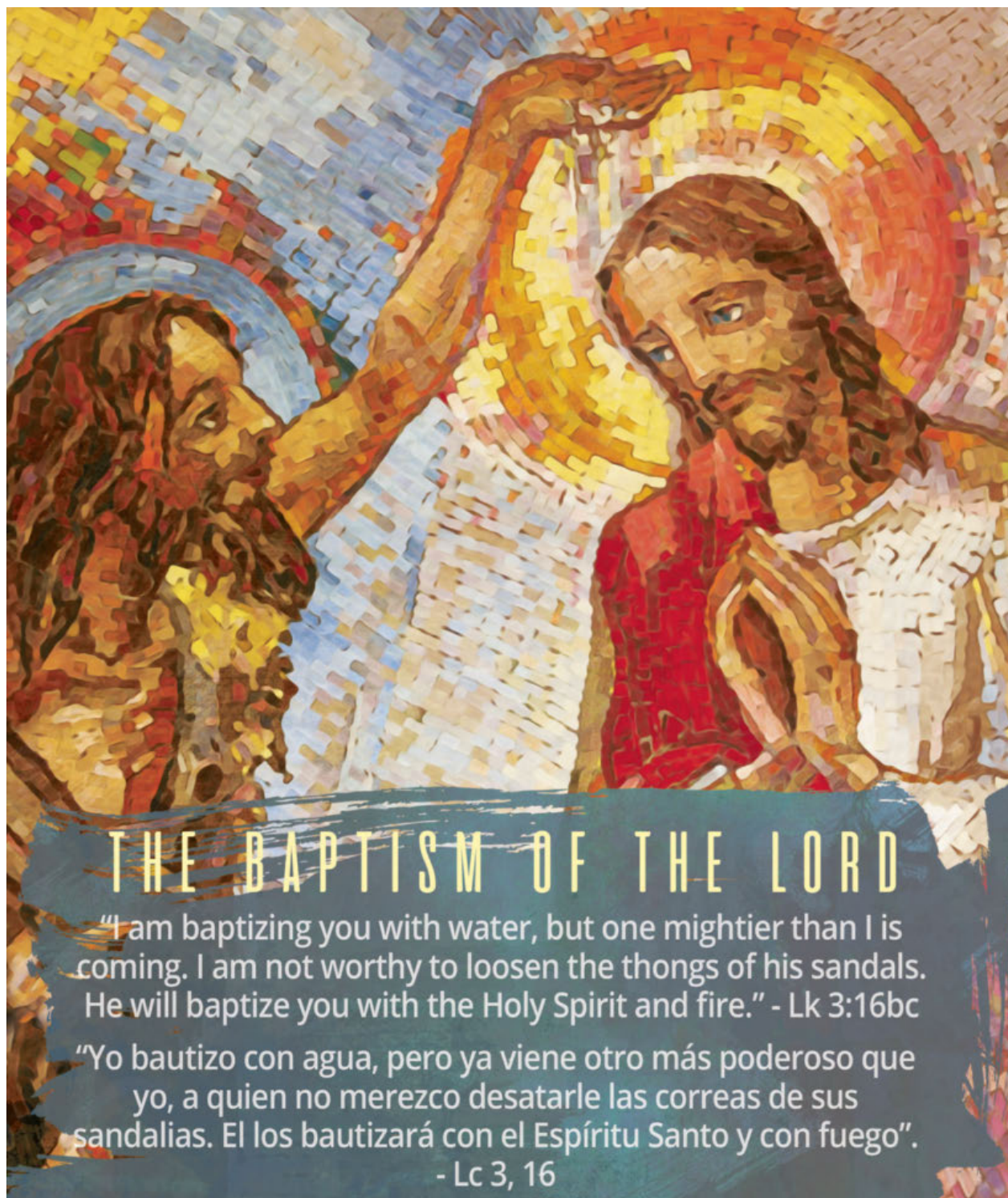

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

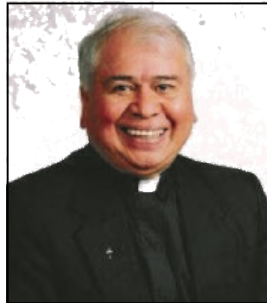
"I am baptizing you with water, but one mightier than I is coming. I am not worthy to loosen the thongs of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." - Lk 3:16bc

