



Vatican International Exhibition of Eucharistic Miracles.

Many Christians, including some Catholics, do not believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. In fact this teaching is clearly supported by the Bible (see Jesus' promise of the Eucharist, Jn. 6; the institution narratives in Mt. 26: 26-28, Mk 14: 22-24, Lk 23:19-20; and warnings against abuse 1 Cor. 11: 27-29). Some believe the mystery but do not grasp its implications or its dynamic power to impact their daily lives. Eucharistic miracles are a gift from God that recall us to the deeper

meaning of this mystery of our faith.

Pope John Paul II started his encyclical letter on the Eucharist, *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, with the simple yet profound statement: “The Church draws her life from the Eucharist.” Apart from Jesus, we can do nothing (John 15:5). So, whether it is an honest day’s work, playing with the kids at the park, leading family prayer, visiting the sick, feeding the poor, teaching RCIA, or rescuing babies from abortion, it is all possible because of Jesus. It is this same Jesus who is present in the Eucharist. So, whether we realize it or not, the power of Jesus in the Eucharist enables us to live out our faith. The Catechism puts it this way: “the Eucharist is the sum and summary of our faith” (CCC 1327).

In *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, the Holy Father reminds us: “Every commitment to holiness, every activity aimed at carrying out the Church’s mission, every work of pastoral planning, must draw the strength it needs from the Eucharistic mystery and in turn be directed to that mystery as its culmination. In the Eucharist we have Jesus, we have his redemptive sacrifice, we have his resurrection, we have the gift of the Holy Spirit, we have adoration, obedience and love of the Father. Were we to disregard the Eucharist, how could we overcome our own deficiency?” (#60)

The importance of the Eucharist to our daily lives cannot be overstated. This exhibition can help reawaken or deepen our Eucharistic faith, draw us into a more intimate relationship with Jesus, and bring about a renewed commitment to, and enthusiasm and fervor to live our Christian faith more dynamically as individuals and as a parish.

La Exposición de Milagros Eucarísticos del Vaticano

Muchos cristianos, incluidos algunos católicos, no creen en la Presencia Real de Jesús en la Eucaristía. De hecho, esta enseñanza está claramente respaldada por la Biblia (ver la promesa de Jesús de la Eucaristía, Jn. 6; las narraciones de la institución en Mt. 26, 26-28, Mc 14, 22-24, Lc 23, 19-20; y advertencias contra el abuso 1 Cor. 11: 27-29). Algunos creen en el misterio pero no captan sus implicaciones o su poder dinámico para impactar sus vidas diarias. Los milagros eucarísticos son un don de Dios que nos recuerdan el significado más profundo de este misterio de nuestra fe.

El Papa Juan Pablo II comenzó su carta encíclica sobre la Eucaristía, Ecclesia de Eucharistia, con la declaración simple pero profunda: “La Iglesia vive de la Eucaristía”. Aparte de Jesús, no podemos hacer nada (Juan 15:5). Entonces, ya sea un día de trabajo honesto, jugar con los niños en el parque, dirigir la oración familiar, visitar a los enfermos, alimentar a los pobres, enseñar RICA o rescatar bebés del aborto, todo es posible gracias a Jesús. Es este mismo Jesús quien está presente en la Eucaristía. Entonces, ya sea que nos demos cuenta o no, el poder de Jesús en la Eucaristía nos permite vivir nuestra fe. El Catecismo lo expresa así: “la Eucaristía es la suma y resumen de nuestra fe” (CCC 1327).

En Ecclesia de Eucharistia, el Santo Padre nos recuerda: “Todo compromiso de santidad, toda actividad encaminada a cumplir la misión de la Iglesia, toda obra de planificación pastoral, debe sacar del misterio eucarístico la fuerza que necesita y, a su vez, orientarse a ese misterio como su culminación. En la Eucaristía tenemos a Jesús, tenemos su sacrificio redentor, tenemos su resurrección, tenemos el don del Espíritu Santo, tenemos adoración, obediencia y amor al Padre. Si despreciáramos la Eucaristía, ¿cómo podríamos superar nuestra propia deficiencia? (#60)

No se puede exagerar la importancia de la Eucaristía en nuestra vida diaria. Esta exposición puede ayudar a despertar o profundizar nuestra fe eucarística, llevarnos a una relación más íntima con Jesús y generar un compromiso renovado, entusiasmo y fervor para vivir nuestra fe cristiana de manera más dinámica como individuos y como parroquia.




