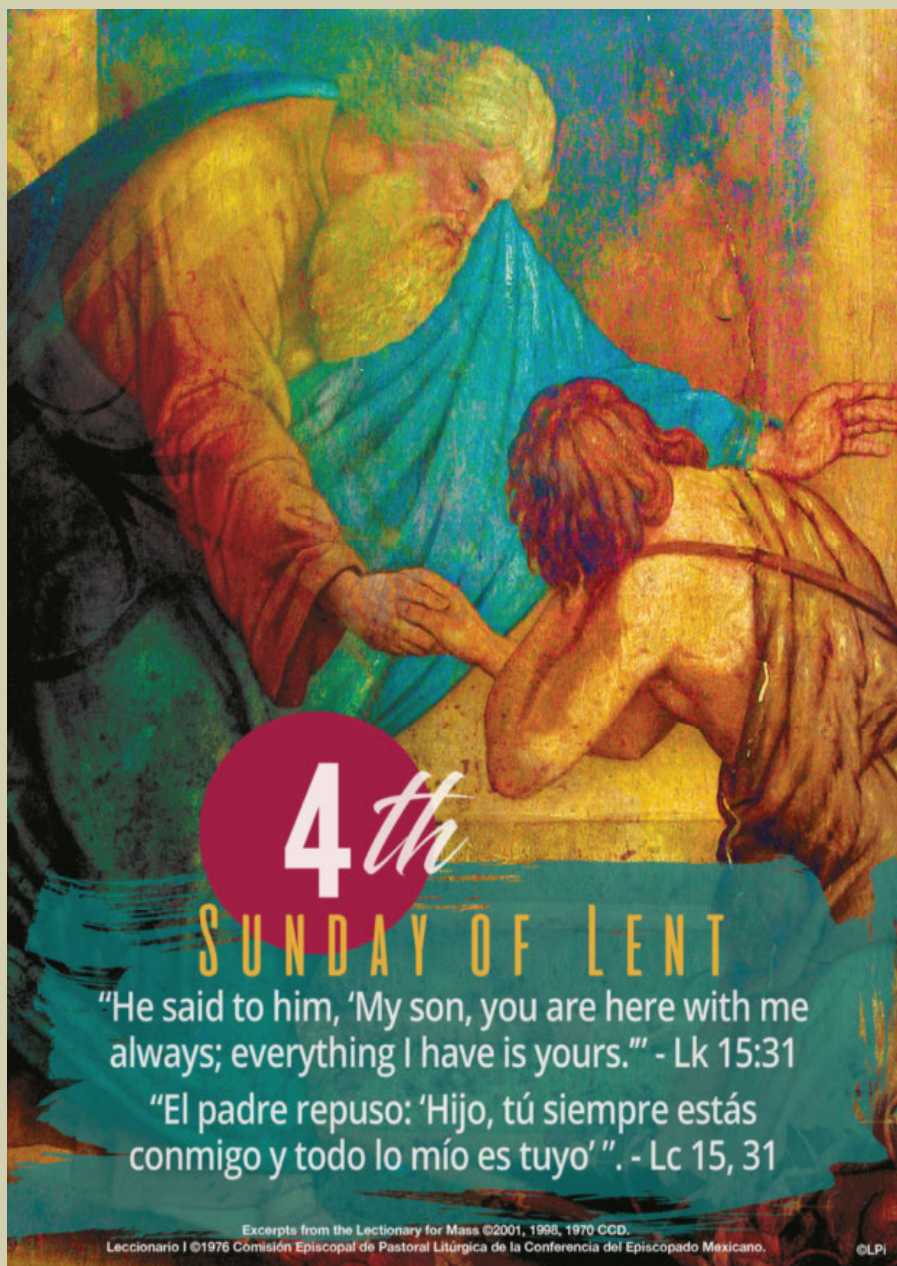

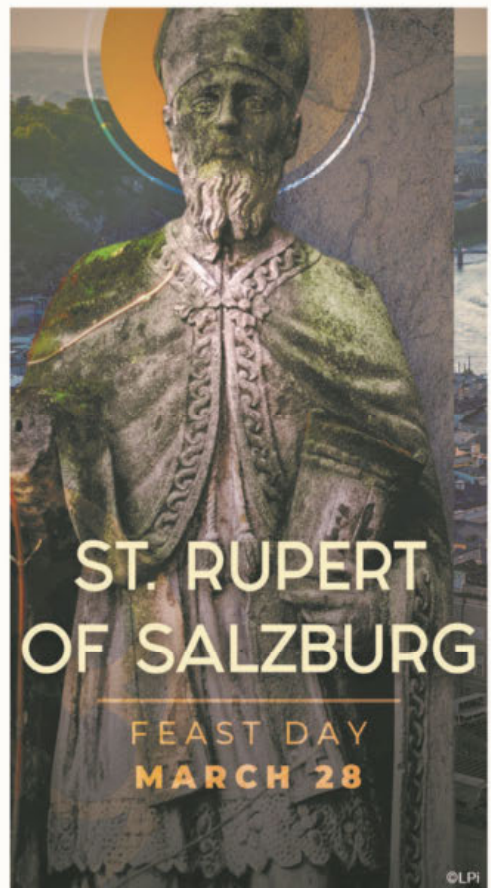

## LIVE THE LITURGY Inspiration for the week

Have you ever given thought to the fact that you are an "ambassador for Christ?" An ambassador is an accredited diplomat and official representative. We are asked to be ambassadors for Christ and his message of reconciliation. Within each one of us is a prodigal son who realizes the need to return home, an elder brother who struggles with entitlement and self-pity, and a forgiving father who simply wants to celebrate love. Realizing that all of these things are operative in our hearts, we can bring credibility to God's ministry of reconciliation. Genuine witnesses are those who not only recognize their need for wholeness, mercy, and forgiveness but also their tendency to be over self-focused and stubborn. Then, discovering freedom from all that binds them, they can then extend the love they have received to others. These ambassadors embody unity, mercy, and reconciliation and can look on others with deep compassion because they know what it is to walk in their shoes. Can God count on you to deliver this message?



## SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Rupert of Salzburg is also known as the "Apostle of Bavaria and Austria." Although mostly legend, it is believed that he was born sometime around 660 in Gaul, which is now part of France. It is possible that he is a descendant of the Merovingian royal line. Not much is known about the saint's early life.

We do know that Rupert was first appointed as Bishop of Worms in present-day Germany and despite many good works there, the pagan population eventually beat him and forced him from the city. Rupert retired to Rome for a time until Duke Theodo of Bavaria asked him to come to help establish the Church more firmly in Bavaria. Rupert agreed and brought with him a group of priests. Rupert traveled the region, effecting conversions, miracles, healing.

Eventually Rupert chose to settle at Juvavum an old Roman city mostly in ruins. He renamed the city Salzburg or "Salt Castle," and established there a great cathedral and monastery under the Rule of St. Benedict. His niece became abbess of the Benedictine convent he founded nearby. Rupert was the first bishop of Salzburg, serving also as abbot of the monastery.

St. Rupert is usually portrayed carrying a vessel of salt, as he helped establish the salt mining industry for which he named the city. It is said that Rupert died on Easter Sunday though sources disagree on the year, which could have been around 710 or possibly as late as 718.

