

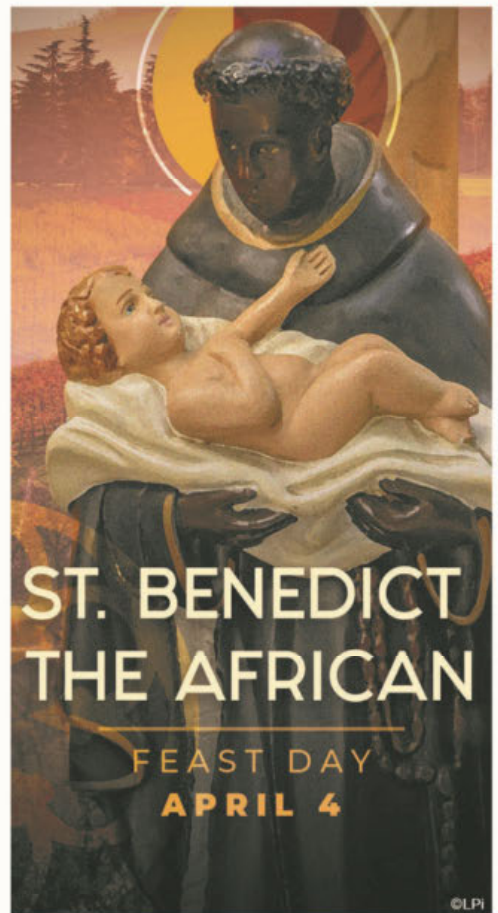

LIVE THE LITURGY

Inspiration for the week

Mercy makes us attentive to the voice of truth. We do not know what ever happened to the woman caught in adultery, after her encounter with Jesus. It is hoped that she found what she needed to feel true sorrow. What we do know is that through his gentle and wise persuasiveness, Jesus puts the Pharisees in their place and opens the door to grace for this child of God. Being exploited and used to test and discredit Jesus, she who is publicly known to be a sinner is now the victim. Jesus never tolerates people being used and immediately rushes to her defense. As the author of mercy, Jesus became her advocate and opened the door for her to God's love. Jesus also stands between us and the harsh, judgmental, and often hurtful stance of our world. He invites us to grace, to leave the sin that binds us, and for which we are often criticized, and pursue a life of virtue and freedom.



SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Benedict the African (1524-1589), was born in San Fratello, Sicily to Cristoforo and Diana Manasseri, Africans who had been taken as slaves. Some accounts claim that because of his parents' loyal service that Benedict was given his freedom at birth, other sources say that his freedom was granted when he turned 18. At 21 Benedict joined a society of hermits living under the rule of St. Francis of Assisi. Eventually he succeeded his friend, Jerome Lanze, as their leader. When the Pope disbanded the independent hermit society, Benedict joined the Order of Friars Minor and he was sent to Palermo, to the Franciscan Friary of St. Mary of Jesus. There Benedict worked in the kitchens and despite being illiterate and a lay brother (not a priest), he also served as Master of Novices, and as Guardian of the Community. St. Benedict was known throughout his life as a brilliant cook under whose hands food seemed to multiply miraculously, a healer, and a spiritual leader with profound understanding. He is recognized as the patron saint of African Americans.



WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN TITHING AND STEWARDSHIP?

Both tithing and stewardship are part of a spiritual way of life that calls us to use all of our resources for the service of the Gospel. Everything we are and everything we have comes from God. Offering back to God what He has given us is part of how we worship and give thanks to God.

Tithing is the practice of giving back 10 percent of what we earn. It comes from the Old English word for "ten." The first Scriptural example of tithing came from Abraham who gave a tenth of his possessions to the priest Melchizedek. He did so as an act of thanksgiving to God.

Stewardship as a way of life calls us to use well all that we have and all that we are, placing all things in service of others and God. Stewardship helps us see the good we can accomplish by making God and our spiritual life the most important values in our life. Whatever we accumulate in this life stays here. We can't take it with us! Both tithing and stewardship help us remember that nothing is mine or even ours ... all belongs to God.

Why should we participate in the Holy Week liturgy?

