





<i>What is the sacrament of reconciliation?</i>	<i>¿Qué es el sacramento de reconciliación?</i>
<p>The sacrament of penance is also called the sacrament of reconciliation, sacrament of conversion, sacrament of confession or sacrament of forgiveness. Baltimore Catechism defines it as a “sacrament in which the sins committed after Baptism are forgiven.” The New Advent Encyclopedia describes it as “a sacrament of the New Law instituted by Christ in which forgiveness of sins committed after baptism is granted through the priest’s absolution to those who with true sorrow confess their sins and promise to satisfy for the same.” Jesus Christ instituted the sacrament of confession on Easter Sunday night. Jesus came and stood among them. He breathed on them and said, “Receive the Holy Spirit. For those whose sins you forgive, are forgiven. For those whose sins you retain, they are retained” (John 20:19-23). In this sacrament, the penitent confesses his sins, expresses contrition, and proposes amendment. The confessor suggests a penance and says the words of absolution ending in.... I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.” The spiritual effects of the sacrament of Penance are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) reconciliation with God by which the penitent recovers grace; b) reconciliation with the Church; c) remission of the eternal punishment incurred by mortal sins; d) remission, at least in part, of temporal punishments resulting from sin; e) peace and serenity of conscience, and spiritual consolation; f) an increase of spiritual strength for the Christian battle. (CCC 1496). <p>Lent is a time to renew ourselves in Christ. The perfect time to do an examination of conscience and go to confession to prepare ourselves for a better experience of the Holy Week. And thus become a new person in Risen Christ. This coming Wednesday as well as on Saturdays we have confessions in preparation for Holy Week. James</p>	<p>El sacramento de la penitencia también se le llama también, sacramento de la reconciliación, sacramento de la conversión, sacramento de la confesión o sacramento del perdón. El Catecismo de Baltimore lo define como un “sacramento en el que se perdonan los pecados cometidos después del bautismo”. La New Advent Encyclopedia lo describe como “un sacramento de la Nueva Ley instituido por Cristo en el que se concede el perdón de los pecados cometidos después del bautismo mediante la absolución del sacerdote a aquellos que con verdadero dolor confiesan sus pecados y prometen satisfacerlos”. Jesucristo instituyó el sacramento de la confesión en la noche del Domingo de Resurrección. Jesús vino y se puso en medio de ellos. Sopló sobre ellos y les dijo: “Reciban el Espíritu Santo. Porque aquellos a quienes perdonen los pecados, les quedan perdonados. A quienes se los retengan les serán retenidos” (Juan 20:19-23). En este sacramento, el penitente confiesa sus pecados, expresa contrición y propone enmienda. El confesor sugiere una penitencia y dice las palabras de absolución que terminan en... Yo te absuelvo de tus pecados en el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo.” Los efectos espirituales del sacramento de la Penitencia son:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) la reconciliación con Dios por la que el penitente recobra la gracia; b) reconciliación con la Iglesia; c) remisión de la pena eterna en que incurren los pecados mortales; d) remisión, al menos en parte, de las penas temporales resultantes del pecado; e) paz y serenidad de conciencia y consuelo espiritual; f) un aumento de la fuerza espiritual para la batalla cristiana. (CEC 1496). <p>La Cuaresma es un tiempo para renovarnos en Cristo. El momento perfecto para hacer examen de conciencia e ir a confesarse para prepararnos para una mejor vivencia de la Semana Santa. Y así llegar a ser una persona nueva en Cristo Resucitado. Este próximo miércoles al igual que los sábados tenemos confesiones en preparación a la Semana Santa. Por favor, ven y recibe el sacramento de la Reconciliación.</p> <p>Padre James</p>
