of God. But fire also represents the Holy Spirit, particularly in the Gospel of Luke and the Book of Acts.



In Luke, John the Baptist prophesies that the Messiah will come to "baptize you with the holy Spirit and fire" (3:16). And Jesus does just that. Just before his ascension, he tells his disciples, "I am sending the promise of my Father upon you" and "You will be baptized with the Holy Spirit" (Luke 24:49; Acts 1:5). He then fulfills that promise on Pentecost when the Spirit comes upon them like "tongues as of fire" (Acts 2:3).

Jesus longed with all his heart for the Holy Spirit to fill his disciples and the whole earth! He couldn't wait to see the fire of the Spirit blazing forth and bringing light to every dark corner of the world. This was why he came; it was the goal of his entire mission. It's why he would endure the "baptism" of his passion and death (Luke 12:50).

Jesus' heart burns with love for us, and he wants his Spirit to fill us with that love. Like fire, the Spirit changes everything he touches. His fire will warm our hearts so they burn with love for him and the people around us. His fire will purify our hearts so we will want to live holy lives that please the Lord. And his fire will enflame our hearts with a passion to tell everyone about the love of Jesus.

Jesus wants that transforming power to blaze in each of us until it fills the whole earth. So together let's pray,

"Come, Holy Spirit! Set my heart on fire."



Spiritual Adoption Program



Each August, we offer parishioners an opportunity to "spiritually adopt" a baby in danger of being aborted. This is a powerful and beautiful way to promote a culture of life in a world in which abortion continues to remain legal in many states in our country and in other countries across the globe.

There is a child, known only to God, who has just been conceived. This child is in danger of losing his or her life. His mom may be under great pressure from circumstances,

parents, boyfriend or husband. Pray for life. Pray for the life of this baby who has not yet been born. Pray for the parents of this child, that their hearts are open to the miracle of life.

Will you spiritually adopt this child and pray every day for nine months? Pray that his or her life will be spared and that the mother of this child will find the support she needs to choose life and plan for a safe and happy home for her child.

Prayer is powerful! Praying for a specific child may help you be more faithful in your own prayer. Prayer cards are available at the Hospitality Desk and at the exits of the church, with the short prayer printed below. You are encouraged to name the baby you adopt.

Each month, from September to May, on the 4th Sunday of the month, a picture and description of the child's development will be included in the bulletin and on the Respect Life Spiritual Adoption page of the St. Laurence website. In May, we will celebrate the birth of your spiritually adopted child with a baby shower to benefit needy mothers and their children.

"Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of (name), the unborn baby that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion."

THIS MONTH: Conception

The mother's egg and the father's sperm have united to form a new, unique human being, made in the image of God. This child, although only a single cell, is already male or female, with all the genetic information to direct his or her development. Hair color and family resemblance have already been determined! God has a plan for this child, a mission for him or her to carry out to build his kingdom. He or she will be a gift to family, friends, to all the world. Will he be a doctor, to bring healing and comfort? Will she be a wonderful teacher to help children develop their potential? Will he or she be a loving and devoted spouse and parent to his/her own children? Only God knows what He has planned for this child – but first he or she must survive to be born!






