

SAINT OF THE WEEK

With a family like hers, it's no wonder that St. Katharine Drexel (November 26, 1858 – March 3, 1955) grew up to become one of the first American-born saints.

Born in Philadelphia in 1858, her mother passed away when she was only five weeks old. Her father, a renowned banker, remarried a wonderful woman, and together they raised St. Katharine Drexel and her two sisters in a life of privilege. Both financially and spiritually well-endowed, the Drexels were devout Catholics and set an excellent example of true Christian servitude with prayer and care for the poor.

After her father's death, St. Katharine Drexel gave up her inheritance and instead devoted her life to the material and spiritual well-being of black and native Americans. Mother Drexel, as she would become known as, established the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament for Indians and Colored, and together they opened a boarding school in Santa Fe, the first of 50 missions for Native Americans in 16 states.


At 77, she suffered a heart attack and was forced to retire from active ministry. She spent the next 20 years of her life in quiet yet intense prayer. She died at the age of 96 and was canonized in 2000 by Pope John Paul II.

Why fasting, penance and prayer are recommended during Lent?	¿Porque el ayuno, penitencia y oración son recomendó durante la Cuaresma?
<p>We start Lent this year on the 2nd of March with Ash Wednesday. The season of lent invites to concentrate on the sacrificial love of Christ for you and me expressed on the cross. We are to evaluate our on spiritual journey knowing how much we are loved. The three pillars of Lent, Fasting, Prayer and Penance, help us to energize our spiritual batteries.</p> <p>1) <u>Fasting</u> reduces our “spiritual obesity” or the excessive accumulation of fat in our soul in the form of evil tendencies and evil habits.</p> <p>2) It gives us additional moral and spiritual strength and encourages us to share our blessings with the needy people.</p> <p>3) Fasting also gives us more time to be with God in prayer.</p> <p>4) We need to do prayerful fasting and acts of penance for our sins, following the example of Jesus before his public ministry.</p> <p>5) When we fast, we are imitating the people of Nineveh and the Syrian King, Ben Hadad who fasted pleading for God’s mercy and forgiveness, and Queen Esther who fasted for her people.</p> <p><u>Acts of penance</u> during Lent: a) remove the weakness left by sin in our souls and give us more self-control, b) pay the temporary debt caused by sin, and c) make our prayers more fruitful. Besides, it is Jesus’ teaching: <i>If any one wishes to follow me, let him deny himself, take up his cross and follow me.</i></p> <p><u>Prayer</u> is necessary at all times because God has commanded it, and because, without it, we do not receive the graces necessary to persevere to the end. “It is necessary for adults as a means of salvation; that is to say, that a person who does not pray, and neglects to ask of God the help requisite for overcoming temptations, and for preserving grace already received, cannot be saved.” (<u>St. Alphonsus – CCC 2744</u>). In essence, prayer is talking to God and listening to Him. Jesus gives us the model of penitential prayer by his forty days in the desert in preparation for his public life. Prayer during the Lent Prayer, 1. Unites us to God; 2. Makes us heavenly minded; 3. Strengthens us against evil; 4. Gives us zeal and energy for good; 5. Comforts us in adversity; and 6. Obtains help for us in time of need, and the grace of perseverance unto death.</p> <p>Fr. James</p>	<p>Este año comenzamos Cuaresma el 2 de marzo; Miércoles de Ceniza. La temporada de Cuaresma invita a concentrarse en el amor sacrificar de Cristo por ti y por mí, manifestado en la Cruz. Debemos evaluar nuestro viaje espiritual sabiendo cuanto somos amados. Tres pilares de Cuaresma; Ayuno, Oración, y Penitencia, nos ayudan a cargar nuestras baterías espirituales.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) <u>Ayuno</u> reduce nuestra “obesidad espiritual” o la acumulación excesiva de grasa en nuestra alma en la forma de malas tendencias y malos hábitos. 2) Nos da fortaleza adicional, espiritual y moral y nos anima a compartir nuestras bendiciones con las personas más necesitadas. 3) El ayuno nos da más tiempo para estar con Dios en oración. 4) Necesitamos hacer ayunos orantes y actos de penitencia por nuestros pecados, siguiendo el ejemplo de Jesús antes de su ministerio publico. 5) Cuando ayunamos, estamos imitando al pueblo de Nínive y al Rey Sirio, Ben Hadad, quien ayuno implorando la misericordia y el perdón de Dios, y la Reyna Ester quien ayuno por su gente. <p><u>Actos de penitencia</u> durante la Cuaresma: a) remover la debilidad dejada por el pecado en nuestras almas y nos da más autocontrol b) pagar la deuda temporal causada por el pecado c) hacer nuestra oración más fructífera. Además, es la enseñanza de Jesús: <i>Si alguno quiere seguirme, niéguese a sí mismo, tomo su cruz, y sígame.</i>”</p> <p><u>La oración</u> es necesaria todo el tiempo porque Dios así nos lo ha mandado y porque sin ella, no recibimos las gracias necesarias para perseverar hasta el fin. “Es necesario para los adultos como medio de salvación; esto quiere decir, que una persona que no reza, y deja de pedir a Dios la ayuda necesaria vencer las tentaciones, y conservar la gracia ya recibida, no puede salvarse” (<u>St. Alphonsus – CCC 2744</u>). En esencia, la oración es platicar con Dios y escucharlo a Él. Jesús nos da el modelo de oración penitencial por sus cuarenta días en el desierto en preparación para su vida pública. Oración durante la Cuaresma: 1. Nos une a Dios 2. Nos hace de mente celestial 3. Nos fortalece contra el mal 4. Nos da celo y energía para el bien 5. Nos consuela en la adversidad 6. Y obtenemos ayuda en tiempos de necesidad, y la gracia de perseverar hasta la muerte</p> <p>Fr. James</p>

THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING REGISTERED!

Being a registered, active and participating member of a Parish is very important especially when you need to baptize, register for religious education classes, sponsor a child for sacraments, get married, obtain letters (letters of good standing, immigration letters, sponsor letters, letters of transfer etc.)

For parents who have children enrolled in Catholic Schools, in order to receive the school reduced Catholic Tuition Rate, your family needs to meet the criteria set by the Parish for being a registered, ACTIVE and participating member.

The definition of a registered, active and participating member of this parish includes: being registered for the minimum of six months, attend Sunday Mass regularly as well as contributing with an envelope to our offertory along with (if possible) supporting the ministry life of our parish which is a HUGE plus.

If you aren't registered, come and join our parish family by obtaining a registration form from the parish office OR if you aren't sure if you are registered, call the front office to verify.

:ES IMPORTANTE ESTAR REGISTRADO!

Ser un miembro registrado, activo y participante de una parroquia es muy importante especialmente cuando usted necesita bautizar, inscribir a los niños o adultos en clases de educación religiosa, ser padrino para los sacramentos, casarse, obtener cartas (cartas de buena reputación, cartas de inmigración, cartas de permiso, etc.)

Para los padres de familia que tienen niños inscritos en las Escuelas Católicas, para recibir un descuento en la colegiatura, su familia debe cumplir con los requisitos establecidos por la parroquia para ser considerado un miembro registrado, **ACTIVO** y participante.

La definición de ser un miembro registrado, activo y participante de esta parroquia incluye: estar registrado por lo mínimo de seis meses, asistir regularmente a misa los domingos y contribuir con un sobre a nuestra colecta junto con (si es posible) estar involucrado en uno o más ministerios de nuestra parroquia, que es una ventaja enorme.

Si usted no está registrado, venga y sea parte de nuestra familia de San Carlos Borromeo obteniendo una forma de registro de nuestra oficina. O si quiere saber si está registrado, llame a la oficina para verificar.
