




SAINT OF THE WEEK

At the age of 14 St. Bernadette (1844-1879) was living in abject poverty with her family in a one-room basement which had previously been used as a jail, in the town of Lourdes in southern France. She was a sickly child, having fallen victim to Cholera in 1854 and would battle asthma and tuberculosis for the rest of her short life. Bernadette was illiterate and is characterized in many accounts as slow or ignorant. It was in her 14th year that Bernadette was granted 18 visions of a 'Lady' at a grotto in Massabielle. The Lady instructed Bernadette to come daily to the grotto to receive the visions, eventually proclaiming 'I am the Immaculate Conception'. A spring at the grotto, which appeared where Bernadette was instructed to dig, has been a site of miraculous healing. The Lady also asked that a chapel be built in the grotto for pilgrims. Today the Marian shrine at Lourdes is one of the world's most popular.

During and following the period of visions, the saint was examined rigorously by Church and local authorities. The popular excitement around the visions left her subject to persistent questioning and attention. Eventually she sought protection by retiring to a home for the poor in a nunnery. She took her vows in 1866 with the Sisters of Charity at Nevers. She worked as an infirmary assistant, and later a sacristan, but by the end of her life she was too sick to participate in convent life. She died at the age of 35, humble and penitent until the end.

Easter Triduum

I haven't attended Triduum services before. What happens that's different from a normal Sunday Mass?

The liturgies during Holy Week are unique and rich in symbolism. The Mass for Palm Sunday follows the pattern of the day 2,000 years ago when Jesus entered Jerusalem. It includes a Gospel reading outside the church building and the entrance of the priest into the sanctuary while the congregation waves palms.

The Holy Thursday Mass also follows the rhythm of the ancient Last Supper. The presider washes the feet of members of the congregation, like Jesus washed the feet of the disciples. After Mass, all remaining hosts are taken to an altar of repose, where adoration of the Blessed Sacrament occurs late into the night. Parishioners can remain like the disciples in Gethsemane, asked to "watch and pray."

On Good Friday, we celebrate another special liturgical service. Following the Liturgy of the Word, there is a communal reverencing of the cross. The intercessions are solemn and include prayers for many different groups of people, reminding us that Jesus' passion is for the whole world. There is no Liturgy of the Eucharist. Hosts consecrated on Holy Thursday are distributed, after which the tabernacle is empty. The tabernacle remains empty through Holy Saturday — just as Jesus departed from this earthly world in death — and we wait in hope for Easter Sunday!

Triduo Pascual

No he asistido a los servicios del Triduo Pascual antes. Cual es la diferencia de una Misa dominical?

Las liturgias durante la Semana Santa son unicas y ricas en simbolismo. La Misa del Domingo de Ramos sigue el patron del dia hace 2000 años, cuando Jesus entro a Jerusalen. Incluye una lectura del Evangelio que se lee afuera de la Iglesia, durante la procesion de entrada al santuario, minetras la congregacion levanta sus palmas.

La Misa del Jueves Santo sigue tambien el ritmo de la Antigua Ultima Cena. El celebrante lava los pies de miembros de la congregacion, como Jesus lavo los pies de los discipulos. Despues de Misa, todas las hostias restantes se llevan al altar de reposo donde se realiza la Adoracion del Santisimo Sacramento hasta altas horas de la noche. Feligreses pueden permanecer, como los discipulos en Getsemani, a los que se les pido, "permanezcan en oracion."

El Viernes Santo, celebramos otro servicio liturgico especial. Despues de la Liturgia de la Palabra, hay una reverencia comunitaria de la Cruz. Las intercesiones incluyen oraciones por diferentes grupos de personas, recordandnos que la pasion de Jesus es por todo el mundo. No hay Liturgia de la Eucaristia. Hostias consagradas son distribuidas el Jueves Santo, tras lo cual se vacia el Santuario. EL Tabernaculo permanece vacio hasta el Sabado Santo - Tal como Jesus partio de este mundo terrenal al morir - ¡Y Esperamos con esperanza el Domingo de Pascua!

Holy Thursday Foot Washing

What is the significance of foot washing on Holy Thursday?

Foot washing is an ancient practice of hospitality. In Israel in Jesus' day, with its deserts and dusty roads, washing of feet was an act of honor on the part of the host. However, the host himself would not do the washing. That was the role of the servant. The Apostles would have been accustomed to this tradition. At the Last Supper, Jesus takes on the role of the servant, washing the feet of his followers and friends. He models the humble, loving service to which the Apostles would soon be called.

Holy Thursday is the commemoration of the Last Supper. We celebrate many things, including the institution of both the Eucharist and the priesthood – “This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me.” (Luke 22:19B). When the priest washes the feet of his parishioners, he is modeling the service of Christ. While foot washing is no longer a common practice in our society, we too are invited to imitate Christ’s sacrificial service to others.

Jueves Santo Lavatorio de los Pies -

Cual es el significado del lavado de los pies el Jueves Santo?

El lavado de los pies es una Antigua practica de hospitalidad. En Israel, en tiempos de Jesus, con sus desiertos y caminos polvorientos, el lavatorio de los pies era un acto de honor de parte del anfitrion. Sin embargo, el propio anfitrion no hacia el lavado, sino que era la labor de un sirviente. Los Apostoles se habrian acostumbrado a esta tradicion. En la Ultima Cena, Jesus assume el papel de servidor lavando los pies de sus seguidores y amigos. Él es modelo el servicio humildad y amoroso al que pronto seran llamados los Apostoles.

El Jueves Santo es la conmemoracion de la Última Cena. Celebramos varias cosas, incluyendo la institucion de la Eucaristia como la del sacerdocio: “Este es mi cuerpo, que sera entregado por ustedes; hagan esto en memoria mia,” (Lucas 22:19b). Cuando el sacerdote lava los pies de los feligreses esta modelando el servicio de Cristo. Mientras el lavado de los pies ya no es una practica comun en nuestra sociedad, somos invitados a imitar el servicio sacrificial de Cristo a los demas.
