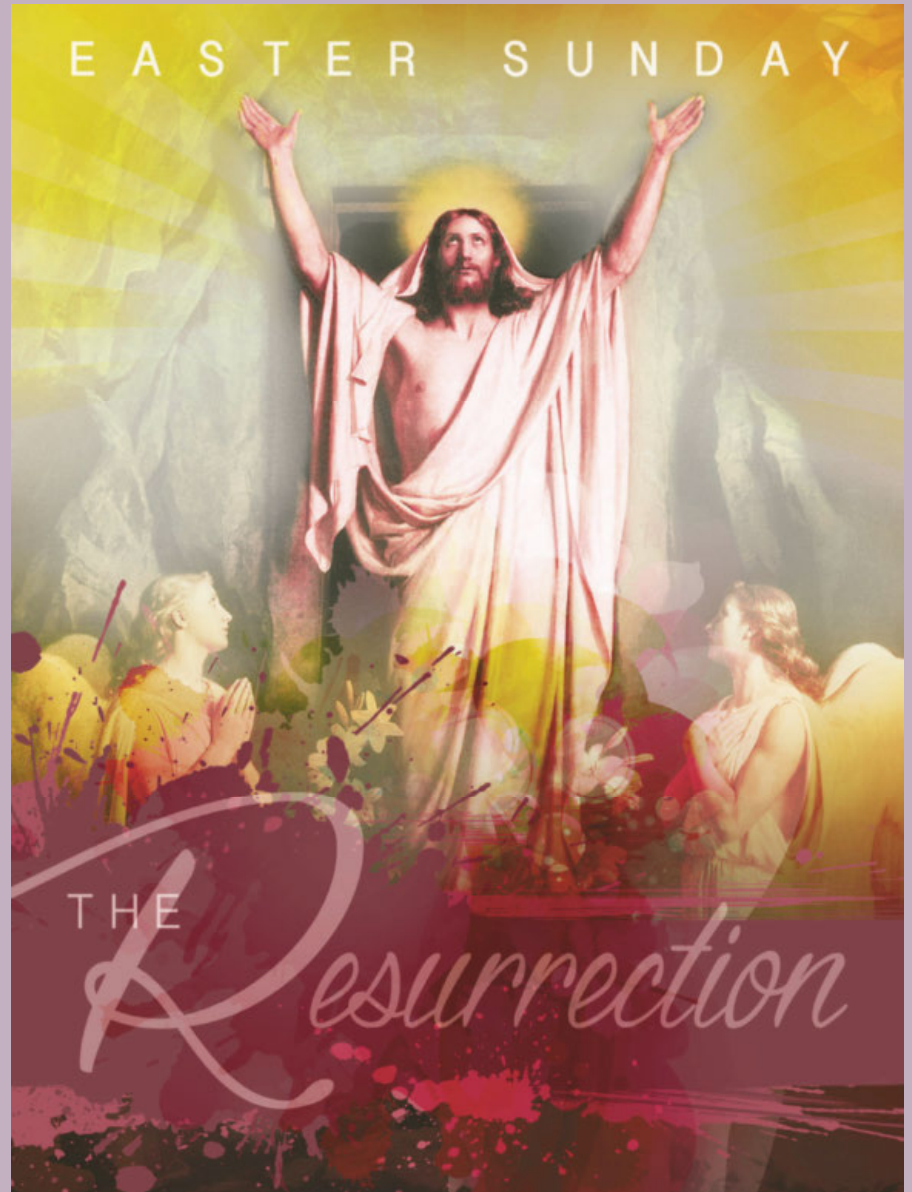

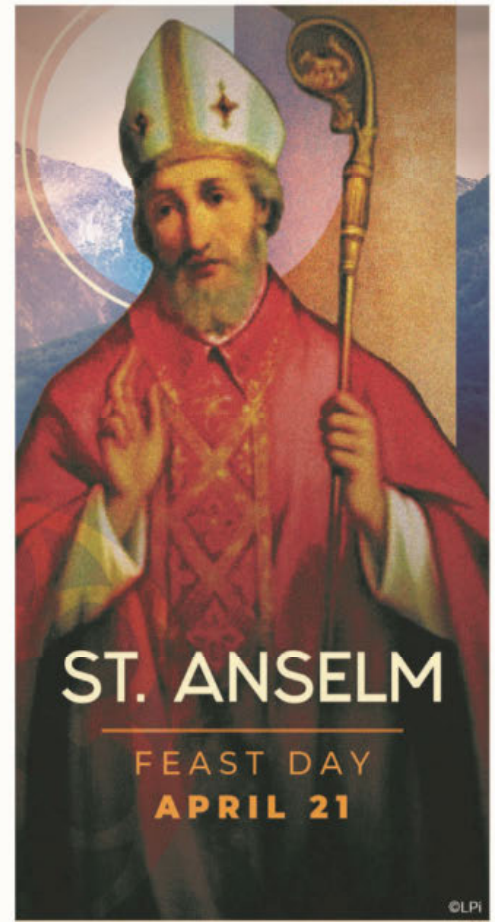

We have many stones and boulders blocking the path to freedom, love, and joy. They are often too big for us to move, and they cripple us. We can take a leap of faith today and believe with all our heart, mind, and soul that there is much more than can be seen by the naked eye. There is something very holy, sacred, and eternal stirring within us. We want to live forever! Christ's resurrection brings us joy and allows us to see ourselves as we are meant to be seen, as God's children destined for glory!



SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Anselm of Canterbury left his home in Italy to travel as a young man and ended up at the monastery in Bec, France, which was known for the teachings of its leader, Lanfranc. Anselm rose quickly to become abbot of the community and his writings are now compared in importance to those of St. Augustine.

In 1093 Anselm was appointed Archbishop of Canterbury by William II Rufus, the son and successor of William the Conqueror. However, at the time there was a controversy in Europe over whether kings or the pope had the power to invest bishops. Anselm, who believed only the pope should have the right to invest an ecclesiastical authority, spent much of his time as Archbishop exiled in Rome.

St. Anselm's teaching and works of theology are his most important contribution to the Catholic faith. He is considered of the fathers of scholastic theology and his chief achievement in philosophy was the ontological argument for the existence of God. His work *Cur Deus homo?* taught that atonement for sins could only be achieved through Christ. He was canonized in 1494 and named a Doctor of the Church in 1720.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

Easter Sunday

