The Structure of the Mass

Liturgy of the Word

Most of the Liturgy of the Word is made up of readings from Scripture. On Sundays and solemnities, there are three Scripture readings. During most of the year, the first reading is from the Old Testament and the second reading is from one of the New Testament letters. During the Easter season, the first reading is taken from the Acts of the Apostles which tells the story of the Church in its earliest days. The last reading is always taken from one of the four Gospels.

In the Liturgy of the Word, the Church feeds the people of God from the table of his Word (cf. Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, no. 51). The Scriptures are the word of God, written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. In the Scriptures, God speaks to us, leading us along the path to salvation.

The Responsorial Psalm is sung between the readings. The psalm helps us to meditate on the word of God. The high point of the Liturgy of the Word is the reading of the Gospel. Because the Gospels tell of the life, ministry, and preaching of Christ, it receives several special signs of honor and reverence. The gathered assembly stands to hear the Gospel and it is introduced by an acclamation of praise. During most of the year, that acclamation is "Alleluia!" derived from a Hebrew phrase meaning "Praise the Lord!" A deacon (or, if no deacon is present, a priest) reads the Gospel.

After the Scripture readings, the celebrant preaches the homily. In the homily, the preacher focuses on the Scripture texts or some other texts from the liturgy, drawing from them lessons that may help us to live better lives, more faithful to Christ's call to grow in holiness.

In many Masses, the Nicene Creed follows the homily. The Nicene Creed is a statement of faith dating from the fourth century. In certain instances, the Nicene Creed may be replaced by the Apostles' Creed (the ancient baptismal creed of the Church in Rome) or by a renewal of baptismal promises, based on the Apostles' Creed.

The Liturgy of the Word concludes with the Prayer of the Faithful or the General Intercessions. The gathered assembly intercedes with God on behalf of the Church, the world, and themselves, entrusting their needs to the faithful and loving God.

La estructura de la Misa

Liturgia de la Palabra

La mayor parte de la Liturgia de la Palabra se compone de lecturas de las Escrituras. Los domingos y solemnidades hay tres lecturas bíblicas. Durante la mayor parte del año, la primera lectura es del Antiguo Testamento y la segunda lectura es de una de las cartas del Nuevo Testamento. Durante el tiempo de Pascua, la primera lectura se toma de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, que cuenta la historia de la Iglesia en sus primeros días. La última lectura siempre se toma de uno de los cuatro Evangelios.

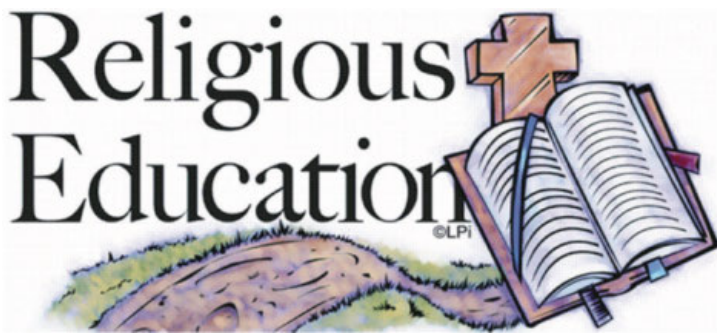
En la Liturgia de la Palabra, la Iglesia alimenta al pueblo de Dios con la mesa de su Palabra (cf. Constitución sobre la Sagrada Liturgia, n. 51). Las Escrituras son la palabra de Dios, escrita bajo la inspiración del Espíritu Santo. En las Escrituras, Dios nos habla, guiándonos por el camino de la salvación.

El Salmo Responsorial se canta entre las lecturas. El salmo nos ayuda a meditar en la palabra de Dios. El punto culminante de la Liturgia de la Palabra es la lectura del Evangelio. Debido a que los Evangelios hablan de la vida, el ministerio y la predicación de Cristo, recibe varios signos especiales de honor y reverencia. La asamblea reunida se pone de pie para escuchar el Evangelio y es introducido por una aclamación de alabanza. Durante la mayor parte del año, esa aclamación es "¡Aleluya!" derivado de una frase hebrea que significa "¡Alabado sea el Señor!" Un diácono (o, si no hay diácono presente, un sacerdote) lee el Evangelio.

Después de las lecturas bíblicas, el celebrante pronuncia la homilía. En la homilía, el predicador se centra en los textos de la Escritura o en algunos otros textos de la liturgia, extrayendo de ellos lecciones que nos ayuden a vivir una vida mejor, más fieles a la llamada de Cristo a crecer en santidad.

En muchas misas, el Credo de Nicea sigue a la homilía. El Credo de Nicea es una declaración de fe que data del siglo IV. En ciertos casos, el Credo de Nicea puede ser reemplazado por el Credo de los Apóstoles (el antiguo credo bautismal de la Iglesia en Roma) o por una renovación de las promesas bautismales, basadas en el Credo de los Apóstoles.

La Liturgia de la Palabra concluye con la Oración de los Fieles o las Intercesiones Generales. La asamblea reunida intercede ante Dios en nombre de la Iglesia, del mundo y de ellos mismos, confiando sus necesidades al Dios fiel y amoroso.

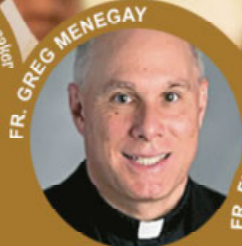

THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING REGISTERED!

Being a registered, active and participating member of a Parish is very important especially when you need to baptize, register for religious education classes, sponsor a child for sacraments, get married, obtain letters (letters of good standing, immigration letters, sponsor letters, letters of transfer etc.)

For parents who have children enrolled in Catholic Schools, in order to receive the school reduced Catholic Tuition Rate, your family needs to meet the criteria set by the Parish for being a registered, ACTIVE and participating member.

The definition of a registered, active and participating member of this parish includes: being registered for the minimum of six months, attend Sunday Mass regularly as well as contributing with an envelope to our offertory along with (if possible) supporting the ministry life of our parish which is a HUGE plus.
