PASTOR'S CORNER

My dear Parishioners,

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen!

On this Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, I am reminded of the mandate Jesus entrusted His disciples and us today to go and baptize all people in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. By our baptism we become children of God and are given a share in the life of God here in this life and in the life to come.

To help us heighten our appreciation for being members of the family of Love, the Holy Trinity, I would like to share this reflection taken from the treatise *On the Trinity* by Didymus of Alexandria, (He was a Christian theologian in the Church of Alexandria, 313 AD – 298 AD). Just as a note, I made some changes in the document to make it more inclusive in addressing the faithful.

The Holy Spirit Renews Us In Baptism

“The Holy Spirit renews us in baptism through His godhead, which He shares with the Father and the Son. Finding us in a state of deformity, the Spirit restores our original beauty and fills us with his grace, leaving no room for anything unworthy of our love. The Spirit frees us from sin and death, and changes us from the earthly people we were, men and women of dust and ashes, into spiritual individuals, sharers in the divine glory, daughters and sons and heirs of God the Father who bear a likeness to the Son and are his co-heirs, sisters and brothers, destined to reign with Him and to share His glory. In place of earth the Spirit reopens heaven to us and gladly admits us into paradise, giving us even now greater honor than the angels, and by the holy waters of baptism extinguishing the unquenchable fires of hell.


We are conceived twice: to the human body we owe our first conception, to the divine Spirit, our second. John says: To all who received Him, who believed in His name, He gave power to become children of God. These were born not by human generation, not by the desire of the flesh, not by the will of man, but of God. All who believed in Christ, He says, received power to become children of God, that is, of the Holy Spirit, and to gain kinship with God. To show that their parent was God the Holy Spirit, He adds these words of Christ: I give you this solemn warning, that without being born of water and the Spirit, no one can enter the kingdom of God.

Visibly, through the ministry of priests, the font gives symbolic birth to our visible bodies. Invisibly, through the ministry of angels, the Spirit of God, whom even the mind's eye cannot see, baptizes into Himself both our souls and bodies, giving them a new birth.

Speaking quite literally, and also in harmony with the words of water and the Spirit, John the Baptist says of Christ: He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire. Since we are only vessels of clay, we must first be cleansed in water and then hardened by spiritual fire—for God is a consuming fire. We need the Holy Spirit to perfect and renew us, for spiritual fire can cleanse us, and spiritual water can recast us as in a furnace and make us into new persons.”

I am grateful to God and to all of you for the life we share in love! We are brothers and sisters, co-heirs of the kingdom of God and we believe that He will gather us to be together with Him forever in heaven. Glory to God forever!




The Feast of the Visitation of Mary

Monday, May 31, 2021

This feast commemorates the
three-month visit of Mary with
her elderly cousin Elizabeth
during Mary's pregnancy with

Jesus and Elizabeth's with John the Baptist. The
story appears in the first chapter of Luke's Gospel.
It recounts Elizabeth's Spirit-filled greeting,
acknowledging Mary as “the mother of my Lord,”
and Mary's beautiful response, the Magnificat,
which begins, “My soul proclaims the greatness of
the Lord.” Introduced by the Franciscans in 1263,
the feast became universal in the 16th century.

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the
central mystery of the Christian faith
and life. God reveals himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
The doctrine of the Trinity includes three truths of faith.
First, the Trinity is One. We do not speak of three gods but of
one God. Each of the Persons is fully God. They are a unity
of Persons in one divine nature.

Second, the Divine Persons are distinct from each other.
Father, Son, and Spirit are not three appearances or modes of
God, but three identifiable persons, each fully God in a way
distinct from the others.

Third, the Divine Persons are in relation to each other. The
distinction of each is understood only in reference to the
others. The Father cannot be the Father without the Son, nor
can the Son be the Son without the Father. The Holy Spirit is
related to the Father and the Son who both send him forth.

Thank God - literally - that He doesn't take a break, even if we do. Can we try to remember that, even in the midst of our many wonderful distractions? Let's enjoy this summer. Let's live it to the full. But let's see it for the gift that it is - and remember the thanks we owe the Giver.


