If you have been at the 9:30 AM Sunday Mass lately you have probably noticed some extra ceremony following the homily. A young lady, Jazmine Seisa and occasionally a youth or two have come for-

ward, been prayed over and then dismissed. Jazmine is one of the Elect. The youths are Catechumens. They are Kalista Garcia and Jayden Garcia.

The Elect are those of our community that are preparing to enter the Catholic Church at the upcoming Easter Vigil. During the Vigil Jazmine will receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and 1st Eucharist. She is participating in RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). A process that was reestablished by Vatican II as the means to enter the Church.

Jazmine, along with the Candidates (members of our community who have previously received a Christian Baptism and are seeking Confirmation and 1st Eucharist), have been preparing for this for many months. The candidates are Danny Flores, Rosie Flores, and Mikayla Ehlenberger. Meeting weekly, they have been exposed to the major elements of our faith and have had time to discern if becoming Catholic and living the life of a Catholic is for them.

Between now and the Easter Vigil on April 16th, they all will continue to meet weekly to reflect on the upcoming Easter mysteries. Their preparation will conclude with a morning of reflection on April 16th. Then it is on to the Vigil that evening with its beautiful liturgy and the receiving of Sacraments.

Once they have received their Sacraments, they will be Neophytes (a fancy name for new, fully initiated Catholics). They will have a series of additional weekly meetings to help them get a good start to their new life in faith.

What can we do to help, you ask? First and foremost, pray for them and their families. Welcome them into the ministries you participate in when the opportunity arises. Be open to supporting them and those who will follow them in the years to come.

We can all also encourage our family and friends to consider taking part themselves in the RCIA process if they are interested in joining the Catholic Church or want to complete their Sacraments of Initiation.

RCIA is a journey of faith. It is a journey into community. Let us support them in this walk.
