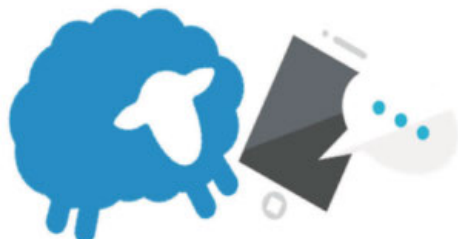

A note from Father James

Why do we have a parish mission in Lent?

Every parish deserves and needs a parish mission once in a while. Lent is primarily the time of intense spiritual preparation for conquering our temptations using the means Jesus used. It is also the time for renewing our lives for the celebration of Easter with our Risen Lord who conquered sin and death by his suffering, death and resurrection. A fruitful parish mission during Lent will increase bonding among parishioners. The renewal, enthusiasm and shot in the arm from this type of event invigorate even the best of communities. It renews their faith, commitment and attachment to the Body of Christ present in their faith community. By its very nature, a parish mission has in its DNA a conversion mode. The mission is a preaching event. God's Word is proclaimed through the Bible and Catholic doctrine. In times past parish missions were often seen as a time to "scare the hell" out of people, putting the fear of the Lord into them. Its main emphasis is centered upon how much the loving Lord desires to encounter and save each one of us. A parish mission is also a time of grace, a time for repentance, for change, for becoming a renewed person. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is an essential part of a good mission. St. Alphonsus used to say that the thermometer for a successful mission was judged by how many people used the confessional.

This Lent in our parish family we have arranged parish mission (retreat) on March 12,13 and 14 in Spanish and on March 19,20 and 21 in English on Eucharist and our daily life. We also will have confessions after each retreats on 15 and 22 respectively. It is also an opportunity for us to grow in our love for Eucharist and to be enriched in our Eucharistic life. We are organizing the Eucharistic Revival Programs in our parish as the part of National Eucharistic Revival Year. The parish mission is the first step of Eucharistic Revival Movement in our parish. In the month of May we will have lessons on Eucharist and also we will be hosting the exhibition on Eucharistic Miracles in our parish that travels from Italy. We will conclude the revival activities being "REVIVED IN EUCHARIST" personally and as a parish family with Eucharistic Procession on the Feast of Corpus Christi.

What should we do?

1. Find time for Eucharistic Adoration every day or three or four times a week.
2. Participate in the Holy Eucharist every day or whenever is possible in this Lent.
3. Participate in the Parish Mission.
4. Make a good confession.
5. Read gospel of John chapter 6, Bread of Life discourse, and meditate.

Una Nota del Padre James

¿Por qué tenemos misión parroquial en Cuaresma?

Cada Parroquia merece y necesita una Misión de vez en cuando. La Cuaresma es el tiempo primordial de intensa preparación espiritual para vencer nuestras tentaciones usando los medios que Jesús utilizó. Además es el tiempo para renovar nuestras vidas para la celebración de la Pascua con Nuestro Señor Resucitado quien conquistó el pecado y la muerte a través de su sufrimiento, muerte y resurrección. Una Misión Parroquial fructífera durante Cuaresma incrementan la unión entre los parroquianos. La renovación, el entusiasmo y el impacto de este tipo de eventos llena de vigor aun hasta las mejores comunidades. Renueva al fe, el compromiso y unión con el Cuerpo de Cristo presente en nuestra comunidad. Por sí misma, una misión parroquial tiene en su ADN un módulo de conversión. La Misión es un evento de predicación. La Palabra de Dios es proclamada a través de la Biblia y la doctrina Católica. En el pasado una misión parroquial eran frecuentemente momentos para "asustar a las personas", poniendo en ellos un miedo al Señor. El principal énfasis está centrado en Cuanto el Señor amoroso desea encontrarnos y salvar a cada uno de nosotros. Una misión parroquial es también un tiempo de gracia, un tiempo para arrepentirnos, cambiar, transformarnos en una persona renovada. El Sacramento de la Reconciliación es una parte esencial de una buena misión. St. Alfonso decía que el termómetro para medir el éxito de una Misión se juzga por la cantidad de personas que utilizan el confesionario.

Esta Cuaresma en nuestra familia parroquial hemos preparado una Misión Parroquial (Retiro) en marzo 2,13,14 en español y en Marzo 19,20,21 en inglés sobre la Eucaristía y la vida diaria. También tendremos confesiones después de cada retiro el 15 y 22 respectivamente. Es también una oportunidad para crecer en nuestro amor por la Eucaristía y enriquecernos en nuestra vida Eucarística. Estamos organizando Programas de Reavivamiento Eucarístico en nuestra parroquia como parte del Año Nacional de Reavivamiento Eucarístico. La misión de la parroquia es el primer paso al Movimiento de Reavivamiento Eucarístico en nuestra parroquia. En el mes de mayo tendremos lecciones sobre la Eucaristía y también tendremos en nuestra parroquia la Exhibición de los Milagros Eucarísticos que ha venido desde Italia. Concluiremos las actividades de reavivamiento "REVIVIENDO EN LA EUCHARISTIA" personalmente y como parte de la familia parroquial con la Procesión Eucarística en la fiesta de Corpus Christi.

¿Qué deberíamos hacer nosotros?

- 1.- Darnos tiempo para la Adoración Eucarística diariamente o tres o cuatro veces por semana.
- 2.- Participar en la Santa Eucaristía todos los días o cuando te sea como posible durante esta Cuaresma.
- 3.- Participar en la Misión Parroquial.
- 4.- Hacer una buena confesión.
- 5.- Leer el evangelio de Juan, capítulo 6, discurso de Pan de vida, y meditar.

THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING REGISTERED!

Being a registered, active and participating member of a Parish is very important especially when you need to baptize, register for religious education classes, sponsor a child for sacraments, get married, obtain letters (letters of good standing, immigration letters, sponsor letters, letters of transfer etc.)

For parents who have children enrolled in Catholic Schools, in order to receive the school reduced Catholic Tuition Rate, your family needs to meet the criteria set by the Parish for being a registered, ACTIVE and participating member.

The definition of a registered, active and participating member of this parish includes: being registered for the minimum of six months, attend Sunday Mass regularly as well as contributing with an envelope to our offertory along with (if possible) supporting the ministry life of our parish which is a HUGE plus.

Ser un miembro registrado, activo y participante de una parroquia es muy importante especialmente cuando usted necesita bautizar, inscribir a los niños o adultos en clases de educación religiosa, ser padrino para los sacramentos, casarse, obtener cartas (cartas de buena reputación, cartas de inmigración, cartas de permiso, etc.)
