

And if I have the gift of prophecy, and comprehend all mysteries and all knowledge; if I have all faith so as to move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give away everything I own, and if I hand my body over so that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing. Love is patient, love is kind. It is not jealous, it is not pompous, It is not inflated, it is not rude, it does not seek its own interests, it is not quick-tempered, it does not brood over injury, it does not rejoice over wrongdoing but rejoices with the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never fails. If there are prophecies, they will be brought to nothing; if tongues, they will cease; if knowledge, it will be brought to nothing. For we know partially and we prophesy partially, but when the perfect comes, the partial will pass away. When I was a child, I used to talk as a child, think as a child, reason as a child; when I became a man, I put aside childish things. At present we see indistinctly, as in a mirror, but then face to face. At present I know partially; then I shall know fully, as I am fully known. So faith, hope, love remain, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.



Open Wide the Doors to Christ- Our Saints

Anticipation is growing as we prepare to open the doors of the remodeled church. The workers have prepared the sanctuary for the flooring of marble and limestone. Painters have applied their craft to the walls and ceiling. Reconstruction of the altar, ambo, lectern, and furniture are soon ready for installation. Lights, air-conditioning, and a new sound and video system are soon to arrive. Last of all, the church will receive a deep cleaning to receive us all.

That is for the interior of the Church. But, what have we done to prepare ourselves to open

wide the doors to Christ in our own lives. Our much anticipated opening will only make sense if we can truly receive the Word of God into our lives and celebrate the Eucharist to its fullness. With all that is new in our church, what must be renewed is US. This is a life-long process but it is the reality of what it means to be a community of faith.

For this purpose, a series of articles will appear in the bulletin to help lead us to a greater participation in the life and practice of our Catholic Faith. It is a tradition to have a relic of a saint placed in the altar. Ideally, it is associated with the patron of the parish. Since there are no relics of Mary, the relic of St. Candidus, soldier of the Theban Legion who was martyred for refusing to offer sacrifice to pagan gods at the direction of the Roman Emperor Maximian, were placed in the altar in 1954.

Our refurbished altar will be placed in the enlarged sanctuary flanked by a new ambo and lectern. Through the generosity of a few parishioners, we are including a number of significant relics of saints who have special connection to our parish family. These will include: **St. Francis of Assisi, St. Bonaventure, St. Theresa of Avila, St. Philip Neri, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, St. Teresa of the Child Jesus, and Pope St. Pius X.** All the relics will be located in a clear leucite box made visible under the altar for veneration. Including these will enhance the visible sign of the presence of the Communion of Saints surrounding us during Mass. As they were open to Christ, so may they inspire us to be living saints today.

WEEKLY REFLECTION: Instruments or Barriers to Grace?

In today's Gospel passage a people who have come for Sabbath synagogue worship turn angry to the extent of intending to throw Jesus off a cliff. What made them so angry? Jesus had reminded them of a time in their history when, as the people of Israel experienced famine, God chose to save a Gentile widow. He also reminded them of God's mercy towards a Gentile named Naaman. His message was the opposite of they wanted to hear.

Had Jesus told them that they were God's exclusively privileged people, he would have been praised rather than criticized. Instead, he chose to declare the truth that God has no favorites, that all are equal shareholders of God's love no matter who we are, where we come from or our social status. We don't earn God's mercy by the titles we hold – it's a gift freely given. This truth is what St. Paul calls: "the most excellent way", God's unconditional love.

What happened in that Nazareth synagogue can happen today in our Christian communities if we aren't careful. If we carry prejudice into our places of worship, we effectively erect barriers to God's grace.

While attending college in South Africa Mahatma Gandhi began to read the Gospels and even considered becoming Christian. He believed that the teachings of Jesus offered a solution to the caste system that divided the people of India. One Sunday he decided to attend services at a nearby church and talk to the minister about becoming Christian. But, when he entered the vestibule, the usher refused to give him a seat and suggested that he go worship with his "own people". Gandhi left the church and never returned. "If Christians have caste differences also," he said, "I might as well remain a Hindu."

The usher missed a golden opportunity to be an instrument of Grace, to welcome and invite Gandhi to draw closer to Jesus. Do we, even subconsciously, bring prejudice into our Christian community or our community at large? If so, we need to turn to Jesus for healing, so we can be instruments and not barriers to Grace.

En aquel tiempo, después de que Jesús leyó en la sinagoga un pasaje del libro de Isaías, dijo: "Hoy mismo se ha cumplido este pasaje de la Escritura que acaban de oír". Todos le daban su aprobación y admiraban la sabiduría de las palabras que salían de sus labios, y se preguntaban: "¿No es éste el hijo de José?"

Jesús les dijo: "Seguramente me dirán aquel refrán: 'Médico, cárdate a ti mismo' y haz aquí, en tu propia tierra, todos esos prodigios que hemos oído que has hecho en Cafarnaúm". REFLEXION: Instrumentos o barreras para la gracia de Dios?

En el Evangelio de hoy, un pueblo que había venido para el servicio del sábado a la sinagoga se enojó a tal punto, que intentó arrojar a Jesús por un precipicio. ¿Qué los hizo enojar tanto? Jesús les había recordado un momento de su historia cuando, mientras el pueblo de Israel experimentaba hambre, Dios decidió salvar a una viuda gentil. También les recordó la misericordia de Dios hacia un gentil llamado Naamán. Su mensaje era lo contrario de lo que querían oír.

Si Jesús les hubiera dicho que eran el único pueblo escogido de Dios, habría sido alabado y no criticado. En cambio, Jesús optó por declarar que Dios no tiene favoritos y que todos somos partícipes por igual del amor de Dios, sin importar quiénes somos, de dónde venimos o nuestra condición social. La misericordia de Dios no la ganamos por los títulos que tengamos sino porque es un regalo gratuito, lo que San Pablo llama “el don por excelencia”: el amor incondicional de Dios.

Lo que pasó en aquella sinagoga de Nazaret puede pasar hoy en nuestras comunidades cristianas si no estamos conscientes. Si llevamos prejuicios a nuestras iglesias, efectivamente erigimos barreras para la gracia de Dios.

Cuando Mahatma Gandhi asistía a la universidad en Sudáfrica, comenzó a leer los Evangelios e incluso consideró convertirse en cristiano. Creía que las enseñanzas de Jesús ofrecían una solución al sistema de castas que dividía a la gente de la India. Un domingo decidió asistir a los servicios en una iglesia cercana y hablar con el ministro acerca de convertirse en cristiano. Pero, cuando entró al vestíbulo, el ujier se negó a darle un asiento y le sugirió que fuera a adorar a Dios con su “propia gente”. Gandhi salió de la iglesia y nunca volvió. “Si los cristianos también tienen diferencias de casta” dijo, “mejor sigo siendo hindú”.

El ujier perdió una oportunidad de oro para ser un instrumento de la gracia de Dios, para acoger e invitar a Gandhi a acercarse a Jesús. ¿Traemos, incluso inconscientemente, prejuicios a nuestra comunidad cristiana o a nuestra comunidad en general? Si es así, debemos acudir a Jesús para que nos sane, para que podamos ser instrumentos y no barreras para su gracia.