"Yo bautizo con agua, pero ya viene otro más poderoso que yo, a quien no merezco desatarle las correas de sus sandalias. El los bautizará con el Espíritu Santo y con fuego".

- Lc 3, 16

REY MESIÁNICO. Hoy lo vemos consagrado por el Padre en el Espíritu Santo. Jesús baja al río Jordán para abrir a los seres humanos las puertas de la verdadera Tierra Prometida: el cielo, la vida eterna. "En el Bautismo en el Jordán ya se vislumbra claramente el 'estilo' mesiánico de Jesús: viene como 'Cordero de Dios' para cargar con el pecado del mundo y quitarlo" (Juan Pablo II). Por eso cuando nos preguntamos por qué Jesús, siendo limpio e inocente, pidió ser bautizado, la respuesta la encontramos en el hecho de que Cristo quiso solidarizarse con la raza humana: "ha sido probado en todo igual que nosotros, a excepción del pecado" (Hebreos 4,15); o mejor todavía: "Dios hizo cargar con nuestro pecado al que no cometió pecado, para que así nosotros participáramos en El de la justicia y perfección de Dios" (2 Cor 5,21). "Mientras (Jesús) estaba en oración, se abrieron los cielos" (Lc 3,21); "Al momento de salir del agua, Jesús vio los cielos abiertos" (Mc 1,10); "Una vez bautizado, Jesús salió del agua. En ese momento se abrieron los cielos" (Mt 3,16). Hacía ya tiempo que no se veían profetas. Parecía que Dios estaba callado y los judíos decían que "los cielos estaban cerrados". Pero ahora Dios vuelve a hablar: se abrieron los cielos; es decir, que Jesús recibió una comunicación divina (Ez 1,1; Apoc 4,1). Jesús toma el relevo de los profetas. Marcos no usa el término "abrir", tal como vierten algunas traducciones, sino que dice que los cielos se "rasgaron". La diferencia es significativa; lo que se abre puede también cerrarse; sin embargo, lo que se desgarró no puede volver fácilmente a su estado original.

MESSIANIC KING. Today we see Jesus consecrated by the Father in the Holy Spirit. Jesus goes down to the Jordan River to open the doors of the true Promised Land: heaven, eternal life for human beings. "At the Baptism in the Jordan, the messianic style of Jesus is already clearly glimpsed: he comes as the Lamb of God to bear the sin of the world and take it away" (John Paul II). That is why when we ask ourselves why Jesus, being clean and innocent, asked to be baptized, the answer is found in the fact that Christ wanted to be in solidarity with the human race: "He has been tested in everything just like us, except for sin" (Hebrews 4.15); or better yet: "God made the one who did not commit sin bear our sin, so that we might participate in Him of the justice and perfection of God" (2 Cor 5,21). "While (Jesus) was in prayer, the heavens were opened" (Lk 3,21); "As he came out of the water, Jesus saw the heavens opened" (Mk 1,10); "Once baptized, Jesus came out of the water. At that moment the heavens were opened" (Mt 3:16). It had been a long time since prophets had been seen. It seemed that God was silent and the Jews said that the heavens were closed. But now God speaks again; the heavens have opened; that is, Jesus received a divine communication (Ez 1,1; Rev 4,1). Jesus takes over from the prophets.

Mark does not use the term "to open", as some translations render, but he says that the heavens were "torn". The difference is significant; what opens can also close. However, what is torn cannot easily be returned to its original state.
