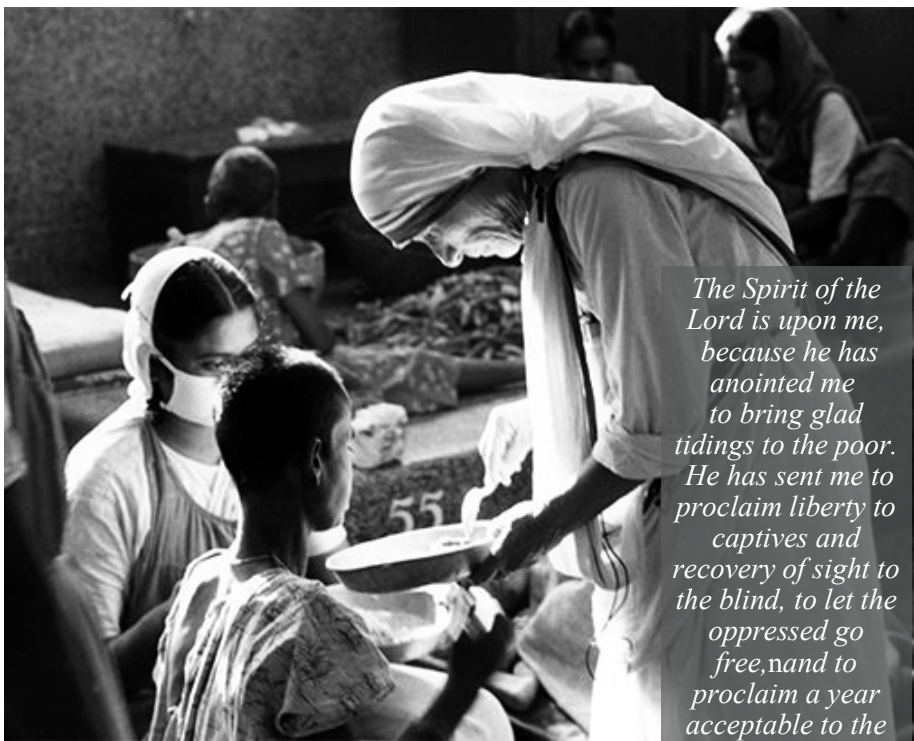

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO GROW UP IN POVERTY?

Children who grow up in poverty have poorer physical and mental health; worse performance in school, and, given neighborhood segregation by income, they are more likely to attend lower quality schools and live in neighborhoods with fewer employed adults. These factors all make it harder for children to reach their human potential and achieve higher levels of income when they reach adulthood. This contributes to the relatively low level of social mobility in the United States. Based on worker productivity losses, costs to the healthcare system, and the costs of incarceration and the judicial system, a recent report from the National Academies of Science estimated that child poverty costs the economy of the United States between \$800 billion and \$1.1 trillion each year. 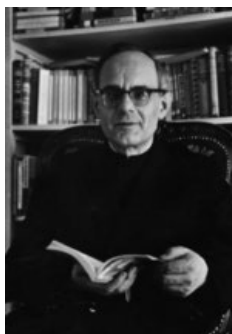
¿QUÉ SIGNIFICA CRECER EN LA POBREZA?

Los niños que crecen en la pobreza tienen peor salud física y mental; peor desempeño en la escuela y, dada la segregación del vecindario por ingresos, es más probable que asistan a escuelas de menor calidad y vivan en vecindarios con menos adultos empleados. Todos estos factores dificultan que los niños alcancen su potencial humano y alcancen mayores niveles de ingresos cuando lleguen a la edad adulta. Esto contribuye al nivel relativamente bajo de movilidad social en los Estados Unidos. Con base en las pérdidas de productividad de los trabajadores, los costos del sistema de salud y los costos del encarcelamiento y el sistema judicial, un informe reciente de las Academias Nacionales de Ciencias estimó que la pobreza infantil le cuesta a la economía de los Estados Unidos entre \$ 800 mil millones y \$ 1.1 billones cada año. . 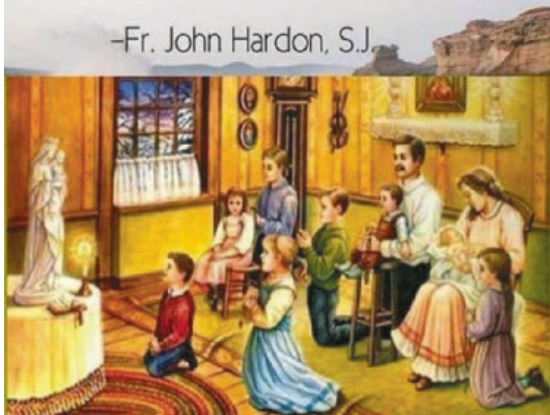

WE NEED FATHERS TO GUIDE AND PROTECT

Many fathers are struggling to balance marriage, children and a career. And today's predators are more dangerous than actual wolves. Harmful social media apps, pornography, excessive time spent on video games and dubious companions all can corrupt the soul. Yet some fathers today throw their kids to the wolves by not paying attention to what they are doing online or with their friends. Children need parents to set limits like "no calling or texting after 8 pm." No one should have access to your children late at night. This is when "I hate you" texts are often sent.



