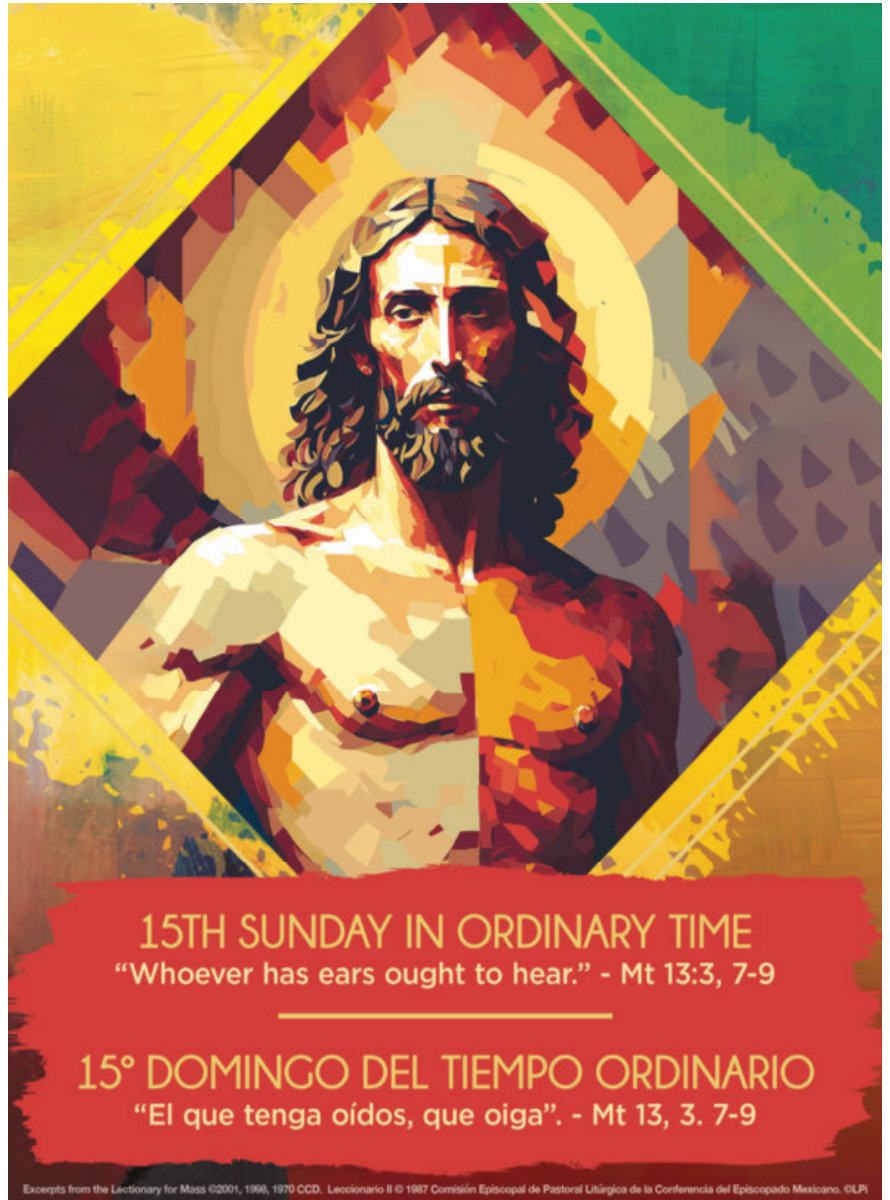

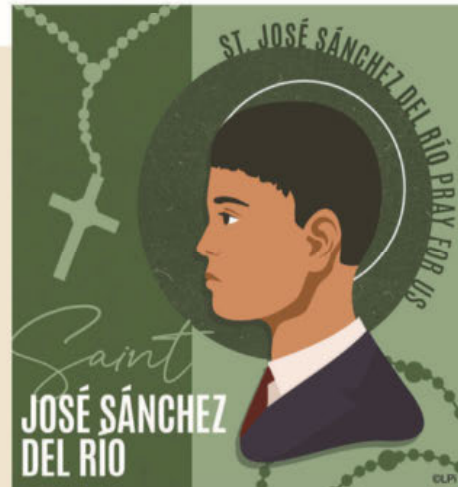

St. Charles Borromeo is my first parish here in Phoenix. As I have told you before I was not sure of anything when I started. Someone asked me on our first pastoral council meeting, Father, what are your plans for our parish? I responded, "I have no plans. I am still in a kind of uncertain whether I made right decision to say yes to Bishop Olmsted to take the responsibility of St. Charles Borromeo Parish." July 1st was my third anniversary of being in this parish. And I know that this parish is a God's gift to me and He walks with me every day. And I consider St Charles Borromeo as a birthday gift to me. I try my best to cherish this gift and I experience a tremendous love and acceptance here as my home. You all stood by me in my joys and in my pains when I lost my dad and mom. This is a parish that any priest can dream of having. Thank you for all your kind words and wishes on my birthday and that of Mons. George. I like to share this note that I came across in one of my readings. St Charles Borromeo parish practices everything that this note says as a model to other parishes.

When You Visit A Priest, Please Remember...

That a priest is not married, nor will he have a family of his own. No wife, no children. His family is his parishioners. He is a spiritual father in faith to the community he serves. His future is in celebrating the Eucharist at mass every day, listening to confessions, anointing the sick, serving those who come to him for help. A priest may serve a parish only for a minimum of five to seven years. After that, he may be transferred to another parish or assigned a different role in the Church. He relies on his team of volunteers, staff and the lay faithful. Do not expect him to be there all the time for you.