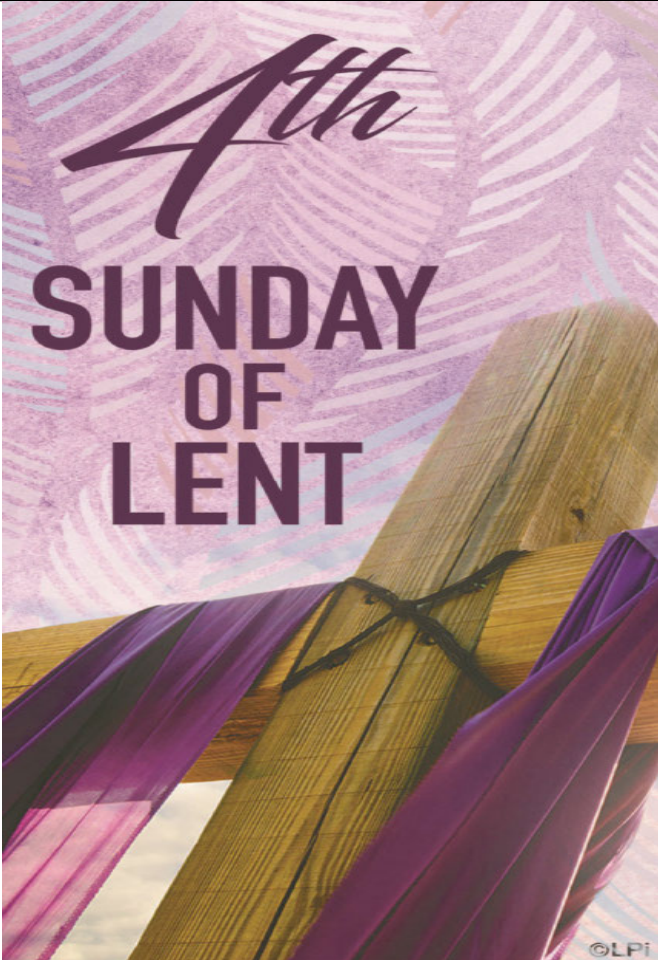

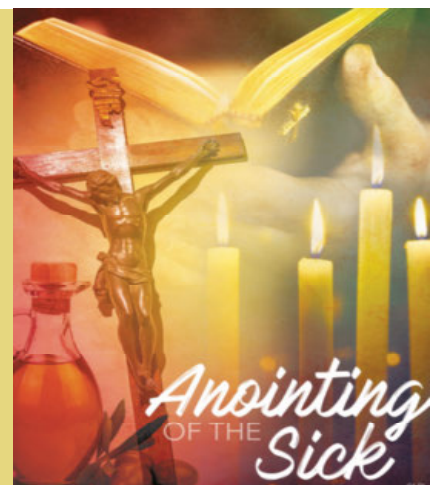

<p>Why should we dress properly in the church?</p>	<p>¿Porque debemos vestirnos apropiadamente en la Iglesia?</p>
<p><u>Dress code in the church?</u></p> <p>1) Jesus is present in our churches in the tabernacle, in the Holy Bible and in the praying community. We honor him in the church by wearing honorable dress.</p> <p>2) Jesus, with a whip in his hands, drove away the merchants and money changers from the Temple of Jerusalem for converting his “<i>Father’s house into a market place.</i>” Hence, dress we wear for shopping or beach is not expected in the church.</p> <p>3) Scanty, transparent or provocative dress gives distraction and scandal to the praying community. <b>“Be careful however, that the exercise of your freedom does not become a stumbling to the weak”</b> (I Cor.8:9).</p> <p>4) We come to the church to offer our lives on the altar and receive God’s blessings. Hence we must dress properly.</p> <p>5) St. Paul instructs us: “<i>I also want women to dress modestly, with decency and propriety.</i>” (1Timothy 2:9-10).</p> <p>6) People expect modesty and decency in dress and dignity in behavior in the church. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (No. 2521-2524), reminds us that “Modesty is decency.”</p> <p>7) If we wear formal dress for an interview or meeting a VIP but no for going to church, there is something wrong with our attitude in worshipping God. Appropriate dress is the mark of showing respect to God in the church.</p> <p>8) Christianity teaches us that the sacredness of the human body as a gift from God, calls for thoughtful respect and privacy, not over exposure.</p> <p><u>Anecdote:</u> Cardinal Angelo Roncalli, papal nuncio to France (and a future Pope John XXIII), was once invited to a formal banquet. His dinner companion wore an extremely low-cut dress, which the prelate pretended not to notice. When dessert was served, however, he selected a plump apple and duly offered it to the woman, who politely declined. “Please take it, madam,” he pleaded. “It was only after Eve ate the apple that she became aware of how little she had on.” Do ushers and greeters at Mass require baskets of apple in our church?</p> <p>Fr. James</p>	<p><u>Código de vestimenta en la Iglesia</u></p> <p>1) Jesús está presente en nuestra iglesia en el tabernáculo, en la Sagrada Escritura y en la oración en comunidad. Por lo tanto, la manera que nos vestimos para ir de compras o a la playa NO es adecuada para vestir en la Iglesia.</p> <p>3) La vestimenta escasa, transparente, o provocativa causa distracción y escandaliza a la comunidad en oración. <b>“Mirad, sin embargo, que el ejercicio de vuestra libertad no se convierta en tropiezo para los débiles”</b> (1 Cor 8:9).</p> <p>4) Venimos a la Iglesia a ofrecer nuestras vidas en el altar y recibir las bendiciones de Dios. Por lo tanto, debemos vestirnos apropiadamente.</p> <p>5) San Pablo nos instruye: “<i>Quiero también que las mujeres se vistan con modestia, con decencia y decoro.</i>” (1 Timoteo 2:9-10).</p> <p>6) La gente espera modestia y decencia en el vestir y dignidad en el comportamiento en la Iglesia. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (2521-2524), nos recuerda que “Modestia es decencia”.</p> <p>7) Si nos vestimos de manera formal para una entrevista o reunión VIP, pero no para ir a la Iglesia, hay algo mal con nuestra actitud al adorar a Dios. La manera adecuada en que vestimos demuestra nuestro respeto a Dios en la Iglesia.</p> <p>8) El cristianismo nos enseña que la santidad del cuerpo humano como un regalo de Dios exige respeto y privacidad y no una exposición excesiva.</p> <p><u>Anécdota:</u> El Cardenal Angelo Roncalli, nuncio papal en Francia (y futuro Papa Juan XXIII), fue invitado una vez a un banquete formal. Su acompañante de cena lució un vestido extremadamente escotado, lo cual el prelado pretendió no notar. Cuando se sirvió el postre, él selecciono una manzana y se la ofreció debidamente a la mujer, quien de manera cortés ella rechazo. “Por favor tómelas señora”, explico. “Fue hasta después que Eva comió de la manzana que ella se dio cuenta de la poca ropa que llevaba puesta.” ¿Deben los ujieres o saludadores de la Misa tener canastas de manzanas en la Iglesia?</p> <p>Padre James</p>