This Easter, in churches all over the world, people will be fully initiated in the Catholic Church. Those who have come from another Christian denomination have already begun their journey with Jesus Christ. But for those who are baptized at the Easter Vigil, a new reality has come to pass. Each newly baptized man, woman, and child have become new creations in Jesus Christ. They have died and risen with the one who rose on the third day and whose empty tomb we celebrate every Easter. Easter Sunday morning, they awake after many months of RCIA and all have the same question before them: "Now what?"

When one finds themselves having journeyed through various thresholds of conversion and now they bear the name of Christian, the time comes to chart the course of life as a disciple. Stewardship is that course of life. How one lives out their life from now on is the life of stewardship. The less one understands true stewardship and the value of their gifts and talents to the Body of Christ, the harder the journey.

Those of us who were baptized many years ago can easily fall into a false sense of comfort. We forget that sense of excitement those coming into the Church experience at the Easter Vigil. However, the story of that empty tomb reminds us of the power behind our baptism. Today, we, too, are called to discipleship and a stewardship way of life. Jesus continues to provide the answer to our, "Now what?"

LA CORRESPONSABILIDAD DIARIA

Domingo de Pascua

Esta Pascua en las Iglesias de todo el mundo, personas se iniciarán plenamente en la Iglesia Católica. Los que han venido de otra denominación Cristiana ya han comenzado su camino con Jesucristo. Pero, para aquellos que son bautizados en la Vigilia Pascual, ha llegado una nueva realidad. Cada hombre, mujer y niño recién bautizado se ha convertido en una nueva creación en Jesucristo. Han muerto y resucitado con el que resucitó el tercer día y cuyo sepulcro vacío celebramos cada Pascua. El Domingo de Pascua, por la mañana se despiertan después de varios meses de RICA y todos tienen la misma pregunta: "¿Y ahora que?"