Video game marathons bring their own problems. I frequently hear from parents that online gaming is the only way their sons "see" their friends. But online gaming is different from playing in person. Profanity-laced communication is the norm, and the virtual environment encourages bingeing, disrupting schoolwork and sleep. Perhaps fathers themselves play too many video games or spend too much time on their smartphones. Or maybe they spend too much time at work.

Dads cannot expect their teens to mature without spiritual guidance and loving discipline. While drawing boundaries and enforcing rules will draw immediate backlash, young people benefit when such guidelines are applied with consistency. The child will pass through a withdrawal phase toward better behavior and a healthier emotional state. Ultimately, a strong relationship with God will help us build strong relationships with our children. Guiding our children through such cultural and social minefields is a crucial step in fulfilling our ultimate mission as fathers: guiding them to heaven. NECESITAMOS PADRES QUE GUIEN Y PROTEJAN

Muchos padres luchan por equilibrar el matrimonio, los hijos y una carrera. Y los depredadores de hoy son más peligrosos que los lobos reales. Las aplicaciones dañinas de las redes sociales, la pornografía, el tiempo excesivo dedicado a los videojuegos y los compañeros dudosos pueden corromper el alma. Sin embargo, algunos padres arrojan a sus hijos a los lobos al no prestar atención a lo que hacen en línea o con sus amigos. Los niños necesitan que los padres establezcan límites como "no llamar ni enviar mensajes de texto después de las 8 p. m.". Nadie debe tener acceso a sus hijos a altas horas de la noche. Aquí es cuando a menudo se envían mensajes de texto de "Te odio".

Los maratones de videojuegos traen sus propios problemas. Con frecuencia escucho de los padres que los juegos en línea son la única forma en que sus hijos "ven" a sus amigos. Pero los juegos en línea son diferentes de jugar en persona. La comunicación llena de blasfemias es la norma, y el entorno virtual fomenta los atracones, lo que interrumpe el trabajo escolar y el sueño. Quizás los propios padres juegan demasiados videojuegos o pasan demasiado tiempo en sus teléfonos inteligentes. O tal vez pasan demasiado tiempo en el trabajo.



Los papás no pueden esperar que sus hijos adolescentes maduren sin una guía espiritual y una disciplina amorosa. Si bien trazar límites y hacer cumplir las reglas provocará una reacción violenta inmediata, los jóvenes se benefician cuando dichas pautas se aplican con coherencia. El niño pasará por una fase de retraimiento hacia un mejor comportamiento y un estado emocional más saludable. En última instancia, una relación sólida con Dios nos ayudará a construir relaciones sólidas con nuestros hijos. Guiar a nuestros hijos a través de tales campos minados culturales y sociales es un paso crucial para cumplir nuestra misión principal como padres: guiarlos al cielo. KIDS' CORNER

THIS WEEK, JAN. 25, WE CELEBRATE THE CONVERSION OF ST. PAUL

Many people don't realize that St. Paul never actually met Jesus like the 12 Apostles. Rather, he is introduced in the Acts of the Apostles, Chapter 7 and 8. His name was actually "Saul", but was changed to "Paul" when he became a Christian. Saul was present as a "young man" when Stephen was stoned to death by people who could not accept his message as a Christian. This was in the very earliest days of the Church. Then Saul, a Pharisee, started to arrest Christians, put them into jail, and even kill them. But one day, when he was going from Jerusalem to Damascus to arrest more, he was knocked to the ground by a bright light and a voice from heaven asked him: "Why are you persecuting me? I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting." Look at Chap. 9 of Acts in your Bible and read the whole story. One lesson from this story is that someone can commit the very worst sin and God can still come to that person and make them a saint! Remember, EVERYONE can be a saint!

Mucha gente no se da cuenta de que San Pablo en realidad nunca conoció a Jesús como los 12 Apóstoles. Más bien, se le presenta en los Hechos de los Apóstoles, capítulos 7 y 8. Pero un día, cuando iba de Jerusalén a Damasco para arrestar a más, fue derribado al suelo por una luz brillante y una voz del cielo le preguntó: "¿Por qué me persigues? Mira el cap. 9 de Hechos en su Biblia y lea la historia completa. ¡Una lección de esta historia es que alguien puede cometer el peor pecado y Dios aún puede venir a esa persona y hacerla santa! ¡Recuerde, TODOS pueden ser santos!

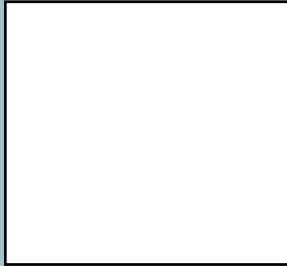

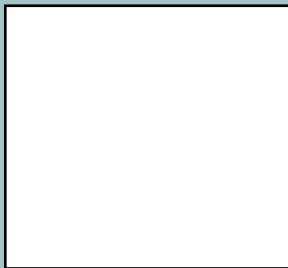

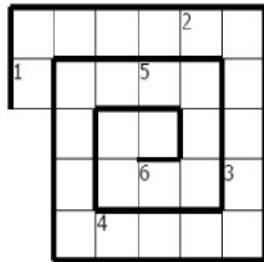
