Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

First of all, we give thanks to our Almighty God for a very fruitful Vacation Bible Camp (VBC) after a year of not having it due to pandemic. Last week, we held our VBC with 59 children participants and 50 youth volunteers—mostly high schoolers and our school alumni. I am very grateful to Chris Mardesich (Youth Director) and Jennifer Robinson (VBC Coordinator) and to all of our volunteers who did such a wonderful job and spent so much time to make it a success.

Another academic year of grace is drawing near, even in the midst of many challenges due to COVID, and schools are about to welcome students to their campuses. This year, our own Holy Family parish and school will welcome 307 students with 60 new students. Most of them (1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades) will start on Wednesday August 18<sup>th</sup>. This is a thrilling moment for us as a parish and school. We are given the opportunity to support our children to achieve academic excellence in a safe, loving, caring, and nurturing setting, and dedicated to passing on the Catholic traditions. We are blessed to be entrusted with such task. Nevertheless, our undertaking does not come without challenges. One of the obstacles that we need to overcome is our acceptance of our responsibilities and our willingness to extend ourselves to one another.

As our souls yearn to live in unity with God, we, too, must strive to live in unity with our families, communities, and parish, wherefore, putting the words of God into action. To live in unity as a parishioner of the Holy Family church, we cannot separate ourselves from the church, other parishioners, or the school. Much the same as the Holy Trinity, the Holy Family church, the parishioners, and the school are one. Whereas each entity is distinct from one another with its own role, each is equally significant and collectively makes up the Holy Family parish. No one entity can shake-off their responsibility to another entity. Each and every one's well being is dependent on one another. Comparable to a ripple effect, in such that if the church is positive and favorable, the parishioners and the school will be also be pleasing and agreeable. With parishioners that are faithful active members and respond to the struggles or hardships of the church or school, the church and the school will benefit tenfold. Supposing that our students, who are the church of today and tomorrow, lead a devoted spiritual life and study diligently, the church and their parents will surely and truly be blessed. Conversely, if the school encounters adversity, the church and the parishioners would be affected as well. Therefore, it is an utmost essential for each and every one of us to not turn a blind eye when our stewardship is required.

I invite staff, parishioners, school parents and students to immerse yourselves in God's grace. With a grateful attitude, lend your hands to one another in serving God within your capability and capacity. Mother Teresa once said, "It is not how much we do, but how much love we put in the doing; it is not how much we give, but how much love we put in the giving." Keep in mind that God only asks us to do little things with great love. By so doing, we often do it without counting the cost. The fruit of our sacrificial gift for one another is immeasurable, and the joy that we receive far outweighs the cost. Let us join hands and continue to build a strong parish and school in God's grace for we are two functions, but one entity. Many our loving Lord continue to bless our faith community and our loved ones!