Cuando uno se encuentra transitado por varios umbrales de conversión y ahora lleva el nombre de Cristiano, llega el momento de trazar el curso de la vida como un discípulo. La corresponsabilidad es ese curso de vida. La manera como uno vive su vida de ahora en adelante es la vida de corresponsabilidad. Cuanto menos entiende uno la verdadera corresponsabilidad y el valor de sus dones y talentos para el Cuerpo de Cristo, mas difícil será el camino.

Aquellos de nosotros que fuimos bautizados años atrás podemos caer fácilmente en una falsa sensación de comodidad. Olvidamos esa sensación de emoción que experimentan los que vienen a la Iglesia en la Vigilia Pascual. Sin embargo, la historia de esa tumba vacía nos recuerda el poder detrás de nuestro bautizo. Hoy, nosotros también estamos llamados al discipulado y a una forma de vida de corresponsabilidad. Jesús continúa dándonos la respuesta a nuestro, "¿Y ahora que?"

A note from Father James

Three friends were discussing death and one of them asked: "What would you like people to say about you at your wake service while your dead body in the coffin is visible to everyone?" The first of the friends said: "I would like them to say, he was a great humanitarian who cared about his community." The second said: "He was a great husband and father who was an example for many to follow." The third friend said, "I would like them to say, 'Look, he's moving in the coffin!'"

Easter is the greatest and the most important feast in the Church. It marks the birthday of our eternal hope. "Easter" literally means "the feast of fresh flowers." We celebrate it with pride and jubilation for three reasons: The Resurrection of Christ is the basis of our Christian Faith. The Resurrection is the greatest of the miracles -- it proves that Jesus is God. That is why St. Paul writes: "If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain; and your Faith is in vain... And if Christ has not been raised, then your Faith is a delusion and you are still lost in your sins... But in fact, Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep" (I Cor 15:14, 17, 20). If Jesus Christ did not rise from the dead, then the Church is a fraud and faith is a sham. But if Jesus really did rise from the dead, his message is true! Without the Resurrection, Jesus would have remained forever a good person who had met a tragic end. People would remember some of his teachings, and a handful of people might try to live according to them. All the basic doctrines of Christianity are founded on the truth of the Resurrection. "Jesus is Lord; He is risen!" (Rom 10:9) was the central theme of the kerygma (or "preaching"), of the apostles. There is a story of two women who stood before Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris. One asked, "Why can't we build structures like this anymore?" Her friend answered, "The people who built this had Faith. Today we have only opinions. And you can't build a cathedral with opinions." Easter is the guarantee of our own resurrection. Jesus assured Martha at the tomb of Lazarus: "I am the Resurrection and the Life; whoever believes in Me will live even though he dies" (Jn 11:25-26). Christ will raise us up on the last day, but it is also true, in a sense, that we have already risen with Christ. By virtue of the Holy Spirit, our Christian life is already a participation in the death and Resurrection of Christ. Easter is a feast, which gives us hope and encouragement in this world of pain, sorrows and tears. It reminds us that life is worth living. It is our belief in the Real Presence of the Risen Jesus in our souls, in His Church, in the Blessed Sacrament and in Heaven, that gives meaning to our personal, as well as to our common, prayers. Our trust in the all-pervading presence of the Risen Lord gives us strength to fight against temptations and freedom from unnecessary worries and fears. The prayer of St. Patrick, the Apostle of Ireland, reads: "Christ before me, Christ beside me, Christ within me, never to part." Together with Bishop Eduardo Nevares and Monsignor George, I wish you all a blessed Easter. May this Easter season bring you a fresh start in following Christ and living in Christ.

