

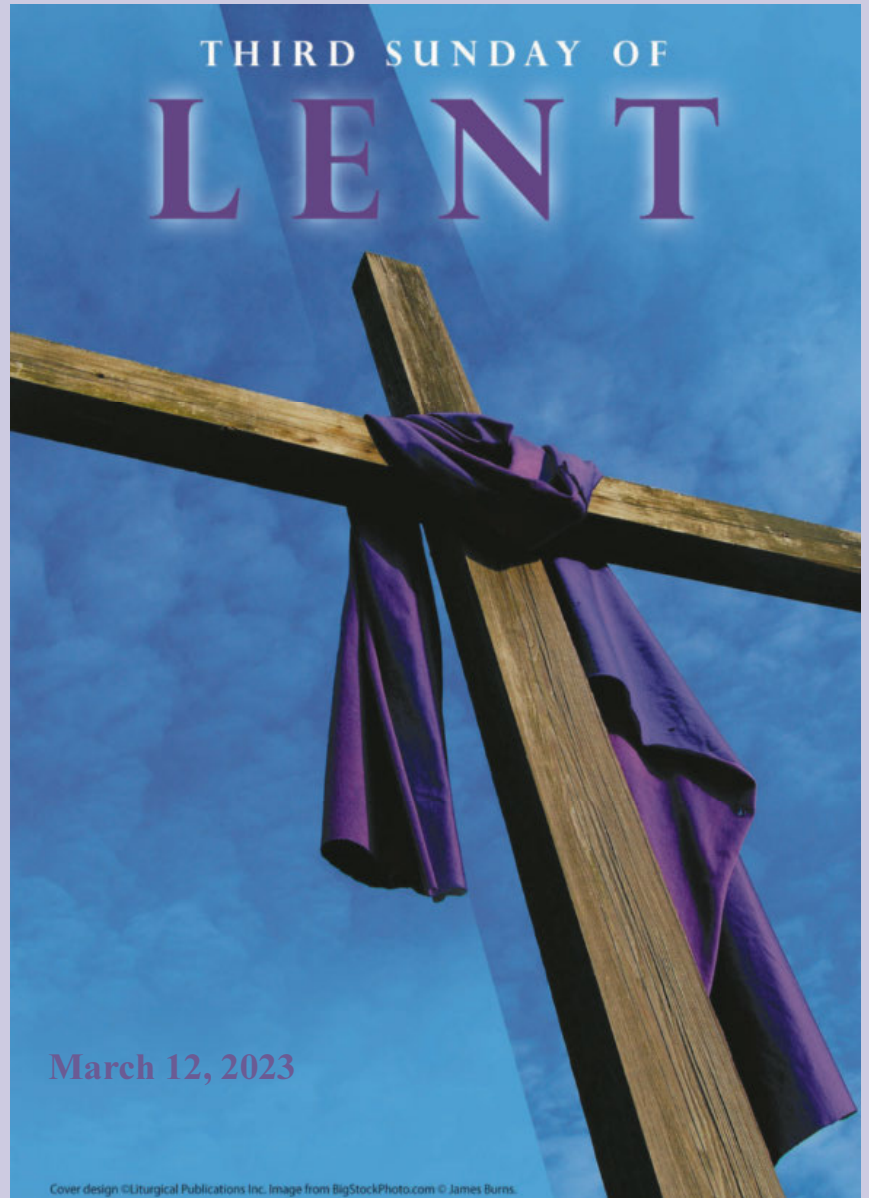

Stations of the Cross

The first Stations of the Cross were walked by Jesus himself on the way to Calvary. Known as the "Via Dolorosa" ("The Way of Suffering") or the "Via Crucis" ("The Way of the Cross"), it was marked out from the earliest times and was a traditional walk for pilgrims who came to Jerusalem. The early Christians in Jerusalem would walk the same pathway that Jesus walked, pausing for reflection and prayer. Later, when Christians could not travel to the Holy Land, artistic depictions of "The Way of the Cross" were set up in churches, or outside and Christians would walk from station to station, reading the Gospel account of the Passion, or simply praying and reflecting on each event. While the content or place of each station had changed, the intention was to make a mini-pilgrimage and follow--literally--in the footsteps of Jesus.

This devotion became better known in the Middle Ages, and the Franciscans are credited with its spread. Lent is a time when many people make the Stations and some churches present Passion plays or Living Stations. But anyone can pray the Stations at any time. It is a simple and personal reflection on the passion of Jesus and what it means to us.