It is on Palm Sunday that we enter Holy Week, and welcome Jesus into our lives, asking him to allow us a share in his suffering, death and resurrection. This is also the time we remember and relive the events, which brought about our redemption and salvation. That is why the Holy Week liturgy presents us with the actual events of the dying and rising of Jesus. The liturgy also enables us to experience in our lives, here and now, what Jesus went through then. In other words, we commemorate and relive during this week our own dying and rising in Jesus, which result in our healing, reconciliation, and redemption. No wonder Greek Orthodox Christians greet each other with the words, “*Kali Anastasi*” (Good Resurrection), not on Easter Sunday but on Good Friday. They anticipate the resurrection. Just as Jesus did, we, too, must lay down our lives freely by actively participating in the Holy Week liturgies. In doing so, we are allowing Jesus to forgive us our sins, to heal the wounds in us caused by our sins and the sins of others and to transform us more completely into the image and likeness of God. Thus, we shall be able to live more fully the divine life we received at Baptism. Proper participation in the Holy Week liturgy will also deepen our relationship with God, increase our faith and strengthen our lives as disciples of Jesus. But let us remember that Holy Week can become “holy” for us only if we actively and consciously take part in the liturgies of this week. This is also the week when we should lighten the burden of Christ’s passion as daily experienced by the hungry, the poor, the sick, the homeless, the lonely and the outcast through our corporal and spiritual works of mercy. Let us prayerfully prepare for the Holy Week. As part of preparing ourselves spend little extra time in prayer, personally and as a family, participate in the Holy Eucharist if possible on weekdays as well, read Bible and if you have the book, Imitation of Christ, read in this season. Let us turn to the Lord, confess our sins, and ready ourselves to receive the manifold blessings of the Holy Week.

¿Porque debemos participar en la liturgia de Semana Santa?

El Domingo de Ramos comenzamos la Semana Santa, y damos la bienvenida a Jesús a nuestras vidas, preguntándole que nos permita compartir su sufrimiento, muerte y resurrección. Es también el tiempo que recordamos y revivimos los eventos que dieron lugar a nuestra redención y salvación. Es por eso que la liturgia de Semana Santa nos presenta los eventos reales de la muerte y resurrección de Jesús. La liturgia nos permite también experimentar en nuestras vidas, aquí y ahora, por lo que Jesús paso en aquel tiempo. En otras palabras, conmemoramos y revivimos durante esta semana nuestra propia muerte y resurrección en Jesús, lo cual resulta en nuestra sanación, reconciliación, y redención. Con razón, cristianos ortodoxos griegos se saludan con las palabras “*KaliAnastasi*” (Buena Resurrección), no en el Domingo de Pascua sino Viernes Santo. Anticipan la resurrección. Tal como lo hizo Jesús, nosotros también, debemos dar nuestras vidas libremente participando activamente en las liturgias de Semana Santa. Al hacerlo, estamos permitiendo que Jesús nos perdone nuestros pecados, sane las heridas en nosotros causadas por nuestros pecados y los pecados de los demás y nos transforme más completamente a la imagen y semejanza de Dios. Así podremos vivir más plenamente la vida divina que recibimos en el bautismo. La participación adecuada de la liturgia de Semana Santa profundizará también nuestra relación con Dios, aumentará nuestra fe y fortalecerá nuestras vidas como discípulos de Jesús. Pero, recordemos que la Semana Santa puede volverse ‘santa’ para nosotros solo si participamos activa y conscientemente en las liturgias de esta semana. Esta es también la semana en la que debemos aligerar la carga de la pasión de Cristo como la experimentan diariamente los hambrientos, los pobres, los enfermos, desamparados, y marginados, a través de nuestras obras de misericordia y espirituales. Preparémonos en oración para la Semana Santa. Como parte de la preparación dedica un poco de tiempo extra a la oración personal y oración en familia. Participa de la Santa Eucaristía si es posible también entre semana, lee la Biblia, y si tienes el libro Imitación de Cristo, léelo durante esta temporada. Vallamos al Señor y confesemos nuestros pecados y preparémonos para recibir las múltiples bendiciones de Semana Santa.