Una Nota del Padre James

Tres amigos estaban discutiendo sobre la muerte y uno de ellos pregunto: "Que te gustaria que la gente dijera sobre ti n tu velorio mientras tu cadaver esta en el ataúd visible para todos?" El primero de los amigos dijo "Me gustaria que dijeran, fue un gran humanitario que se preocupó por su comunidad." El Segundo dijo: "Era un gran esposo y padre, un gran ejemplo a seguir." El tercer amigo dijo: "¡A mí me gustaria que dijeran, 'Miren, se está moviendo en el ataúd!'" La Pascua es la fiesta más grande y más importante de la Iglesia. Marca el cumpleaños de la esperanza eternal. "Pascua" significa literalmente "la fiesta de las flores frescas." La celebramos con orgullo y júbilo por tres razones: La Resurrección de Cristo es la base de nuestra Fe Cristiana. La Resurrección es el mayor de los Milagros, prueba que Jesús es Dios. Por so escribe San Pablo: "Y si Cristo no ha resucitado, de nada les sirve su fe: ustedes siguen en sus pecados. Pero no, Cristo resucito de entre los muertos, siendo el primero y primicia de los que se durmieron (1 Cor 15:14, 17, 20). Si Cristo no resucito de entre los muertos, entonces la Iglesia es fraude y la fe es una farsa. ¡Pero, si Jesús realmente resucito de entre los muertos, su mensaje es verdadero! Sin la Resurrección, Jesús hubiera permanecido para siempre una Buena persona con un trágico fin. La gente recordaría algunas de sus enseñanzas, y un puño de ellos trataría de vivir su vida de acuerdo a ellas. Todas las doctrinas básicas del cristianismo están fundadas en la verdad de la Resurrección. "Jesús es el Señor; ¡Él ha resuciado!" (Romanos 10:9) fue el tema central del kerigma (o predicación) de los apóstoles. Hay una historia de dos mujeres que se pararon frente a la Catedral de Notre Dame en Paris. ¿Una de ellas pregunto, "Porque no podemos construir estructuras como estas? Su amiga contesto, "La gente que construyo esto tenia fe. Hoy solo tenemos opiniones. Y no puedes construir una catedral con opiniones. "Pascua es la garantía de nuestra propia resurrección. Jesús aseguro a Martha en la tumba de Lázaro: "Yo soy la Resurrección y la Vida; el que cree en Mí, aunque muera vivirá" (Juan 11:25-26). Cristo nos resucitara el ultimo día, pero es también cierto, en cierto sentido, que ya hemos sido resucitados en Cristo. Por virtud del Espíritu Santo, nuestra vida cristiana es ya una participación en la muerte y Resurrección de Cristo. La Pascua, es una fiesta que nos da esperanza y aliento en este mundo de dolor, tristeza, y lágrimas. Nos recuerda que vale la pena vivir la vida. Es nuestra creencia en la presencia real del Jesús resucitado en nuestras almas, en Su Iglesia, en el Santísimo Sacramento y en el Cielo lo que les da sentido a nuestras oraciones. Nuestra confianza en presencia omnipresente del Cristo Resucitado nos da fortaleza para luchar contra las tentaciones y liberarnos de preocupaciones y temores innecesarias. La oración de San Patricio, el Apóstol de Irlanda dice: "Cristo delante de mí, Cristo a mi lado, Cristo dentro de mí, nunca aparte de mí." Junto con el Obispo Eduardo Nevares y monseñor George, les deseamos una bendita Pascua. Que esta temporada de Pascua les traiga un nuevo comienzo para seguir a Cristo y vivir en Cristo.

THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING REGISTERED!

Being a registered, active and participating member of a Parish is very important especially when you need to baptize, register for religious education classes, sponsor a child for sacraments, get married, obtain letters (letters of good standing, immigration letters, sponsor letters, letters of transfer etc.)

For parents who have children enrolled in Catholic Schools, in order to receive the school reduced Catholic Tuition Rate, your family needs to meet the criteria set by the Parish for being a registered, ACTIVE and participating member.

The definition of a registered, active and participating member of this parish includes: being registered for the minimum of six months, attend Sunday Mass regularly as well as contributing with an envelope to our offertory along with (if possible) supporting the ministry life of our parish which is a HUGE plus.

If you aren't registered, come and join our parish family by obtaining a registration form from the parish office OR if you aren't sure if you are registered, call the front office to verify.

¡ES IMPORTANTE ESTAR REGISTRADO!

Ser un miembro registrado, activo y participante de una parroquia es muy importante especialmente cuando usted necesita bautizar, inscribir a los niños o adultos en clases de educación religiosa, ser padrino para los sacramentos, casarse, obtener cartas (cartas de buena reputación, cartas de inmigración, cartas de permiso, etc.)

Para los padres de familia que tienen niños inscritos en las Escuelas Católicas, para recibir un descuento en la colegiatura, su familia debe cumplir con los requisitos establecidos por la parroquia para ser considerado un miembro registrado, **ACTIVO** y participante.
