



LIVE THE LITURGY

Inspiration for the week

When we encounter or even ponder God's magnificence, power, and awesomeness, we easily begin to feel our own smallness and perceived insignificance. After all, who can compete with eternal greatness, seraphim, or the ability to catch great numbers of fish? We unfortunately think that God's presence somehow overrides us, reduces our importance, and only seeks to judge our inadequacies and doubts. Things begin to change a bit when we realize that what we may have seen as overwhelming and frightening is really only unconditional, unmerited love. Love has tremendous majesty and power. When we listen to this power and stop seeing it as threatening or dooming, our fear dissipates and Divine friendship takes root. Remaining close to what we once preferred at a distance, we can journey to places we never thought possible and do things we never thought we could do. Strengthened by Divine friendship and encouraged by its life-giving power, we can say "here I am, send me!" when God asks, "whom shall I send?" Sin and fear no longer are of concern to the one who remains close to God in a bond of trust.



SAINT OF THE WEEK

The story of St. Josephine Bakhita (1869-1947) is a story that many people taken into slavery have experienced. Born in the Darfur region of Sudan, she was kidnapped at the age of 8 and sold into slavery many times. As she passed from owner to owner, she experienced the moral and physical humiliations associated with slavery. It was only at the age of 13 that her suffering was alleviated after she was bought for the Italian Consul in Sudan. It was here that she was fortunate to receive kindness, respect, and peace from her new master.

She was later handed over to the Canossian Sisters when she made the case that slavery had been outlawed in Italy for years. She was baptized and confirmed in the Catholic Church in 1890, where she took the name Josephine. She later entered the Institute of St. Magdalene of Canossa in 1893 and made her profession three years later.

St. Josephine Bakhita's next 50 years were spent serving people through cooking, sewing, embroidery, and housekeeping. She was a source of encouragement and her constant smile won people's hearts, as did her humility and simplicity. Today she is known as the patron saint of victims of modern slavery and human trafficking.



What are New Age Religions and why they are wrong?

Talk show host Oprah Winfrey is rolling out the red carpet for the New Age Religions with a weekly online class with *New York Times* bestselling guru Eckhart Tolle and a daily broadcast with Marianne Williamson. “A Course in Miracles (ACIM) by Marianne presented by “*Oprah and friends*” channel on XM satellite radio claims to be a mind training based on spiritual psychotherapy. New Agers are Universalists, believing that all paths lead to God. They fault Christians for being intolerant and narrow-minded. Most New Agers hold Jesus in high regard, believing him to be a great spiritual teacher, or guru, but not as God and Savior. They do not accept Jesus’ claim that he alone is “*the way, the truth, and the life*” (John 14:6). The typical New Ager believes that God is in everything (pantheism), all things are one (monism), man is God, human mind creates reality, and one’s own experience validates the truth. New Agers do not believe in evil. Therefore, they do not accept man’s problem as separation by sin from God. Instead, they believe that each of us has forgotten his or her own divinity. Therefore, the New Age solution is to seek “higher consciousness” through meditation, breathing exercises, yoga, diet, crystals, channeling, alternative healing, spirit guides, and more. Each of these diverse practices has the same purpose: to awaken the god in man. The main problem with the “new age movement” is that it is just modernized superstition and its ideas are mostly antichristian. Put simply, New Age is an unacceptable combination of humanism, eastern mysticism and occultism.

Another growing and dangerous cult in the society today is satanic worship. The satanic worshippers promote to place Satan in the place of God and promotes all kinds of immoral activities as the way of life. We belong to God who created us in His own image and likeness. Ever since the foundation of the world the Satan has been fighting to get the possession of human souls. Jesus suffered and dies on the cross and defeated death and all the powers of evil by His own death on the cross. Let us not give back our souls to the devil by accepting and admitting the satanic activities. We should stay awake and pray kneeling before Eucharistic Lord to save our children, teenagers, families, society and our country. Invite all our loved ones back to be united to the Lord. It is our responsibility to protect our loved ones from being snatched away from the life to death. What should we do?

Una Nota del Padre James

¿Cuáles son las religiones de la Nueva Era y porque están equivocadas?

La presentadora del programa de entrevistas Oprah Winfrey está desplegando la alfombra roja para las Religiones de la Nueva Era con una clase semanal en línea con el gurú más vendido del *New York Times*, Eckhart Tolle, y una transmisión diaria con Marianne Williamson. “Un Curso de Milagros (ACIM) de Marianne presentado por el canal “*Oprah y amigos*” en la radio satelital XM que afirma ser un entrenamiento mental basado en psicoterapia espiritual. Los miembros de La Nueva Era son Universalistas que creen que todos los caminos conducen a Dios. Culpan a los cristianos de ser intolerantes y de mente estrecha. La mayoría de los miembros de La Nueva Era tienen a Jesús en alta estima creyendo que es un gran maestro espiritual, o un gurú, pero no como Dios y Salvador. No aceptan la afirmación de Jesús, de que solo él es “*el camino, la verdad, y la vida*” (Juan 14:63). El típico creyente de la Nueva Era cree que Dios está en todo (panteísmo), todas las cosas son una (monismo), el hombre es Dios, la mente humana crea la realidad, y la experiencia propia valida la verdad. Los de LA Nueva Era no creen en el mal. Por lo tanto, no aceptan el problema de separación de Dios a causa del pecado. En cambio, creen que cada uno de nosotros se ha olvidado de su propia divinidad. Cada una de estas prácticas diversas tiene el mismo propósito: despertar a Dios en el hombre. El problema principal con el movimiento de “la nueva era” es que es solo una superstición modernizada y sus ideas son mayormente anticristianas. En pocas palabras, La Nueva Era es una combinación inaceptable de humanismo, misticismo oriental y ocultismo.

**THE IMPORTANCE OF
BEING REGISTERED!**

Being a registered, active and participating member of a Parish is very important especially when you need to baptize, register for religious education classes, sponsor a child for sacraments, get married, obtain letters (letters of good standing, immigration letters, sponsor letters, letters of transfer etc.)

For parents who have children enrolled in Catholic Schools, in order to receive the school reduced Catholic Tuition Rate, your family needs to meet the criteria set by the Parish for being a registered, ACTIVE and participating member.

The definition of a registered, active and participating member of this parish includes: being registered for the minimum of six months, attend Sunday Mass regularly as well as contributing with an envelope to our offertory along with (if possible) supporting the ministry life of our parish which is a HUGE plus.

If you aren't registered, come and join our parish family by obtaining a registration form from the parish office OR if you aren't sure if you are registered, call the front office to verify.
