



IMPORTANT DAYS DURING LENT

Ash Wednesday: Marks the start of Lent and the time for penance. Obligatory day of fasting (ages 18 to 59) and abstinence (ages 14 & over).

Fridays of Lent: Obligatory abstinence (ages 14 & over). All Fridays (even outside of Lent) are days of penance.

Holy Thursday: Lent ends and the Holy Triduum begins in the evening with the commemoration of the Institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper.

Good Friday: The anniversary of the Crucifixion of Christ (no Mass). Obligatory day of fasting (ages 18 to 59) and abstinence (ages 14 & over).

Holy Saturday: Christ is in the grave conquering death and freeing the captives. Final day of Lenten fasting (no daily Mass, Easter Vigil begins at sundown).

Sacred Triduum: The period of 3 days (Holy Thursday + Good Friday + Holy Saturday) during which we remember Christ's Passion, ending at the Easter Vigil (Saturday evening).

Easter Sunday: Lent has ended and the joy begins, the day of Christ's resurrection, the principle Christian feast of the entire liturgical year. This is the celebration of Christ's victory over sin and death merited for us by his passion, death, and resurrection from the dead on Easter Sunday.

OBLIGATORY DUTIES FOR CATHOLICS DURING LENT

Fasting & Abstinence: Our obligatory duty on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Abstinence: Do not eat meat on the Fridays of Lent. Treat it as a day of penance.

Confession: Catholics are obligated to fulfill their Easter Duty by receiving Holy Communion at least once during the Easter season (from Easter Sunday to Pentecost), therefore the Sacrament of Penance for any mortal sins is required prior to this, and is strongly recommended as a Lenten penitential practice for any venial sins prior to the Easter feast.

DÍAS IMPORTANTES DURANTE LA CUARESMA

Miércoles de Ceniza: Marca el inicio de la Cuaresma y el tiempo de penitencia. Día obligatorio de ayuno (de 18 a 59 años) y abstinencia (de 14 años en adelante).

Viernes de Cuaresma: Abstinencia obligatoria (a partir de 14 años). Todos los viernes (incluso fuera de Cuaresma) son días de penitencia.

Jueves Santo: Termina la Cuaresma y comienza el Triduo Santo por la tarde con la conmemoración de la Institución de la Eucaristía en la Última Cena

Viernes Santo: El aniversario de la Crucifixión de Cristo (sin Misa). Día obligatorio de ayuno (de 18 a 59 años) y abstinencia (de 14 años en adelante).

Sábado Santo: Cristo está en el sepulcro venciendo a la muerte y liberando a los cautivos. Último día de ayuno de Cuaresma (no hay Misa diaria, la Vigilia Pascual comienza al atardecer).

Triduo Sagrado: El período de 3 días (Jueves Santo + Viernes Santo + Sábado Santo) durante el cual recordamos la Pasión de Cristo, que termina en la Vigilia Pascual (sábado por la noche).

Domingo de Resurrección: Termina la Cuaresma y comienza la alegría, el día de la resurrección de Cristo, principal fiesta cristiana de todo el año litúrgico. Esta es la celebración de la victoria de Cristo sobre el pecado y la muerte que nos merece su pasión, muerte y resurrección de entre los muertos el Domingo de Pascua.

REGLAMENTOS PARA LOS CATÓLICOS DURANTE LA CUARESMA

Ayuno y Abstinencia: Nuestro deber obligatorio el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo.

Abstinencia: No comer carne los viernes de Cuaresma. Trátalo como un día de penitencia.

Confesión: los católicos están obligados a cumplir con su Deber de Pascua recibiendo la Sagrada Comunión al menos una vez durante la temporada de Pascua (desde el Domingo de Pascua hasta Pentecostés), por lo tanto, se requiere el Sacramento de la Penitencia por cualquier pecado mortal antes de esto, y se recomienda enfáticamente como un Práctica penitencial de Cuaresma por los pecados veniales antes de la fiesta de Pascua.