When you give money to the Church, you may be surprised to know that the money is not for him because no priest earns a fixed salary. They receive a stipend to meet their basic expenses of food, clothing and travel. They save every penny to go for a vacation and friends, relatives and well-wishers gift much of the money, as they do not get paid leave like the rest of us who work. While we work for a fixed amount of hours with two days off a week, priests are expected to be on standby 24/7. So do not be angry if they do not respond to you when you need them. They are humans as well with the same frailty as us.

If you hear anyone speaking badly about a particular priest, please correct that person and do not engage in idle gossip without knowing the facts. Remember that they are alone and at times would need company. Pay attention to their emotional, physical and mental needs. Accompany them if needed or offer a helping hand or even a lift. It is not easy to go out alone at two or three in the morning especially in dangerous neighborhoods for counseling or even anointing someone on their deathbed. If someone comes to them at such an hour for help, they have to get up from their deep sleep and still be expected to celebrate Mass in the morning. Who is there for them when they are ill or have emergencies in the middle of the night? Yet they are required to perform their duties because if not them, who?

Remember their birthdays, ordination anniversaries and important events in their lives. Celebrate with them, cry with them. Offer a shoulder to lean on. If they fall, do not judge or criticize. Lift them up and help them on their journey in life. Do not be offended if they do not live up to your expectations. No priest is perfect.

So take care of your priests, remember the ones who baptized, confirmed, married and anointed you. The ones who offer masses for your intentions and pray for you. May God bless our priests in Jesus name, our eternal High Priest. Amen.

I am so happy that I said yes to Bishop to take care of St. Charles Borromeo Parish. Thanks to each of you for being a caring and loving parishioner. You make a difference and our parish family makes a difference. Let us continue to support each other and be what we are called to be. Say a prayer for your priests and all the priests you know. God bless you all.