<p><i>Why fasting, penance and prayer are recommended during Lent?</i></p>	<p><i>¿Por qué se recomienda el ayuno, la penitencia y la oración durante la Cuaresma?</i></p>
<p>Three pillars of Lent are Fasting, Alms giving and Prayer. These pillars make an internal movement towards God and others.</p> <p>1) <u>Fasting</u> reduces our “spiritual obesity” or the excessive accumulation of fat in our soul in the form of evil tendencies and evil habits.</p> <p>2) It gives us additional moral and spiritual strength and encourages us to share our blessings with the needy people.</p> <p>3) Fasting also gives us more time to be with God in prayer.</p> <p>4) We need to do prayerful fasting and acts of penance for our sins, following the example of Jesus before his public ministry.</p> <p>5) When we fast, we are imitating the people of Nineveh and the Syrian King, Ben Hadad who fasted pleading for God’s mercy and forgiveness, and Queen Esther who fasted for her people.</p> <p><u>Acts of penance</u> during Lent</p> <p>a) remove the weakness left by sin in our souls and give us more self-control,</p> <p>b) pay the temporary debt caused by sin, and</p> <p>c) make our prayers more fruitful.</p> <p>Besides, it is Jesus’ teaching: “<i>If any one wishes to follow me, let him deny himself, take up his cross and follow me.</i>” <u>Prayer</u> is necessary at all times because God has commanded it, and because, without it, we do not receive the graces necessary to persevere to the end. “It is necessary for adults as a means of salvation; that is to say, that a person who does not pray, and neglects to ask of God the help requisite for overcoming temptations, and for preserving grace already received, cannot be saved.” (<u>St. Alphonsus – CCC 2744</u>). In essence, prayer is talking to God and listening to Him. Jesus gives us the model of penitential prayer by his forty days in the desert in preparation for his public life.</p> <p>Prayer during the Lent:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Unites us to God; 2. Makes us heavenly minded; 3. Strengthens us against evil; 4. Gives us zeal and energy for good; 5. Comforts us in adversity; and 6. Obtains help for us in time of need, and the grace of perseverance unto death. <p>In these remaining days of Lent let us take a holy moment every day to put ourselves in the spirit of Lent and get ourselves closer to God.</p> <p>Fr. James</p>	<p>Los tres pilares de la Cuaresma son el ayuno, la limosna y la oración. Estos pilares hacen un movimiento interior hacia Dios y hacia los demás.</p> <p>1) El ayuno reduce nuestra “obesidad espiritual” o la acumulación excesiva de grasa en nuestra alma en forma de malas tendencias y malos hábitos.</p> <p>2) Nos da fuerza moral y espiritual adicional y nos anima a compartir nuestras bendiciones con las personas necesitadas.</p> <p>3) El ayuno también nos da más tiempo para estar con Dios en oración.</p> <p>4) Necesitamos hacer ayunos de oración y actos de penitencia por nuestros pecados, siguiendo el ejemplo de Jesús antes de su ministerio público.</p> <p>5) Cuando ayunamos, estamos imitando al pueblo de Nínive y al rey sirio, Ben Hadad, que ayunó suplicando la misericordia y el perdón de Dios, y la reina Ester, que ayunó por su pueblo.</p> <p>Los actos de penitencia durante la Cuaresma</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) quitan la debilidad dejada por el pecado en nuestras almas y nos dan más dominio propio, b) pagan la deuda temporal causada por el pecado, c) hacen que nuestras oraciones sean más fructíferas. <p>Además, es la enseñanza de Jesús: “Si alguno quiere seguirme, niéguese a sí mismo, tome su cruz y sígame”. La oración es necesaria en todo momento porque Dios lo ha mandado y porque sin ella no recibimos las gracias necesarias para perseverar hasta el final. “Es necesario para los adultos como medio de salvación; es decir, que el que no ora y deja de pedir a Dios la ayuda necesaria para vencer las tentaciones y conservar la gracia ya recibida, no puede salvarse.” (<u>San Alfonso – CCC 2744</u>). En esencia, la oración es hablar con Dios y escucharlo. Jesús nos da el modelo de oración penitencial por sus cuarenta días en el desierto en preparación para su vida pública.</p> <p>Oración durante la Cuaresma:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Nos une a Dios; 2. Nos hace de mente celestial; 3. Nos fortalece contra el mal; 4. Nos da celo y energía para el bien; 5. Nos consuela en la adversidad; y 6. Nos obtiene ayuda en tiempos de necesidad, y la gracia de la perseverancia hasta la muerte. <p>En estos días restantes de Cuaresma, tomemos un momento santo todos los días para ponernos en el espíritu de Cuaresma y acercarnos a Dios.</p> <p>Padre James</p>

THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING REGISTERED!

Being a registered, active and participating member of a Parish is very important especially when you need to baptize, register for religious education classes, sponsor a child for sacraments, get married, obtain letters (letters of good standing, immigration letters, sponsor letters, letters of transfer etc.)

For parents who have children enrolled in Catholic Schools, in order to receive the school reduced Catholic Tuition Rate, your family needs to meet the criteria set by the Parish for being a registered, ACTIVE and participating member.

The definition of a registered, active and participating member of this parish includes: being registered for the minimum of six months, attend Sunday Mass regularly as well as contributing with an envelope to our offertory along with (if possible) supporting the ministry life of our parish which is a HUGE plus.

Ser un miembro registrado, activo y participante de una parroquia es muy importante especialmente cuando usted necesita bautizar, inscribir a los niños o adultos en clases de educación religiosa, ser padrino para los sacramentos, casarse, obtener cartas (cartas de buena reputación, cartas de inmigración, cartas de permiso, etc.)
