

Inspiration for the week



<i>A note from Father James</i>	<i>Una Nota del Padre James</i>
Why do we honor Mary as the “Mother of God?”	¿Porqué honramos a María como “La Madre de Dios?”
We honor Mary primarily because God honored her by choosing her to become the mother of Jesus, the Second Person of the Holy Trinity, when He took on human flesh and became man as stated in the Bible. The angel said to Mary: “ <i>You are going to be the mother of a Son and you will call Him Jesus, and He will be called the Son of the Most High.</i> ” After the angel had appeared to her and told her that she was to be the mother of Jesus, the Blessed Virgin Mary visited Elizabeth. At Mary’s greeting, Elizabeth said, “ <i>Why should this great thing happen to me, that my Lord’s mother comes to visit me?</i> ” [Lk. 1:43]. Hence, the Council of Ephesus affirmed in AD 431 that Mary was truly the Mother of God (<i>Theotokos</i>), and in AD 451, the Council of Chalcedon affirmed the Divine Motherhood of Mary as a dogma, an official doctrine of the Holy Catholic Church. Celebrating the feast of <i>Mary, the Mother of God</i> is a very appropriate way to begin a new year. This celebration reminds us that the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God, is also our Heavenly Mother. Hence, our ideal motto for the New Year 2023 should be “Through Mary to Jesus!”	Honramos a María principalmente porque Dios la honró al elegirla para convertirse en la madre de Jesús, la Segunda Persona de la Santísima Trinidad, cuando Él asumió la carne humana y se hizo hombre como se afirma en la Biblia. El ángel le dijo a María: “ <i>Vas a ser madre de un Hijo y lo llamarás Jesús, y será llamado Hijo del Altísimo</i> ”. Después que el ángel se le apareció y le dijo que ella era para ser la madre de Jesús, la Santísima Virgen María visitó a Isabel. Al saludo de María, Isabel dijo: “ <i>¿Por qué me ha de suceder esta gran cosa, que la madre de mi Señor viene a visitarme?</i> ” [Lc. 1:43]. Por lo tanto, el Concilio de Éfeso afirmó en el año 431 d. C. que María era verdaderamente la Madre de Dios (<i>Theotokos</i>), y en el año 451 d. C., el Concilio de Calcedonia afirmó la Maternidad Divina de María como un dogma, una doctrina oficial de la Santa Iglesia Católica. Celebrar la fiesta de María, la Madre de Dios, es una forma muy apropiada de comenzar un nuevo año. Esta celebración nos recuerda que la Santísima Virgen María, la Madre de Dios, es también nuestra Madre Celestial. Por lo tanto, nuestro lema ideal para el Año Nuevo 2023 debería ser “ <i>¡a Jesús A través de María!</i> ”

Let us strive to be pure and holy like our Heavenly Mother and seek our heavenly Mother’s prayers to have a better physical life and spiritual life in the New Year. <u>Let us make the New Year meaningful by having:</u>	Esforcémonos por ser puros y santos como nuestra Madre Celestial y busquemos las oraciones de nuestra Madre para tener una mejor vida física y espiritual en el Año Nuevo. Leave the past behind, the past of burdens, pains, hurts, unforgiveness, addictions, bad choices etc. and make new resolutions to be a better person, better parent, better son/daughter, better brother/sister, better friend and ultimately a better Christian. Deje atrás el pasado, el pasado de cargas, dolores, heridas, falta de perdón, adicciones, malas decisiones, etc. y tome nuevas resoluciones para ser una mejor persona, mejor padre, mejor hijo/hija, mejor hermano/hermana, mejor amigo y, en última instancia, un mejor cristiano.