San Carlos Borromeo es mi primera parroquia aquí en Phoenix. Como les he dicho antes, no estaba seguro de nada cuando empecé. Alguien me preguntó en nuestra primera reunión del consejo pastoral, Padre, ¿cuáles son sus planes para nuestra parroquia? Respondí: "No tengo planes. Todavía no estoy seguro de si tomé la decisión correcta de decirle que sí al obispo Olmsted para asumiera la responsabilidad de la parroquia de San Charles Borromeo". El 1 de julio fue mi tercer aniversario de estar en esta parroquia. Y sé que ésta parroquia es un regalo de Dios para mí y Él camina conmigo todos los días. Y considero a San Carlos Borromeo como un regalo de cumpleaños para mí. Hago lo mejor que puedo para apreciar este regalo y experimento un tremendo amor y aceptación aquí como mi hogar. Todos ustedes estuvieron a mi lado en mis alegrías y en mis dolores cuando perdí a mi papá y mi mamá. Ésta es una parroquia que cualquier sacerdote puede soñar tener. Gracias por todas sus amables palabras y deseos en mi cumpleaños y el de Mons. Jorge. Me gustaría compartir esta nota que encontré en una de mis lecturas. La parroquia de San Carlos Borromeo practica todo lo que dice esta nota como modelo para otras parroquias.

Cuando visites a un sacerdote, recuerda.....

Que un sacerdote no esté casado, ni tenga una familia propia, no esposa, no hijos. Su familia son sus feligreses. Es un padre espiritual en la fe de la comunidad a la que sirve. Su futuro está en celebrar la Eucaristía en la misa todos los días, escuchar confesiones, ungir a los enfermos, servir a los que acuden a él en busca de ayuda. Un sacerdote puede servir en una parroquia solo por un mínimo de cinco a siete años. Después de eso, puede ser transferido a otra parroquia o asignado a un papel diferente en la Iglesia. Se apoya en su equipo de voluntarios, personal y fieles laicos. No esperes que él esté allí todo el tiempo para ti.

Cuando le das dinero a la Iglesia, te sorprenderá saber que el dinero no es para él porque ningún sacerdote gana un salario fijo. Reciben un estipendio para cubrir sus gastos básicos de alimentación, vestido y viaje. Ahorran cada centavo para irse de vacaciones y amigos, parientes y simpatizantes regalan gran parte del dinero, ya que no reciben licencia pagada como el resto de los que trabajamos. Si bien trabajamos por una cantidad fija de horas con dos días libres a la semana, se espera que los sacerdotes estén en espera las 24 horas del día, los 7 días de la semana. Así que no te enojas si no te responden cuando los necesitas. Ellos también son humanos con la misma fragilidad que nosotros.

Si escuchas a alguien hablando mal de un sacerdote en particular, corrige a esa persona y no participes en chismes sin saber los hechos. Recuerda que están solos y en ocasiones necesitarán compañía. Presta atención a sus necesidades emocionales, físicas y mentales. Acompáñalos si es necesario u ofréceles una mano amiga o incluso un aventón. No es fácil salir solo a las dos o tres de la mañana especialmente en barrios peligrosos para aconsejar o incluso ungir a alguien en su lecho de muerte. Si alguien acude a ellos a esa hora en busca de ayuda, tienen que levantarse de su sueño profundo y aún se espera que celebren Misa por la mañana. ¿Quién está ahí para ellos cuando están enfermos o tienen emergencias en medio de la noche? Sin embargo, están obligados a cumplir con sus deberes porque, si no ellos, ¿quién?

Recuerda sus cumpleaños, aniversarios de ordenación y eventos importantes en sus vidas. Celebra con ellos, llora con ellos. Ofrece un hombro en el que apoyarse. Si se caen, no juzgues ni critiques. Levántalos y ayúdalos en su viaje en la vida. No se ofenda si no están a la altura de sus expectativas. Ningún sacerdote es perfecto.

Cuiden pues, de nuestros sacerdotes, recuerda a los que te bautizaron, confirmaron, casaron y ungieron. Los que ofrecen misas por tus intenciones y oran por ti. Que Dios bendiga a nuestros sacerdotes en el nombre de Jesús, nuestro eterno Sumo Sacerdote. Amén.

Estoy tan feliz de haber dicho que sí al obispo para cuidar de la parroquia de San Carlos Borromeo. Gracias a cada uno de ustedes por ser feligreses cariñosos y amorosos. Tú haces la diferencia y nuestra familia parroquial hace la diferencia. Sigamos apoyándonos unos a otros y haciendo lo que estamos llamados a ser.
