dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.



Reflection and Prayer

WEEKLY REFLECTION: EPIPHANY: A PERPETUAL EVENT

The world should never have to guess what Christians stand for, what our faith is all about. There's something essential in Christianity that can only be described with the word we use for today: "Epiphany" meaning to show, to expose to the light for all to see.

The story of the Magi is the one we associate with Epiphany. The Wise Men are symbols of human hunger for truth, and for Christians the great Epiphany is the revelation that Jesus is the only One who can satisfy our deepest need to know and live the truth.

Matthew's emphasis in this Gospel passage is the fact that the Wise Men were foreigners, non-Jews, underlining the truth that Jesus has revealed from the beginning, but which even the sincerest believers sometimes have difficulty accepting: the Good News of God's complete and unconditional love is for all people, everywhere and for all time.

In Herod, Matthew emphasizes another point. Herod exemplifies that part of us that not only shrinks from the truth, but even erects barriers for others – that part of us that dims or covers the clear visibility of this Good News. Any time any of us say or do anything that makes it more difficult for others to recognize this truth, or stand idle when we could help others come to know this truth, we are playing out Herod's role.

At its heart, Christianity is a revelation - a way of life - that speaks openly and honestly to the deepest of human fears, doubts, questions and needs. And it does so with equal intensity to everyone in every situation. It is, for each of us, nothing less than a calling to make Epiphany a perpetual event by always and in every way revealing the absolute truth of this Good News.





REFLEXIÓN: LA EPIFANÍA: UN ACONTECIMIENTO PERPETUO

El mundo nunca debería tener que adivinar qué es lo que creemos los cristianos, de qué se trata nuestra fe. Hay algo esencial en el cristianismo que sólo se puede describir con la palabra “Epifanía”, cuyo significado es mostrar, exponer a la luz para que todos vean.

La historia de los Reyes Magos es la que asociamos con la Epifanía porque son los símbolos del hambre humana por la verdad. Para nosotros los cristianos, la gran Epifanía es la revelación de que Jesús es el único que puede satisfacer nuestra más profunda necesidad de conocer y vivir la verdad.

En este pasaje del Evangelio, San Mateo pone especial énfasis al hecho de que los Reyes Magos eran extranjeros; no judíos, lo que subraya la verdad que Jesús ha revelado desde el principio, pero que incluso los más sinceros creyentes a veces tienen dificultades para aceptar: la Buena Nueva de Dios es de completo e incondicional amor para todas las personas, en todas partes del mundo y para siempre.

Por otro lado, Mateo enfatiza otro punto en la figura de Herodes y ejemplifica esa parte de nosotros que no solo se aleja de la verdad, sino que incluso levanta barreras para los demás.

Habla de esa parte de nosotros que nubla o cubre la clara visibilidad de la Buena Nueva. Cada vez que decimos o hacemos algo que dificulta que otros reconozcan esta verdad, o permanecemos pasivos ante la posibilidad de ayudar a otros para que conozcan esta verdad, estamos desempeñando el papel de Herodes.

Muy en el fondo, el cristianismo es una revelación; una forma de vida, que habla abierta y honestamente a los más profundos temores, dudas, preguntas y necesidades humanas, y lo hace con la misma intensidad para todos en cada situación. Es, para cada uno de nosotros, nada menos que un llamado a hacer de la Epifanía un acontecimiento perpetuo para revelar siempre y en todos los sentidos, la verdad absoluta de esta Buena Nueva.

ENSEÑANZA SOCIAL CATÓLICA

La prueba para nuestra Iglesia no es simplemente si “hemos mantenido la fe,” sino si hemos compartido la fe, en servicio cariñoso, educación creativa, y acción justa en toda la comunidad Católica. Hace más de dos mil años, en la sinagoga de su pueblo natal, Jesús leyó las palabras de Isaías que enumeraban su trabajo en la tierra, al igual que la misión de la Iglesia a través de los siglos:

“El Espíritu del Señor esta sobre mí, porque él me ha ungido para que de la Buena Noticia a los pobres. ...libertad a los cautivos y la vista a los ciegos, para poner en libertad a los oprimidos...” (Lc 4:18)
