

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR:

What is important while eating, the taste and enjoyment of the food, or the concentration on the grit that may be in the food? Find the answer from this Indian story.

A well-known chef of a restaurant prepared a very tasty pulav (a rice dish) using high quality rice. When it was ready, its aroma spread all over and the mouths of all around started watering in anticipation. All were really eager to taste the pulav and nearly a hundred people were served the mouthwatering dish.

Just when everyone was about to take their first mouthful, the chef came in and informed everyone that there is a grit in the pulav. As it was of the same color and size as the rice grain, he could not find it. He said it could be in anyone's plate and he warned everyone to be careful while eating, lest anyone bite into it and injure his/her teeth.

With this announcement of the chef, the fun of eating was gone, despite the excellence of the pulav, and its toothsome flavor. The concentration was on the grit in the pulav, with everyone swallowing one bite after another lest he bite into the grit, without paying any attention to the great taste of the food. The greater the awareness of the grit, the greater was the silence that ensued, there was no table conversation. While before the start of the meal there was an atmosphere of fun and conviviality, now all seemed to be in a trance. All ate what was on their plate, even the last bite being taken very carefully.

After completing the meal everyone sighed in relief for not biting into the grit. Then it came to their notice that no one had bitten into the grit. The chef was called and questioned: "You had said one of us may bite into the grit while eating; but that has not happened?" The chef replied that he had been careful to remove all grits he could find but wanted to warn everyone about one he may have missed by oversight. Everyone stared at each other. There was no comment about the very delicious pulav that was served. Everyone seemed exhausted after the meal because the joy and ease of eating had gone. They had found it to be a hard exercise rather than a joyous occasion!

The pandemic situation is like the stone in the pulav dish. We are unsure as to who could be affected by it. The joy and ease of living have gone. We are suspicious even of those who extend a helping hand, for fear of contagion. Even our shopping for necessities can be fraught with fear of the unknown lurking at the corner. Earlier when one sneezed, we said "God bless you!" Now we feel uneasy and squirm. It is time we got back to being normal and living a happy life. Enjoy the day before you as a precious gift given to you by a good God. Be positive in outlook and find happiness within your own inner self.

I will always remember my very dear friend in the Sandhills who asked me: "Fr. Joe, is there Fourth July in India?" I was taken aback a few seconds before I got her drift. My reply was: "Yes, we have Fourth July in India, but it is on Fifteenth August!" Enjoy Fourth July and the fireworks!
