

God's Gift: A Holy Family

The Christmas crèche graces our homes with that wonderful events of our Savior's birth. There are Mary and Joseph kneeling in adoration before their newborn son. Farm animals adorn the stable with shepherds and sheep standing in awe and wonder. An angel hovers over the scene with the star close by. "All is calm and all is bright", with the child "sleeping in heavenly peace". It gives us pause to imagine that night and the great event that we celebrate.

The Feast of the Holy Family helps us imagine all that happen that night and in the years to come as Jesus grew in "wisdom, age, and grace." But we must admit that all was not perfect that Christmas night and in the years that followed in the life of the Holy Family. We

remember that there was no room for this family in Bethlehem except for a smelly stable. Soon they had to flee to Egypt as they were hunted by the local authorities. Their lives had drastically changed and it would a long time before they could return home to Nazareth.

Much like many families today, we are separated by circumstances beyond our control. The pandemic continues to cause great fear and tension in families. Unemployment, homelessness, food insecurities, family separations, and many other issues cause division and disruption. We are concerned for aging parents and sick spouses and children. Our world is violent and many concerns.

Just as in the days of the Holy Family, we are aware that God's saving grace is our one hope. None of us is immune to tragedy, sickness, or insecurities. We are all struggling to find peace and joy in this world. Our search for holiness is the means by which we find the courage and strength to meet these challenges as did Mary and Joseph.

We call upon the power of God to bind us more closely together in our families and with our friends. It is in our interaction and desire to express and receive love that we are touched by the hand of God.

We pray today for our families, living and deceased. We pray for the strength and courage to overcome differences and conflicts which are often rooted in the wounds of our lives. Healing is very important for every family to ask from the Lord and to desire for one another. It is in our seeking the grace and mercy of God for all who are in our family that we will fully understand the birth of life we celebrate this Christmas. May the newborn King radiate life and love, to innocent and dependent children of God must do, so that we may be open to a new experience that love, peace, and joy can bring. Holiness means "showing" to one another a love that is both human and divine. It's an "Epiphany" of God present in our midst.

WEEKLY REFLECTION:

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Nazareth, and the liturgy invites us to reflect and meditate on the experience of Mary, Joseph and Jesus. We see in the Holy Family a union of love that is inspired by great trust in the Lord. We hear in today's Gospel passage the journey of the family of Nazareth to Jerusalem for the celebration of Passover. However, on the return journey, Joseph and Mary realize that their son Jesus is not with them in the caravan. After three days of searching and fear, they find him in the temple, sitting among the teachers, focused on a discussion with them. The moment they saw their Son, Mary and Joseph "were astonished" and the Mother revealed their fear to him saying: "your father and I have been looking for you with great anxiety." There was much anxiety that Mary and Joseph felt when they could not find Jesus. This anxiety reveals Jesus' centrality in the Holy Family. The Virgin and her husband welcomed Jesus, protected him and watched him grow in age, wisdom and grace, but above all he grew in their hearts; and little by little their affection for him and their understanding of him grew. This is why the family of Nazareth is holy; because it was centered on Jesus. All of Mary and Joseph's attention and concerns were directed toward him.

That anxiety that they experienced in the three days that Jesus was missing is also our anxiety when we are distant from him, when we are distant from Jesus. We should feel anxious when we forget Jesus for more than three days, without praying, without reflecting on the readings, without praying, without feeling the need of his presence and his comforting presence. Mary and Joseph searched for him and found him in the temple while he was teaching. For us, in the house of God we are able to encounter our Divine Teacher and receive his message of salvation. In the Eucharist, the Lord speaks to us, offers us his Word, lights our path and provides us nourishment on our daily journey. May Jesus, Mary and Joseph bless and protect our families, so that it will be founded on the will of God. Let us pray for all families that they may grow holy through all struggles and joys of family life.

Jesús iba creciendo en saber, en estatura y en el favor de Dios y de los hombres.





Al igual que en el tiempo de la Sagrada Familia, estamos conscientes que la gracia salvadora de Dios es nuestra única esperanza. REFLEXIÓN: LA ANSIEDAD DE MARÍA Y JOSÉ

Hoy celebramos la Fiesta de la Sagrada Familia de Nazaret y la liturgia nos invita a reflexionar y meditar sobre la experiencia de María, José y Jesús. Vemos en la Sagrada Familia una unión de amor que se inspira en una gran confianza en el Señor. Escuchamos en el pasaje del Evangelio de hoy, el viaje de la familia de Nazaret a Jerusalén para la celebración de la Pascua. Sin embargo, en su viaje de regreso, José y María se dan cuenta de que Jesús no está con ellos en la caravana. Despues de tres días de búsqueda y angustia, lo encuentran en el templo, sentado entre los maestros de la ley, concentrado en una discusión con ellos. En el momento en que vieron a su Hijo, María y José "quedaron asombrados" y la Madre le reveló su angustia diciendo: "tu padre y yo te hemos estado buscando llenos de angustia".

María y José experimentaron la ansiedad de no poder encontrar a Jesús y esta ansiedad revela la centralidad de Jesús en la Sagrada Familia. La Virgen María y su esposo recibieron a Jesús, lo protegieron y lo vieron crecer en edad, sabiduría y gracia, pero sobre todo, creció en sus corazones; poco a poco su afecto por él y su comprensión sobre él crecían. Por eso la familia de Nazaret es santa; porque estaba centrada en Jesús. Toda la atención y las preocupaciones de María y José se dirigían hacia Él.

Esa angustia que experimentaron María y José en los tres días de la desaparición de Jesús, es también nuestra angustia cuando estamos alejados de Él. Debemos sentirnos angustiados cuando nos olvidamos de Jesús por varios días; sin orar, sin reflexionar sobre las lecturas y sin sentir la necesidad de su presencia consoladora. María y José lo buscaron y lo encontraron en el templo mientras enseñaba. Es en la casa de Dios que podemos encontrarnos con nuestro Divino Maestro y recibir su mensaje de salvación. Es en la Eucaristía donde el Señor nos habla, nos ofrece su Palabra, ilumina nuestro camino y nos da el alimento diario. Que Jesús, María y José bendigan y protejan a nuestra familia, para que así se fundamente en la voluntad de Dios. Oremos por todas las familias para que puedan crecer en santidad a través de todas las luchas y alegrías de la vida familiar.



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
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
